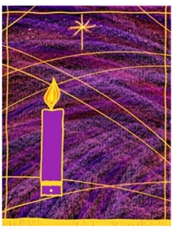

PREPARING IS HALF THE JOY

I once attended a retreat with several of my brother priests, and our retreat master offered us some simple but wise advice about staying healthy. Among his recommendations, he told us to take an annual vacation—not only to go on vacation, but also to *plan* for it. He explained that the preparation and anticipation are at least half the joy.

Each year, the Church celebrates the Incarnation of Christ on December 25th—a date none of us needs to be reminded of. Yet the Church, in her wisdom, gives us a period of preparation beforehand because she knows that anticipation deepens our joy. Advent is that sacred time: a season to prepare our hearts and to joyfully await the coming of Christ at Christmas.

When we speak of preparation, we are not referring simply to shopping or adding more gifts under the tree. While these traditions are not necessarily bad, it is easy to become caught up in the consumerist rush of the season. Instead, today's readings invite us to prepare *spiritually*—both as individuals and as a community.

The Advent wreath, which we light today, is a beautiful sign of our waiting and our hope. As each candle is lit, the light grows, and so does our sense of joyful anticipation as the celebration of Christ's birth draws near.

This is also a time for personal reflection. Is there a small change we could make that would bring the light of Advent more fully into the lives of those around us? Could we say "thank you" a bit more often? Could we be more attentive in caring for our homes—cleaning up after ourselves rather than leaving work for someone else? (After all, laundry does not walk itself to the hamper!) If we have neglected the practice of praying before and after meals, Advent is a wonderful time to revive this simple but meaningful habit. And perhaps we might find one quiet hour each week to spend with the Lord in the Adoration Chapel.

Advent challenges us to prepare a place for Christ—in our homes, in our hearts, and in our daily actions. Give this challenge some thought and then take one step toward it. In this preparation lies half the joy of the Christian life.

PREPARARSE ES LA MITAD DE LA ALEGRÍA

Una vez asistí a un retiro con varios de mis hermanos sacerdotes, y nuestro maestro de retiro nos ofreció un consejo sencillo pero sabio para mantenernos sanos. Entre sus recomendaciones, nos dijo que tomásemos unas vacaciones anuales, no solo para irnos de vacaciones, sino también para planificarlas. Explicó que la preparación y la anticipación son al menos la mitad de la alegría.

Cada año, la Iglesia celebra la Encarnación de Cristo el 25 de diciembre, una fecha que ninguno de nosotros necesita que nos recuerden. Sin embargo, la Iglesia, en su sabiduría, nos da un periodo de preparación previa porque sabe que la anticipación profundiza nuestra alegría. El Adviento es ese tiempo sagrado: una temporada para preparar nuestros corazones y esperar con alegría la venida de Cristo en Navidad.

Cuando hablamos de preparación, no nos referimos simplemente a comprar o a añadir más regalos bajo el árbol. Aunque estas tradiciones no son necesariamente malas, es fácil dejarse llevar por la avalancha consumista de la temporada. En cambio, las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a prepararnos *espiritualmente*, tanto como individuos como como comunidad.

La corona de Adviento, que encendemos hoy, es una hermosa señal de nuestra espera y esperanza. A medida que se enciende cada vela, la luz crece, y también nuestro sentido de alegre anticipación a medida que se acerca la celebración del nacimiento de Cristo.

Este también es un momento para la reflexión personal. ¿Hay algún pequeño cambio que podamos hacer para que la luz del Adviento se refleje más plenamente en la vida de quienes nos rodean? ¿Podríamos decir "gracias" un poco más a menudo? ¿Podríamos ser más atentos al cuidar nuestros hogares—limpiar después de nosotros mismos en vez de dejar el trabajo a otra persona? (¡Al fin y al cabo, la colada no se arrastra sola hasta el cesto!) Si hemos descuidado la práctica de rezar antes y después de las comidas, el Adviento es un momento maravilloso para revivir este hábito simple pero significativo. Y quizá encontremos una hora tranquila cada semana para pasar con el Señor en la Capilla de la Adoración.

El Adviento nos desafía a preparar un lugar para Cristo: en nuestros hogares, en nuestros corazones y en nuestras acciones diarias. Piensa en este reto y luego da un paso hacia él. En esta preparación reside la mitad de la alegría de la vida cristiana.

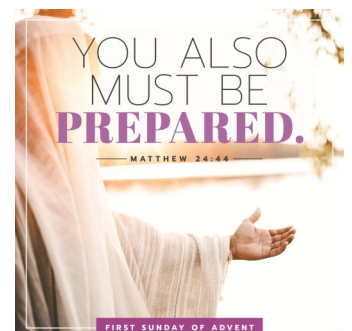

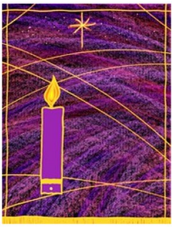

GOSPEL MEDITATION

November 30, 2025—First Sunday of Advent

Matthew: 24:37-44



A few years ago, my house was broken into on Super Bowl Sunday. Turns out, it's a great day for burglars. If the TV isn't on, people are probably watching the game somewhere else, so ... easy pickins'. I'll never forget walking into my bedroom and realizing someone had been there. My stuff was thrown all over the floor. The closet was torn apart. It was disorienting and disturbing — someone had invaded the space I thought was secure. After that, I bought an alarm system. And every Super Bowl Sunday since, I'm extra careful to lock the doors and keep the lights on. That experience made me more alert. Not scared. Just attentive.

That's much like the spiritual place Jesus wants us to be on this first Sunday of Advent. He doesn't start the season with soft candlelight and cozy manger scenes. He starts with two brutal images: a flood and a thief. In other words, chaos and violation.

Why? Because life will flood us. Chaos will come. And in the midst of it, Christ will come like a thief — not to steal from us, but to steal us back. He is the intruder we should want. The one who breaks in, not to ransack, but to rescue. Christ presents himself as the thief but also the new Noah. He builds the ark of the Church to carry us through the flood. And he invites us to join him. How? By participating fully in our parishes. By making our homes places of prayer. By guarding our hearts with truth. By refusing to let spiritual complacency leave us exposed. By repentance.

This Advent, don't just stay vaguely "awake." Prepare. Build. Watch. The flood will come. But so will he.

Mateo 24:37-44

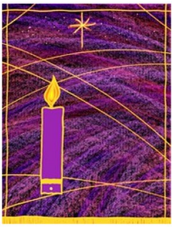

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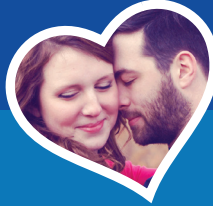
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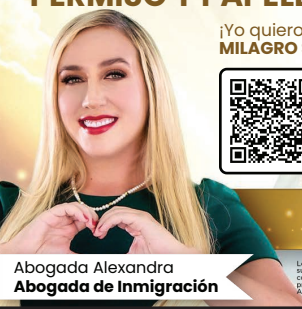
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
