I will begin my spiritual direction at the seminary in the next week or two. I will have four seminarians again this year and will meet with them every couple of weeks. The seminarians are amazing young men who are preparing for the priesthood. Please keep them in your prayers during this year.

As we gather to celebrate the Eucharist on the Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, we will continue in Matthew's Gospel 18:15-20. We hear a three-step procedure for reconciling a sinner. It's a powerful reminder that Jesus is in their midst as they discuss what is affecting the community. The forgiveness of another is always a powerful thing for a community, especially when it seems impossible to forgive. We will pick up this theme next week when Peter asks Jesus how often he needs to forgive another. How has forgiveness affected your life? Is it easy to forgive or is it hard to forgive?

At the end of August, St. Felix Catholic School began the 2026-2027 school year with an enrollment of 93 students. This is an increase from last year. Our largest class is pre-school with 17 students and our next biggest class is 6th grade with 13 students. Teachers created engaging activities for the students to participate in day 1 and it was great to see how all the students were quickly following the procedures. Every morning the school participates in a morning message, prayer, and recites the pledge of allegiance in our atrium. In the atrium, we have a new banner that states, "We come to school to learn and leave to serve. Walking as children in the light of Christ". Our focus and mission are that the students/teachers are deepening their faith each day which results in them sharing it within the community in a variety of ways.

St. Felix Catholic School would not be able to continue to make improvements or stay functioning without our donors. We are so grateful for those donors who come forward to support our needs whether its towards a scholarship, paying for a student's tuition, curriculum needs, bonuses/retention for teachers, and necessary upgrades. This week I would like to personally thank Mr. Paul Busch who recently came forward to donate towards our telephone upgrade needed at the school. This project included all new phones for every classroom, a portable phone for our front office, firewall, and a new switchboard. Thank you, Mr. Busch, for your contribution.
