Anyway, the journey continues.

Ryan Saltness, a diocesan seminarian arrived last Tuesday and is getting acquainted with Wabasha and Kellogg. I ask that you invite Ryan to be part of these communities the best you can. He is two years from being ordained a priest and would appreciate your prayers and support. Welcome Ryan to St. Felix and St. Agnes.

Next weekend, July 12th-13th we will welcome Fr. Richard Dee Du who will be here to preach about their mission and ask for our support. ## St. Felix Catholic School Eric Sonnek, Principal

As I sit down to write this week's article, I find myself reflecting on the past eight years at St. Felix. On July 1, 2017, I walked into my office for the first time as principal—filled with nerves and doubts—ready to begin the journey of leading a school. Looking back now, I am filled with pride and gratitude for how far we have come together as a community.

We've celebrated many successes and faced challenges head-on, all in the pursuit of providing a strong educational foundation for the children of our parish and community. Since that first year, our enrollment has steadily increased—from 81 students to approximately 95 students expected this coming school year. Along the way, we've made significant improvements: a new playground, updated flooring, a dedicated science/art room, and enhanced Wi-Fi and technology throughout the school.

Our academic growth is something to truly be proud of. Over the years, we've seen consistent improvement in our test data, with nearly 70% of our students now performing at or above grade level in both math and reading. We've also expanded our preschool and kindergarten readiness programs by adding staff to help build a solid foundation for our 3- and 4-year-olds. Intervention support was introduced to assist students needing extra help, and—together—we navigated the unprecedented challenges of a global pandemic.

None of this would have been possible without the incredible support I've received along the way.

First, I want to thank my wife and children for their unwavering encouragement and patience throughout the years. I also extend heartfelt thanks to our dedicated staff, whose commitment, sacrifice, and passion for education continue to shape the lives of our students every day. To our students and parents—thank you for believing in our mission and being part of our school community. Your presence and support make everything we do possible.

To the parishes of St. Felix and St. Agnes—thank you for your ongoing financial and spiritual support. It is a true blessing to be part of a community that stands firmly behind its school. Knowing that your prayers are with us each day is a source of strength and inspiration.

Thank you all for an incredible eight years. I look forward to continuing this journey and invite you to stop by any time to see first-hand the great things happening at St. Felix School.
