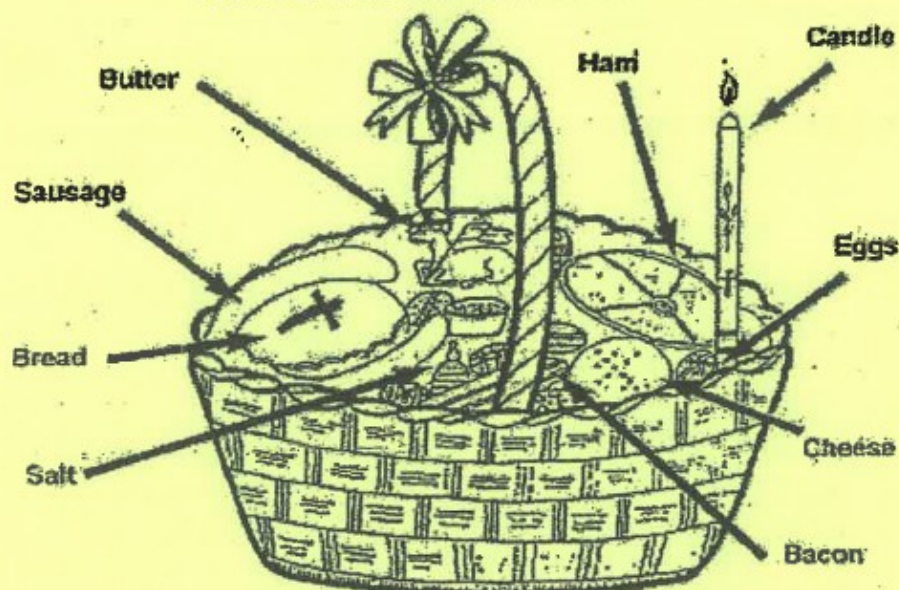
Blessing of the Easter Baskets

Blessing of the Easter Baskets is an Eastern European tradition which takes place on Holy Saturday. A basket is prepared with food, and is taken to the church where the priest blesses it. The food is then taken home and eaten for breakfast on Easter Sunday, Monday and Tuesday.

Many different types of baskets are made in different Christian cultures, and all use beautifully unique traditions. In some places baskets of decorated eggs, or a large Easter Bread is made and brought to the church.

Join in this beautiful tradition by creating your own Easter Basket, Painted Easter Eggs & Easter Breads and bring them to

Traditional foods in the Eastern Easter Basket:



Food is placed in a basket and a ribbon or bow is tied to the handle. A decorated candle is placed in the basket and is lit at the time of blessing. A linen cover is placed over the foods when brought to the church.

Easter Bread - A sweet, yeast bread rich in eggs, butter, etc. Symbolic of Christ Himself who is our True Bread. Usually a round loaf baked with a golden crust decorated with a symbol indicative of Christ. Sometimes a cross of dough is placed on top encircled by a plait giving it a crowned effect, or Greek abbreviations for the name of Christ. The letters XB indicate the Slavonic for "Christ is Risen."

CHEESE - A custard-type cheese shaped into a ball having a rather bland but sweet taste indicative of the moderation that Christians should have in all things.

HAM - The flesh meat popular with eastern Europeans as the main dish because of its richness and symbolic of the great joy and abundance of Easter. Some may prefer lamb or veal.

BUTTER - This favorite dairy product is shaped into the figure of a lamb or small cross and decorated as the cheese. This reminds us of the goodness of Christ that we should have toward all things.

SAUSAGE - A spicy, garlicky sausage of pork products, indicative of God's favor and generosity

BACON - A piece of uncooked bacon cured with spices. Symbolic of the overabundance of God's mercy.

EGGS - Hard boiled eggs brightly decorated with symbols and markings made with beeswax. Indicative of new life and resurrection.

SALT - A condiment necessary for flavor reminding the Christian of his duty to others.
