

Fr. Kevin's Korner

THE WITNESSES

It is hard to underestimate the value of a witness. Witnesses play a vital role in establishing the truth of an event. Witnesses need two qualities in particular, courage and trustworthiness or (credibility).

The theme of witness occurs in today's readings. The gospel shows that it was a task given to the apostles, by Christ. The reading from Acts of the Apostles shows them fulfilling that task.

The first Christian community was founded on the resurrection of Jesus. Belief in the resurrection was based on the witness of a relatively small group of people, the eleven apostles and some other disciples.

Peter and the other apostles were the primary witnesses. The witnesses did not claim to have seen the resurrection itself, and no evangelist describes it, but they did claim to have seen the risen Lord.

What kind of witnesses were the apostles? Firstly, they were tremendously courageous witnesses. They were prepared to suffer for the message. And suffer they did, and gladly, as we read in Acts (5:41).

Secondly, they were highly trustworthy (or credible) witness. What comes across very clearly is their utter conviction. They were absolutely certain that they had met Jesus and there was no more to be said about it.

Moreover, lives of holiness and loving service to others made their witness believable. They were living examples of what they preached. The presence of the risen Christ was manifested in the way they lived.

It has been claimed that it was the credulity of the apostles that produced the resurrection. The apostles were not gullible people. Initially they were slow to believe in the resurrection. Even when Jesus showed himself to them, they still doubted. One of them, Thomas, refused to believe until he saw and touched the Lord for himself.

The theory that the resurrection was produced by the faith of the apostles does not hold up. On the contrary, the faith of the apostles was born from the direct experience of the risen Jesus.

Our faith in the risen Christ remains tied to the apostolic witnesses. Only the Easter witnesses "saw and believed," whereas, all the later disciples would be called to believe without seeing. The witnesses serve as a bridge between the earthly Jesus and the ongoing life of the Church.

Now, the baton has been passed to us. Now we are the witnesses. What Christianity needs is not more arguments (words). It needs more witnesses, those who do what the Lord commanded. The fundamental witness of the Christian will always be the authenticity of his/her life. Those who bear witness with their behaviors are the most valuable witnesses of all.

We must not be discouraged by our weakness, or demoralized by our failures. We should take to heart the words of that great witness, St. Teresa of Calcutta. She said, "I don't pray for success; I pray only that I may be a faithful witness."

I do not pray for success, I ask for faithfulness.




