Fr. Kevin's Korner

JULY 4TH

The 4th of July is a day of Parades, Political Speeches, Fireworks, and Backyard Barbecues.

But most of all it is a day of celebrating our Independence. An independence, which was and is maintained by the sacrifice of many lives.

We are celebrating an independence that is not absolute. Adam, the first man, thought he had an absolute independence, and we are still suffering from the effects of it.

Only God has absolute Independence.

Our independence is rooted in our dependence on God. This dependence on God is clearly stated in our 'Declaration of Independence.'

It begins with these words: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, and that we are endowed by their creator with unalienable rights..."

And it ends: With a firm reliance on Divine Providence we pledge our Lives, our Fortunes and our Honor.

Our nation was founded on belief in God.

The president takes his oath of office by placing his hand on the Bible, the word of God and it ends with..."So help me, God."

In our Pledge of Allegiance we say..."One nation under God."

Engraved on our money is..."In God we Trust."

What our Constitution guarantees is not freedom **from** religion, but freedom **of** religion. Freedom to practice religion.

Today I would like to conclude with a prayer written by George Washington.

PRAYER FOR OUR NATION

"I now make it my earnest prayer, that God would have these United States in His holy protection, that He would incline the hearts of the citizens to cultivate a spirit of subordination and obedience to Government. To entertain a brotherly affection and Love for one another, for their fellow citizens of the United States at large, and particularly for the brethren, who have served in the field, and finally that He would most graciously be pleased to dispose us all, to do justice, to love mercy, and to demean ourselves with that charity, humility, and pacific temper of mind, which were the characteristics of the Divine Author of our blessed Region, and without a humble imitation of whose example in these things, we can never hope to be a happy Nation."

I hope you will have a great holiday. I hope that as you celebrate today, you will pause to be grateful to God, the source of freedom, and to be grateful to those who have gone before us in this life who have entrusted to us the freedom and the blessings we enjoy.

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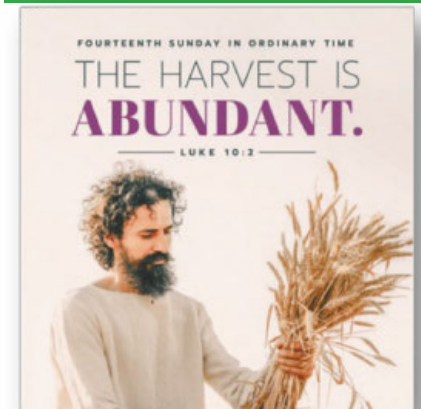

ADULT FAITH Formation

“Beyond the Baltimore Catechism
to the Living Magisterium”

Date: Tuesday, July 8
Time: 9:40 a.m.- 10:50 a.m.

How does the Catholic Church teach authoritatively—and how are the faithful called to respond?

Many of us were formed by the clear certainties of the Baltimore Catechism. But few were ever invited to explore how Church teaching actually works—how doctrine develops, why not all teachings carry the same weight, and what it means to assent faithfully as mature Catholics.

You are invited to join **Edward Speed**, theologian and retired business executive, for a presentation of adult theological formation. We will explore the **Magisterium**—the Church’s living teaching office—with special attention to:

- The development of doctrine
- The “levels” of the magisterium

How we as Catholics today are called to respond with both reverence and understanding to the different levels of authentic teaching.

This is especially suited for those seeking a deeper, more mature understanding of not just **WHAT** our Church teaches us but just as importantly **HOW** our Church teaches us.

Edward holds a Master’s Degree in Systematic Theology from St. Mary’s University where he was named a distinguished graduate in Theology, and later named a Distinguished Alumni. He also taught theology at St. Mary’s.

*IN THE PARISH***GOSPEL MEDITATION****July 6, 2025 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time****Luke 10:1-12, 17-20**

In the days after the awful 2020 killing of George Floyd, a Catholic friend remarked, "Racism is today's great evil. We should put all our energy into fighting it." I admired her intuition that the church must stand firmly against evil. Amen, I thought. At the same time, something felt wrong. As months went by, I saw her steadily slide into bitterness and anger. Soon, despondency. She spoke of giving up the fight. Don't we too wonder how to fight evil without losing our joy or energy?

Jesus' words this week help. He says, "Rejoice not that you have power over demons, but that your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10:20). Notice the asymmetry in where he wants our focus: on the latter, not the former. Should we confidently embrace our God-given power to overcome evil? Absolutely. But even more so, we should emphasize the positive element of our relationship to God. It is tempting but dangerous to define ourselves by what we oppose. It is better to define ourselves by—to rejoice in—what we celebrate: in Jesus, God has written our names in heaven. This sustains our battles.



This week, our marching orders are: fight evil. But more deeply, rejoice that God knows and loves us personally, individually. We allow this joyful knowledge to undergird our fight against the darkness of our day. Then we enjoy long-term stability to be cheerful warriors, who never forget the reason for the contests we are called to fight and win: love. — *Father John Muir*

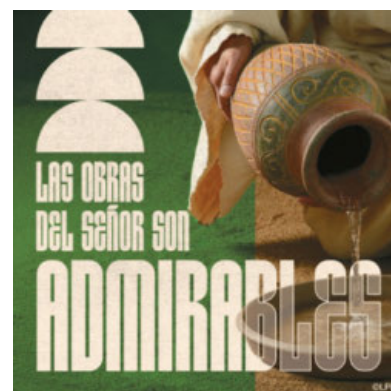
MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

6 de julio de 2025: XIV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 10:1-12, 17-20

La finalidad de este domingo es anunciar el Reino de Dios. Por ello, Dios envía a los discípulos de dos en dos. De esa forma es como se forma una comunidad misionera. Jesús los entrena para la misión, para ir, para salir fuera y mirar a los hermanos y hermanas en la periferia. ¿Qué necesitan? ¿Cómo viven? Es urgente que nos demos cuenta para participar en esta misión encomendada. La cosecha es abundante y los misioneros, pocos. "Rueguen, pues, al dueño de la cosecha que envíe obreros a su cosecha" (Lucas 10:2).

Esta petición de Jesús sigue en pie y nos invita a orar por nuestros sacerdotes, seminaristas, religiosos y religiosas que día a día trabajan para que el Reino de Dios crezca y reine la paz en sus comunidades. También tengamos presente en nuestra oración a los misioneros y misioneras laicos que luchan en silencio por esparcir la semilla del Evangelio entre los suyos. "Siempre debemos orar al dueño de la mies, que es Dios Padre, para que envíe obreros a trabajar en su campo, que es el mundo. Y cada uno de nosotros lo debe hacer con el corazón abierto, con una actitud misionera; nuestra oración no debe limitarse solo a nuestras peticiones, a nuestras necesidades: una oración es verdaderamente cristiana si también tiene una dimensión universal" (Papa Francisco). Nosotros, como bautizados, formamos parte de ese grupo misionero de Jesús. ¡Atrévete a ser un misionero comprometido!

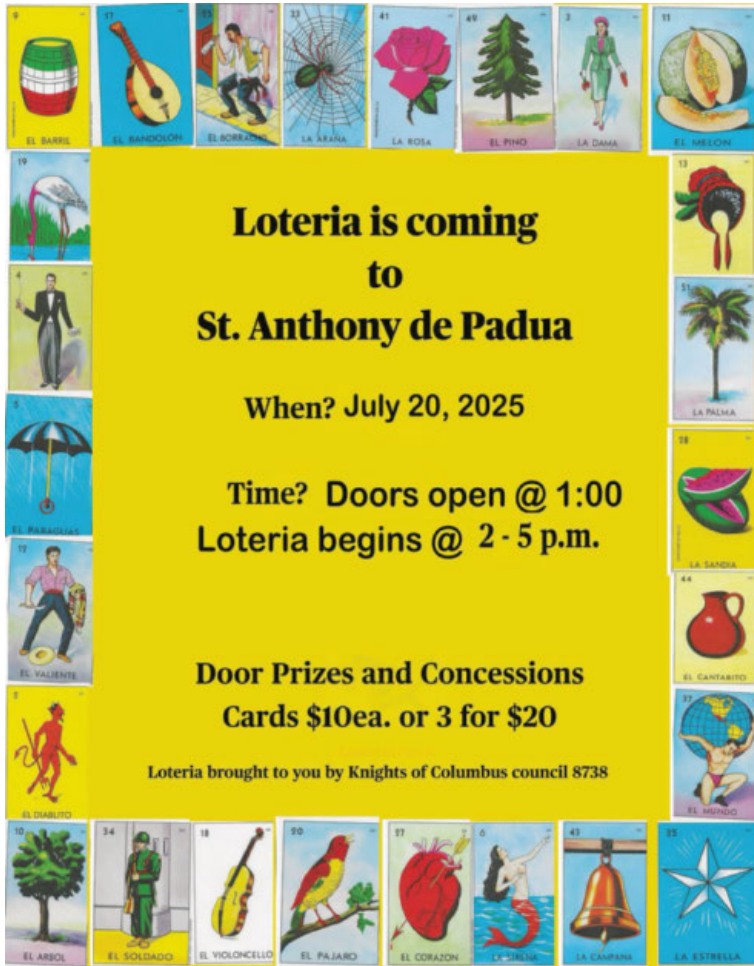

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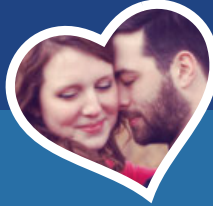

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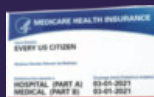
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
