


## HOWELL A STANDOUT AT THE WALKER CUP

mong all the great shot-making at the Walker Cup, Mason Howell's stood out in the U.S. team's convincing victory over Great Britain & Ireland at Cypress Point in Pebble Beach, Calif. The U.S. Amateur champion contributed 2.1/2 points

The U.S. Amateur champion contributed 2 ½ points between foursomes and singles, and he was an

excitable cornerstone of the team. His highlights included a match-sealing eagle in foursomes on Sunday. Even in the practice sessions he was dialed in. On Friday, the 18-year-old riled up his teammates and the gallery with an "albatross", a double-eagle 2 on the par-5 second.

Among Mason Howell's significant shots at the Walker Cup, most electrifying was his hole-out for an eagle 2 on the  $17^{th}$  hole at Cypress Point Sunday to give his team a walk-off win in foursomes. Utilizing his i230 pitching wedge from 147 yards, he one-hopped his shot into the hole to seal the 3-and-1 victory. Watch here. Two holes earlier, Howell dropped in a 30-foot birdie putt on the  $15^{th}$  hole with his PLD Milled Ally Blue 4 putter.



### **TOWNSEND WINS 1ST**

ugo Townsend holed two long birdie putts late on Sunday to earn his first HotelPlanner Tour win at the GAC Rosa Challenge Tour in Konopiska, Poland. He won by two at -15 on four rounds in the 60s (69-63-64-69). "Obviously over the moon," he said, "but it was a stressful, stressful day."

He relied on a G440 driver and fairway, and i240 irons among his PING technology. See What's in the Bag at right.

The victory moved him up on the Road to Mallorca rankings and puts him into contention to gain his DP World Tour card at the end of the season.
