FR. TOM LOOMIS PASTOR

Welcome to any visitors who are with us for Watermelon Days in Kellogg. I enjoy wandering downtown Kellogg before the parade. It is fun to see the locals but also how many visitors come to Kellogg to reconnect. There will be a float in the parade for St. Felix School and the parishes of St. Felix and St. Agnes. Look for us and wave!

Next weekend we have the St. Felix Fall Festival. Another powerful way to host many people from this community and those who live outside the community who are coming to celebrate with us. We are still in need of volunteers and if you can spare an hour or two it would be much appreciated. Thank you to our committee who has done amazing work to put it all together.

Last week I anointed a number of folks from our community. It is an amazing sacrament that brings a deep sense of peace and the presence of Jesus to some very difficult moments where we are looking and wanting to know the presence of Jesus. The anointing is a beautiful reminder that Jesus' journeys with us even when we are unable to see, feel or hear him. Please let me know if you or someone you know would like to celebrate the Anointing of the Sick.

As we celebrate the Eucharist on this Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time we will pick up where we left off in Matthew's gospel last week. We will hear from Matthew 18-21-35. Peter will ask Jesus how many times he needs to forgive someone. Peter says how about if I forgive someone seven times and feels he is being generous by saying seven times. Jesus replies to Peter by saying not seven times but seventy-seven times (a large amount). What we hear is how different God's justice is compared to our human justice. The second servant was unable to extend compassion to his fellow servant and turns to human justice. He refused to serve as an instrument of God's mercy. This can be a difficult gospel to live in our families and communities. What might it look like this upcoming week for you to extend God's mercy to another?

Diocese of Winona-Rochester - Child Sexual Abuse Policy Information

The Diocese of Winona-Rochester will provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employees, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should call the Victim Assistance Coordinator at 507-454-2270, Extension 255. A caller will be asked to provide his or her name and telephone number. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. The Diocese of Winona-Rochester is committed to protecting children, young people and other vulnerable people in our schools, parishes and ministries. The diocesan policy is available on the diocesan web site at www.dowr.org under the Safe Environment Program. Anyone working or volunteering in a Catholic parish or school is a mandated reporter. Anyone who knows or has reason to believe that a minor (a person under the age of 18) or vulnerable adult is or has been abused or neglected, must report all suspected abuse or neglect to proper civil authorities/law enforcement within 24 hours of the abuse or neglect becoming known to him or her and must also follow up with a written report to civil authorities within 72 hours, exclusive of weekends and holidays. Many people working or volunteering in a Catholic parish or school, including clergy, are mandated reporters under state law.
