St Felix Facilities Update: June 10, 2024

Three phases of St Felix Church's refurbishing are now completed. The steeple tower was repaired to include replacing old metal and rotten wood, new caulking, ice and water shielding, and adding a copper covering to the tower's ledge.

All brick surfaces of the church were repaired by replacing 1000s of damaged bricks, adding new mortar where needed and the caulking of the limestone decorative trim. The unused chimney was removed, and many holes refilled. The entire structure was then sprayed with breathable moisture retardant to tighten the exterior façade.

St Felix campus sidewalk replacements will be completed by late August. Much of sidewalk are included in the City of Wabasha street project. The remaining concrete work around the church and gym are a capital expense to St Felix.


The rebuilding of the church's exterior window frames, replacing the aged plexiglass and the work on the facia and soffits may be done in 2025, as the road work along Pembroke Avenue continues into the fall.

River Architects has started its Concept Plan with a review of the architectural prints of the church, gym, school and office. Regular updates on their consultation will follow along with opportunities for parishioner participation.
