Big Fish Award

Embroidered jacket patches and award certificates will be given to all members meeting or exceeding the trophy weight requirements for the following fish:

Chinook Salmon13 pcLake Trout4 pcBrown Trout4 pc

Coho Salmon Rainbow Trout 4 pounds 4 pounds

In addition, the largest fish of each species registered will be eligible for a club trophy in one of the three divisions; Men's, Women's or Children's. A year-dated button patch will be awarded to members who register the same species in succeeding years.

Fisherperson of the Year Award

The greatest total weight of 5 qualifying fish will qualify the entrant for the Fisher-person of the Year Award in one of the three divisions. *The fisherperson of the year is not eligible for any other individual trophies.*

Catch Five Award Patch

Any member registering one of each of the 5 eligible species at or above the minimum weight requirements listed will receive our "Catch Five" award patch. For this patch, all five species must be taken in one fishing season.

Contest Rules:

- 1. Only active members of G.L.S.F-Ozaukee Chapter and their families are eligible.
- 2. A photograph of each fish entered is required.
- 3. All fish taken from shore or boat must be taken on rod, reel and line with either live bait or artificial lures. Intentional snagging or foul hooking is not permitted.
- 4. All fish must be taken during legal open season by entrant according to local and state regulations.
- 5. Fish must be weighed on official scale at weigh-in station and there must be one witness to the weigh-in.
- 6. Entry forms must be completed in full. Incomplete entry forms are subject to disqualification.
- 7. Deliberate falsification of an entry may be grounds for suspension from GLSF-OZ.
- 8. All entries, including photographs, become the property of GLSF-OZ.
- 9. Trophies will be awarded on the basis of weight. In case of a tie length and girth will determine the winner.
- 10. If there is no entry for a particular species at or above the weight requirement, that trophy will not be awarded for the season.
- 11. All fish caught must be registered within 30 days after catch. This ensures that information will be fresh in the mind of entrant.
- 12. Entries may be turned in at regular membership meetings or mailed to GLSF-Ozaukee Chapter Awards Chairman, PO Box 172, Port Washington, WI 53074.
- 13. Contest runs from January 1 through December 15 each year. All entries must be in by December 20.
- 14. The Children's Division is for children and grandchildren under 15. Individuals 15 and over must compete in the adult class. Anyone 18 years and older is not eligible under a parent's/grandparent's membership.
- 15. Official weigh-in stations are: The weigh-in scales at the fish cleaning station in the Port Washington Marina and Fishermen's Wharf-Milwaukee.
- 16. No one is eligible for more than one award in each category.
