The Gospel reading we will focus on is from the Gospel of John 20:19-23. It is a beautiful scripture about Jesus appearing to his disciples and breathing the Holy Spirit upon them. One line from this Gospel that at times we overlook is the last line, "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and those whose sins are retained are retained." It is powerful to think about what forgiving someone does, not only for them but also for us who are able to forgive. The power of the Holy Spirit can open us up to the reality that Jesus invites us into. Could you imagine what it would be like to forgive someone and experience the freedom that it offers to them and us? As we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit constantly, are we willing to allow it to penetrate our hearts, minds and souls? If we invite the Holy Spirit in, get ready for the joy only Jesus and the Spirit can give.


