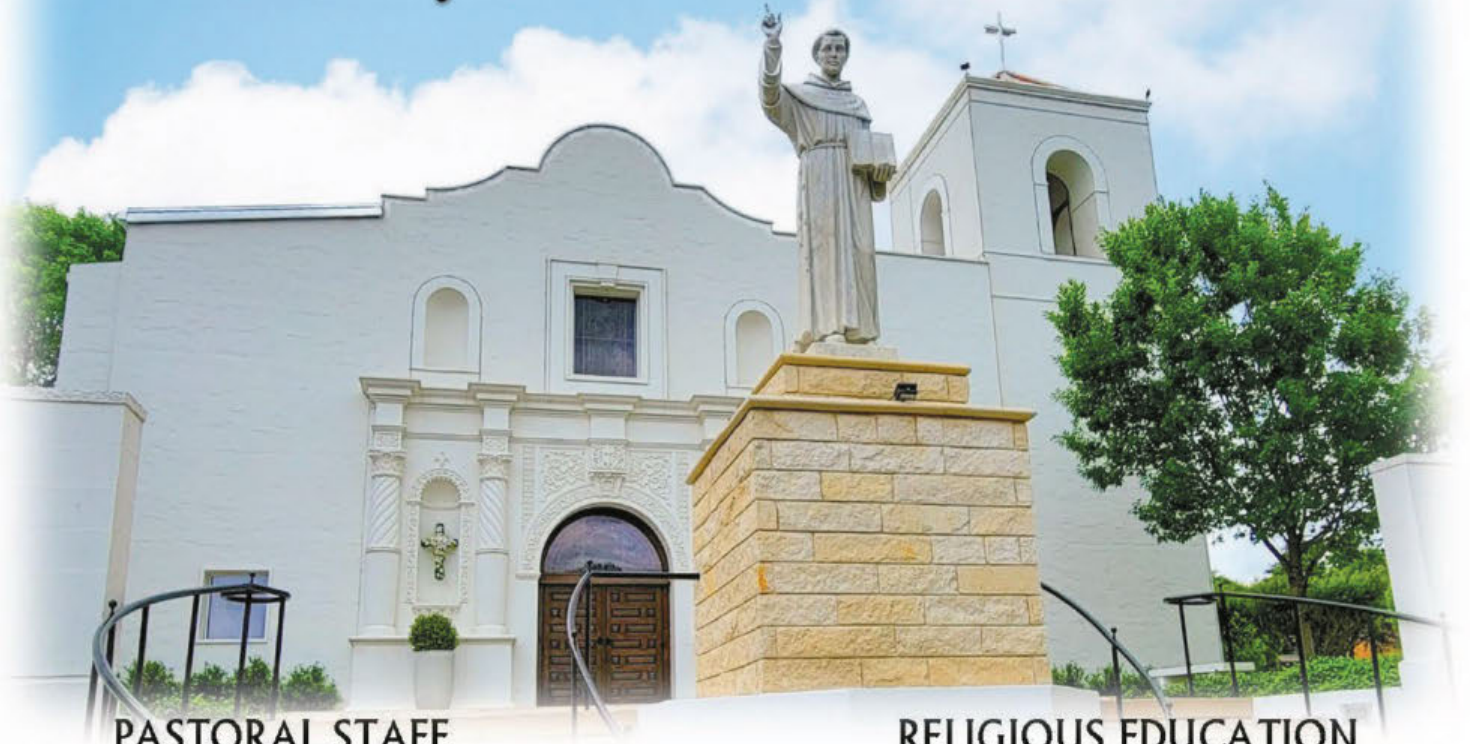

Fr. Kevin's Korner

THE ROAD FROM JERUSALEM TO JERICHO

"A man was going down the road..." Jesus does not attach any religious or social labels to the man, though it is reasonable to assume he was a Jew. Was he a good man or a bad man? Was he an important man or an unimportant man? These questions are irrelevant. He was a human being. That is all that matters.

'He was set upon by bandits...' Heartless, violent men, who prey on the weak. Jesus lived in the real world. He knew that such people existed. We know about them too.

'A priest and a Levite saw him lying there half dead... but passed him by.' The priest and the Levite were religious people. Yet they did not even feel compassion for the wounded man. Religion without compassion is a contradiction. Without compassion one cannot call oneself a true human being, never mind a truly religious person.

'A Samaritan came along...' He saw the wounded man, felt compassion for him, and went at once to his aid. He did not worry about the trouble it caused him. Nor was he put off by the fact that the man was a Jew, Jews and Samaritan's were enemies at that time.

At the start of the story, we know extraordinarily little about the priest, the Levite, and the Samaritan. At the end of it we still do not know much about them. Yet we know all that matters. We know the kind of people they were. Their characters have been revealed to us.

The priest and the Levite were self-centered people. When the crunch came, they put themselves first. The Samaritan, on the other hand, was an unselfish person. He put the other person first.

The priest and the Levite were guilty of the sin of omission. Sins of omission may be our worst sins, yet we think if we do not do harm to anyone, we are okay. But, we watched someone being hurt and not intervening on his/her behalf.

The Samaritan was a carer. Carers are incredibly special people. They do not care about a sense of duty. They care because their hearts will not allow them to do otherwise.



Each of us has the capacity to care. Small opportunities to care come our way every day. It is within our power to say a kind word, to offer a little sympathy, to give a little support.

The road from Jerusalem to Jericho represents the road of life. At the end of the story Jesus said to the lawyer, *"Go and act like the Samaritan."*

Those words are spoken to us too. And since we are still on the road, we can still carry them out.

EL CAMINO DE JERUSALÉN A JERICÓ

"Un hombre iba por el camino..." Jesús no le atribuye ninguna etiqueta religiosa o social al hombre, aunque es razonable suponer que era judío. ¿Era un hombre bueno o un hombre malo? ¿Era un hombre importante o un hombre insignificante? Estas preguntas son irrelevantes. Era un ser humano. Eso es todo lo que importa.

"Fue atacado por bandidos..." Hombres desalmados y violentos, que se aprovechan de los débiles. Jesús vivió en el mundo real. Sabía que tales personas existían. Nosotros también sabemos de ellos.

"Un sacerdote y un levita lo vieron tendido allí medio muerto..." pero le pasó de largo. El sacerdote y el levita eran personas religiosas. Sin embargo, ni siquiera sintieron compasión por el hombre herido. La religión sin compasión es una contradicción. Sin compasión uno no puede llamarse a sí mismo un verdadero ser humano, y mucho menos una persona verdaderamente religiosa.

"Llegó un samaritano..." Vio al herido, sintió compasión por él y acudió en su ayuda. No se preocupó por los problemas que le causaba. Tampoco se desanimó por el hecho de que el hombre fuera judío, los judíos y los samaritanos eran enemigos en ese momento.

Al comienzo de la historia, sabemos extraordinariamente poco sobre el sacerdote, el levita y el samaritano. Al final de la misma todavía no sabemos mucho sobre ellos. Sin embargo, sabemos todo lo que importa. Sabemos el tipo de personas que eran. Sus personajes nos han sido revelados.

El sacerdote y el levita eran personas egocéntricas. Cuando llegó la hora de la verdad, se pusieron a sí mismos en primer lugar. El samaritano, por otro lado, era una persona desinteresada. Puso a la otra persona en primer lugar.

El sacerdote y el levita eran culpables del pecado de omisión. Los pecados de omisión pueden ser nuestros peores pecados, sin embargo, pensamos que si no hacemos daño a nadie, estamos bien. Pero vimos a alguien que era herido y no intervenía en su nombre.

El samaritano era un cuidador. Los cuidadores son personas increíblemente especiales. No les importa el sentido del deber. Se preocupan porque sus corazones no se lo permitirán. Cada uno de nosotros tiene la capacidad de preocuparse. Pequeñas oportunidades para cuidar se nos presentan todos los días. Está en nuestro poder decir una palabra amable, ofrecer un poco de simpatía, dar un poco de apoyo.

El camino de Jerusalén a Jericó representa el camino de la vida. Al final de la historia, Jesús le dijo al intérprete de la ley: *"Ve y actúa como el samaritano"*. Esas palabras también se nos dicen a nosotros. Y como todavía estamos en el camino, todavía podemos llevarlos a cabo.

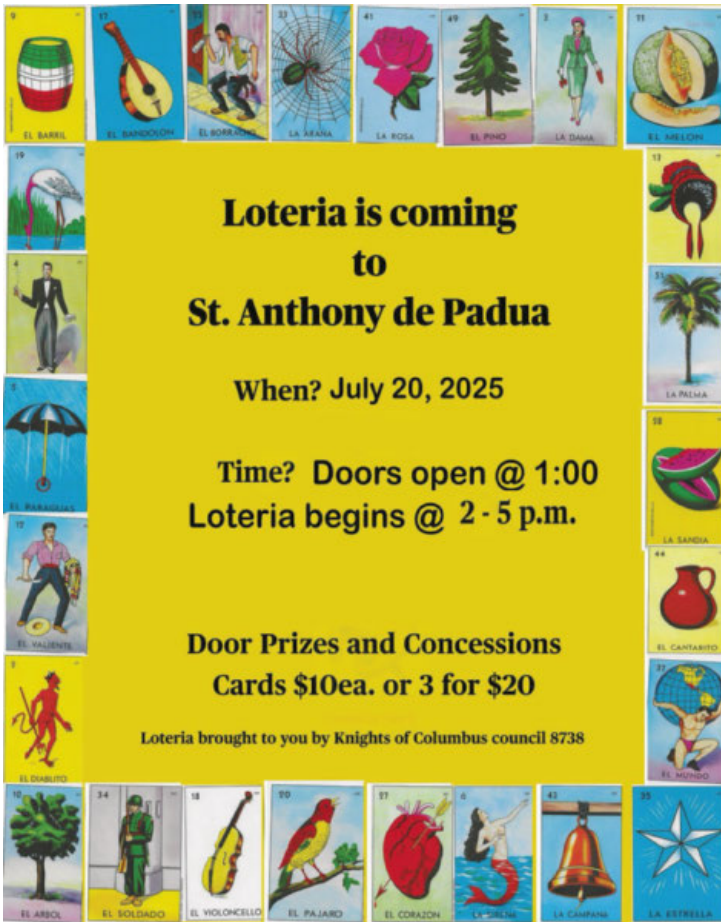

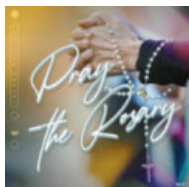

GOSPEL MEDITATION

July 13, 2025 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 10:25-37

I used to be a bad neighbor. I'd get wrapped up in my life and ignore those around me. Then I found sage advice from Benjamin Franklin to this effect: to be a better neighbor, ask someone to do a favor for you. It's counterintuitive, isn't it? Tell strangers that I need their help? Yuck. I'll risk looking needy. Worse, I'll be indebted to them. But I tried it, and it works like a charm. Recently I asked my neighbor Alan for a hacksaw, and Inga for an egg. They kindly obliged, and our friendship is growing.

This week we hear a scribe of the law cynically ask Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" (Luke 10:29). Like him, we prefer to keep the list of our "neighbors" as short as possible. It requires less interruption and inconvenience. But when Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan, he exposes the lonely, cold-heartedness tendency of the scribe's (and our) heart. My "neighbor" is anyone I encounter who manifests a concrete need. There isn't time to require any other credential because human need opens us to the happy reciprocity which is love.



Jesus' words challenge us this week to ask a neighbor for help in some small way. How marvelous that God himself shows us how. He moves into our world and asks us to love Him with small deeds of love. Maybe that's where Ben Franklin got the idea.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

13 de julio de 2025: XV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 10:25-37

"Vete y haz tú lo mismo" (Lucas 10:37). Esta parábola es muy rica en enseñanza. Si revisamos nuestra propia vida, descubriremos que en diferentes circunstancias actuamos como los personajes representados en ella. ¿Cuántas veces hemos sido como el que pasó de largo y se hizo el que no vio lo que pasaba? Y lo hacemos con frecuencia en la propia familia: vemos el sufrimiento y pensamos: "Solo les pasa a ellos por no poner cuidado o por tontos." Hoy pongamos atención en el posadero que, al pedido del buen samaritano, cumplió con su trabajo al pie de la letra. En lenguaje actual se llama responsabilidad y cuidado. Pidamos al Señor que nos dé la apertura e iniciativa del samaritano, pero también la responsabilidad del posadero, para que sanara el hombre que fue asaltado.

¿Cuántas veces nosotros damos rodeos para ayudar a alguien en necesidad? ¿Qué podemos aprender hoy de esta enseñanza de Jesús? El hombre no tiene nombre, precisamente, porque nos representa a cualquiera de nosotros que necesita cuidado. Hombre o mujer de cualquier raza o nación está implícito en esta parábola. ¡Es la historia de la humanidad a través de los años! Sin embargo, existe otro pequeño detalle para dar ayuda al que está en apuros: acercarte y escuchar su historia para poder curar sus heridas. A veces nos toca pagar a alguien para que haga el trabajo; otras veces, hacerlo nosotros. Y es ahí donde está el secreto: hacerlo juntos en Cristo.

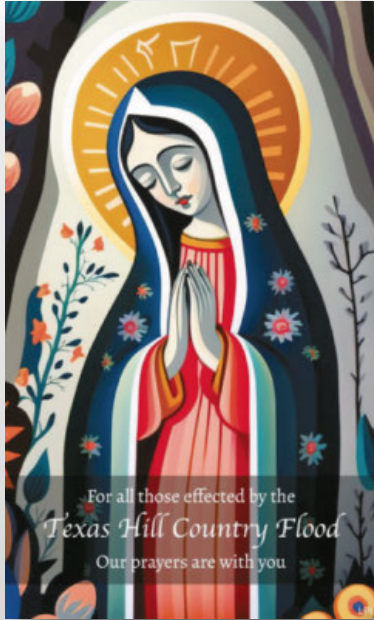

OUTSIDE THE PARISH

Answer Pope Leo XIV's call for peace!

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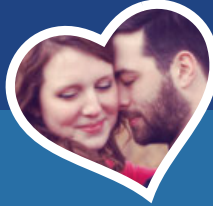


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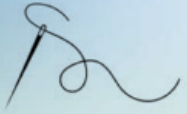
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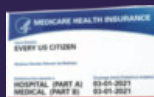
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
