Fr. Kevin's Korner

Celebrating the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul

Today we celebrate the feast of Saints Peter and Paul. It is a very ancient feast going back to around the year 250 A.D. The two are honored because they are the two apostles whom we know the most. They were the greatest influence on the Church at its beginning. Tradition has it they died together in Rome during the persecution of the Emperor Nero.

Peter was crucified upside down; again tradition has it he did not consider himself worthy of dying in the same way his Master had died. Paul was beheaded. Although Paul was a Jew, he also was legally, by birth, a Roman citizen. Roman law decreed that Roman citizens could not be crucified because it was such a horrific way to die and being exempt from crucifixion was one of the perks of being a Roman citizen.

We do not know if Paul ever saw Jesus in the flesh. Paul was born in Tarsus, a city in Asia Minor, which is now modern day Turkey. He spoke Greek and Aramaic and wrote all of his letters in Greek. He was a Pharisee and was totally dedicated to the observance of Jewish law and traditions. He was such a zealous devotee to the Jewish Law that he would go looking for believers in Jesus to arrest them and prosecute them. It was on such a journey to Damascus that the Risen Christ spoke to Paul. In his encounter with Jesus, he discovered Jesus was not a heretic and condemned criminal, but the glorified Lord who has risen from the dead and lives in his Church. He would learn that his mission would be to the Gentiles and that the good news Jesus proclaimed was to be preached to all people. This is when Paul became an Apostle. The word "Apostle" means "one who has been sent." He would come to understand how we are saved by Jesus's death and resurrection and by our incorporation into this saving event through three things: faith, the sacraments, especially baptism and the Eucharist and our love for one another.



As I conclude, we might recall the most famous lines Paul wrote, "*love is kind, love is patient, love is not jealous, it is not pompous...*" and ending with the sentence, "*love never fails.*" The kind of love Paul talks about is a love that is rooted in Christ. We express that love as we gather here in faith, giving God our time and worship and praying for one another. May we continue to express that same love for one another throughout the coming week.

Celebración de la fiesta de los santos Pedro y Pablo

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de los santos Pedro y Pablo. Es una fiesta muy antigua, que se remonta alrededor del año 250 d.C. Los dos son honrados porque son los dos apóstoles que más conocemos. Fueron la mayor influencia en la Iglesia en sus comienzos. La tradición dice que murieron juntos en Roma durante la persecución del emperador Nerón.

Pedro fue crucificado cabeza abajo; De nuevo, la tradición dice que no se consideró digno de morir de la misma manera que había muerto su Maestro. Pablo fue decapitado. Aunque Pablo era judío, también era legalmente, por nacimiento, ciudadano romano. La ley romana decretaba que los ciudadanos romanos no podían ser crucificados porque era una forma horrible de morir y estar exento de la crucifixión era una de las ventajas de ser ciudadano romano.

No sabemos si Pablo alguna vez vio a Jesús en la carne. Pablo nació en Tarso, una ciudad de Asia Menor, que hoy es Turquía. Hablaba griego y arameo y escribía todas sus cartas en griego. Era fariseo y estaba totalmente dedicado a la observancia de la ley y las tradiciones judías. Era un devoto tan celoso de la Ley judía que iba a buscar a los creyentes en Jesús para arrestarlos y procesarlos. Fue en ese viaje a Damasco que Cristo resucitado habló a Pablo. En su encuentro con Jesús, descubrió que Jesús no era un hereje y un criminal condenado, sino el Señor glorificado que ha resucitado de entre los muertos y vive en su Iglesia. Aprendería que su misión sería con los gentiles y que las buenas nuevas que Jesús proclamó debían ser predicadas a todas las personas. Fue entonces cuando Pablo se convirtió en apóstol. La palabra "Apóstol" significa "uno que ha sido enviado". Llegaría a comprender cómo somos salvados por la muerte y resurrección de Jesús y por nuestra incorporación a este evento salvador a través de tres cosas: la fe, los sacramentos, especialmente el bautismo y la Eucaristía y nuestro amor mutuo.

Para concluir, podríamos recordar las frases más famosas que escribió Pablo: *"el amor es bondadoso, el amor es paciente, el amor no es celoso, no es pomposo..."* y terminando con la frase: *"El amor nunca falla"*. El tipo de amor del que habla Pablo es un amor que está arraigado en Cristo. Expresamos ese amor mientras nos reunimos aquí con fe, dando a Dios nuestro tiempo y adoración y orando los unos por los otros. Ruego que sigamos expresando ese mismo amor los unos por los otros a lo largo de la próxima semana.

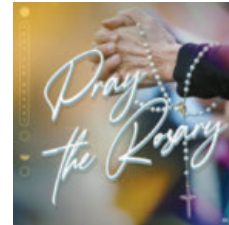

ADULT FAITH Formation

“Beyond the Baltimore Catechism
to the Living Magisterium”

How does the Catholic Church teach authoritatively—and how are the faithful called to respond?

Many of us were formed by the clear certainties of the Baltimore Catechism. But few were ever invited to explore how Church teaching actually works—how doctrine develops, why not all teachings carry the same weight, and what it means to assent faithfully as mature Catholics.

You are invited to join **Edward Speed**, theologian and retired business executive, for a presentation of adult theological formation. We will explore the **Magisterium**—the Church’s living teaching office—with special attention to:

- The development of doctrine
- The “levels” of the magisterium

How we as Catholics today are called to respond with both reverence and understanding to the different levels of authentic teaching.

This is especially suited for those seeking a deeper, more mature understanding of not just **WHAT** our Church teaches us but just as importantly **HOW** our Church teaches us.

Edward holds a Master’s Degree in Systematic Theology from St. Mary’s University where he was named a distinguished graduate in Theology, and later named a Distinguished Alumni. He also taught theology at St. Mary’s.

IN THE PARISH**GOSPEL MEDITATION****June 29, 2025: Sts. Peter & Paul Apostles****Matthew 16:13-19**

What do you call brothers who are born on the same day? Twins, of course. That is what we celebrate today in the inestimable saints, Peter and Paul. Wait: twins? Yes. The early Church believed that Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome on the same day. Since the day of martyrdom is celebrated as a saints' birth into eternal life, the result is striking: Peter and Paul are twins in God's family, the Church.

Who should care about this? Well, anyone who longs to live in a world marked by love and peace. Remember, the Romans believed that twins, Romulus and Remus, founded their city through an act of fratricide, the former murdering the latter. Sadly, the structures of this fallen world emerge through violence between those who should love each other. But in the Church, a new city has been founded upon this new



set of twins, embodying the non-violent power of Jesus' cross and resurrection.

That's why traditional icons represent Peter and Paul in a fraternal and warm embrace. Contrasted with the violence of Rome's founders, it challenges us with a bold claim: do we believe that structures of merciful love are more powerful and lasting than those based on power, violence, and domination? Am I willing to see others in my life as my "twin," with whom I am called to give my life for Christ, or as my rival? Am I committed to living what is embodied in Romulus and Remus, or in Peter and Paul? — Father John Muir

Let us take a moment to remember all those people in the world who are not free to seek life, liberty or happiness.

O God,
you willed that the Jewish people be free from slavery by their Egyptian captors.
You will that all people should be free to worship you without fear
and to celebrate their religious beliefs freely,
even if they have not yet found you.
Grant that those of us who live in this great nation
will thank you daily for our freedom,
and work for the freedom of others around the world
that do not yet have the freedom to practice their faith openly and
proudly.

We seek your wisdom where hatred abounds, and ask for humility to
offer our good works to others who live in fear and bondage.

We ask all this through Christ our Lord,
who frees us from sin and death through the wood of the cross.

Amen.



EN LA PARROQUIA

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

29 de junio de 2025: Solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo

Celebramos hoy, al mismo tiempo, la fiesta de san Pedro y san Pablo. Ellos colaboraron para la construcción del Reino de Dios. Dieron testimonio del Evangelio con su propia vida. Todos sabemos que, en las horas de la pasión, San Pedro negó a Cristo. Por su parte, san Pablo, antes de ser llamado a ser apóstol, fue perseguidor de los cristianos. Pedro se arrepintió y llegó a ser el primer Papa, murió mártir. Pablo, convertido al cristianismo, fue fiel seguidor y propagador del Evangelio y también fue mártir. ¿En qué imitas a estos grandes seguidores de Jesucristo?

“Jesús asigna a Simón este nuevo nombre: ‘Pedro’, que en la lengua de Jesús suena Kefa, una palabra que significa roca. En la Biblia, este término, roca, se refiere a Dios. Jesús lo asigna a Simón no por sus cualidades o sus méritos humanos, sino por su fe genuina y firme, que les ha dado de lo alto. La gloriosa herencia de Pedro y Pablo es una llamada a vivir las virtudes cristianas, de modo particular la fe y la caridad. La fe en Jesús: como Mesías e Hijo de Dios, que Pedro profesó primero y que Pablo anunció a la gente; y la caridad, que la iglesia está llamada a servir con horizonte universal” (Papa Francisco). La historia de estos apóstoles no fue fácil; tuvieron muchas dificultades. Sin embargo, son los cimientos de nuestra Iglesia. Cada uno de ellos fue único y se dejó tocar por Jesús. Pidamos hoy ser rocas firmes en nuestra fe, y caminemos con esperanza a pesar de las dificultades, teniendo la seguridad de que Jesús va con nosotros.

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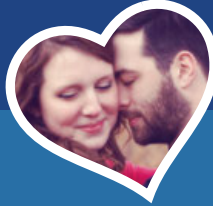

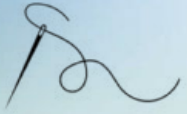
