3 MORE GLOBAL DRIVER WINS

It was another multiple-win weekend for PING drivers as three models contributed to victories in the U.S., Japan and Korea.

Takumi Kanaya relied on a G440 LST to win the ANA Open, his eighth title on the Japan Golf Tour.

Da Yeon Lee utilized a G440 MAX to claim the Hana Financial Group Championship on the Korea LPGA Tour. Her full bag also included a Scottsdale Oslo 3 putter.

And a G430 LST was in the winner's bag at the PURE Insurance Championship on the PGA Tour Champions. He also played G440 hybrids.

RYDER CUP READY

Harris English for Team USA, and Viktor Hovland and Tyrrell Hatton for defending champions Team Europe are donning team colors for the Ryder Cup that begins Friday at Bethpage Black in Farmingdale, N.Y.



English is one of six players to make the U.S. team on points. This is his second appearance, having first played in 2021.



It will be Hovland's third straight Ryder Cup. He helped contribute 3 1/2 points to Europe's win in Rome two years ago.



Hatton competes for a fourth consecutive time, qualifying on points each time. He accounted for 3 1/2 points in 2023.
