

- Specific requests pertaining to the service: location of service and reception, choices for flowers, music, scripture readings or poems, clergy or other important requests.
- Your choice of cemetery or desired disposition of your cremated remains.

## Things To Consider...

- Prepayment of your funeral arrangements is a way of securing the costs from inflation.
