Tragedy and Community

Our Wabasha/ Kellogg community experienced a great tragedy this past week with the loss of three lives in a boating accident. The sadness and pain of this tragedy is palpable throughout our community. We were able to hold a prayer service Monday evening at St. Felix for the families and community members affected by this accident. We estimate that about 750 people came to pray and show their support to the grieving families. The Church had about 350 people and the gym had 400 watching and participating through a live stream.

Leaders from across the Wabasha-Kellogg community came together to participate in this ecumenical service. A special thank you to Nels Onstad, Pastor Knox and Pastor Olcott for participating and representing their churches. Also, a special thank you to parish staff and parishioners who made this prayer service happen on a short notice.

Lessons learned

- Life is a gift from God, do not take loved ones for granted.
- We can be a community united through Jesus Christ and prayer despite our differences.
- We are not meant to walk alone, we need community.

Please continue to pray for the repose of the souls of those who died and their loved ones who mourn their loss. Death is not the End for those in Christ Jesus; it is the door to eternal life.

Gospel Reflection

The mustard seed, though one of the smallest of seeds, grows into a great shrub where the birds come to rest, finding shelter, security, and peace. In the same way, through the grace of God, we are called to plant the mustard seed of faith within our parish community, nurturing a place where Christ is alive and where all can grow in faith, hope, and love through Jesus Christ.

As we continue this mission together, may we remember the beautiful sign of Christian community we experienced this past week and allow it to inspire us to keep building a parish that welcomes, supports, and strengthens one another in faith.
