

## WINNING SCHOTT



**O**n the second hole of a three-man playoff, Freddie Schott broke through with his emotional first DP World Tour victory Sunday at the Bapco Energies Bahrain Championship.

He averaged 354.5 yards off the tee in round 4, and was #1 for the week at 309.9 yards with his G440 MAX driver. Schott led in putts per GIR with a PLD Custom Ketsch putter. He also relied on s259 wedges. See his **What's in the Bag, page 2.**

**P**GA Tour adoption has been swift for the new G440 K driver with its record-setting MOI for a PING driver, and the Tour-winning s259 wedges. At the Farmers Insurance Open,

eight G440 K drivers were in play, helping PING finish second in the driver count.

And 32 s259 wedges were utilized, lifting PING to second in the wedge count.
