Boat of the Year Fish Contest Rules

1. Only individuals who are members of G.L.S. F. Ozaukee Chapter are eligible for this award.
2. Entry form must be completed and signed by both captain and individual catching the fish.
3. All fish must be taken from the entering boat by rod, reel and line. Minimum weight for entry for Chinook Salmon is 13 pounds. Minimum weight for all other species is 4 pounds. Fish must be weighed on an accurate scale. The official scale is the same as used for the regular club contest at the fish cleaning station in the Port Washington Marina. Accuracy of other scales used may be subject to verification by the contest chairman.
4. All fish registered must be taken during regular legal open season according to all local and state fishing regulations.
5. The "Boat of the Year" award will be given to the captain that registers the highest total using the heaviest of each of the five species allowed in the regular annual contest. In case of a tie, length and girth of fish will be considered the tie-breakers.
6. The captain may register all the fish that he wishes to that are caught by members and non members while fishing on his boat. He may also register his own fish, HOWEVER, any fish he registers for this award may not be counted or entered toward the regular club contest. Fish caught by guest members on board the boat may be registered by the member in the regular contest and by the captain for the boat of the year award.
7. Fish caught during a charter for hire are not eligible for entry in this contest.
8. This contest will run annually between January 1 and December 15 or until cancelled by the Board. All entries must be received by December 20 each year.
