FR. TOM LOOMIS PASTOR

Welcome to all who are visiting with us and enjoying the St. Felix Fall Festival. Thank you for joining us at Mass. It is extremely impressive to see the work that has to happen to make this weekend a success. Those in leadership and all the volunteers are impressive. Thank you to everyone who has been open and welcoming during the preparation and also to those who will be welcoming to those joining us to celebrate and build community with Jesus at the center of everything we are and do.

At the 11:00 School Mass we are locking the doors at 11:05 for safety reasons. If you are later than that for Mass, stop by the church office and Heather will be able to let you in. I realize this can be inconvenient, but I ask for your patience as the children and their safety have to be a priority.

As we celebrate the Eucharist on this Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we continue to hear from the Gospel of Matthew 20: 1-16a. This is a parable/allegory that many struggle with because it seems to challenge our sense of fairness. Those who are first will be last, and those last shall be first. But if we look deeper into the meaning of this gospel it gives us tremendous hope about God and faith. The owner (God) seeks us out at all times. The owner promises a just wage, thus he is just. The owner is also a sign of mercy. Isn't that the God we are all searching for? Are we able to look with the eyes of faith this week and encounter the God of mercy and love?

ST. FELIX CATHOLIC SCHOOL JOSHUA KRYCH PRINCIPAL

The 2026-2027 school year is well underway and nearing a full month completed. It seems like yesterday the teachers were coming back from summer vacation and we all were preparing for open house. First 4 weeks of school went by extremely fast!! Students and teachers are in a regular routine now and are engaged in those first set of standards for their specific subjects. We have just completed our NWEA Fall district assessments in ELA, Math, and Science. Teachers will be analyzing the data in the upcoming 2 weeks along with administration and making educational decisions. These educational decisions can include, but are not limited to differentiated instruction, revising of lesson plans, and necessary interventions. A more detailed summary of how we are looking like as a school will come in upcoming principal corners.

In the past 2 weeks, there have been several meetings discussing necessary building projects, upgrades, and planning for the future of St. Felix School. There was a look into bathroom upgrades and adding an ADA compliant restroom as part of capital campaign phase 2. A licensed plumber and several parishioners of St. Felix discussed possibilities as they walked thru the school. The next phase is to have some drawings done so that we can start receiving bids on the cost of the project. Another project we are looking at is the repair of the asphalt in the parking lot of the school grounds. Bids and a drawing are being gathered currently. The final project being worked on in a couple of different ways is planning for the future of St. Felix School. One way is setting up an Endowment for funds to build over time to use for school needs. An organization named CSCOE is partnering with St. Felix to assist in marketing, increase of enrollment, grants, and professional development.

St. Felix School today will be celebrating their Fall Festival which is our largest fundraiser of the school year. Please join and support us!!
