# Fr. Kevin's Korner

## The Lord's Prayer

The Our Father is the first and greatest of all Christian prayers. Its short and simple phrases embrace every relation between God and us. It not only tells us what to pray for, but also how to pray for it.

Properly understood, the Our Father contains a whole program for Christian living. If we were to live up to what it contains, we would be perfectly in tune with the mind of Christ, because undoubtedly this is how he prayed and lived.

### ***The first part deals with God.***

We begin by acknowledging God's existence and calling God "Father." God is a parent to us, and we are his children. Sometimes he acts like a father, and sometimes like a mother.

Then we praise God's name. In praising God's name, we are praising him. We pray for the coming of his kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life, holiness and grace, justice, love, and peace. We have a part to play in making his kingdom a reality. We pray that his will may be done on earth. "On earth" means in our lives too. God's will may not always be the easiest thing to do, but it is always the best thing.

### ***The second part deals with us and our needs.***

We begin by praying for our daily bread. "Bread" stands for all our material needs. All we really need, however, is enough for today. We pray for forgiveness of our own sins, and for grace to be able to forgive those who sin against us. Inability to forgive others makes it impossible for us to receive God's forgiveness. We pray not to be led into temptation. God does not put temptation in our path, but life does. We are asking God to help us cope with the temptations that come to us, and to avoid those of our own choosing.

Finally, we pray to be delivered from all evil, both physical and moral. Once again, we cannot expect never to encounter evil. What we are asking God for is the grace to be victorious over all evil, but especially moral evil.

Unfortunately, like all prayers, the Our Father suffers from repetition, it tends to be said hurriedly and unthinkingly, so that much of its meaning is lost. We need to slow it down and think about the meaning of what we are saying and its implications for our lives. Above all, we must pray for it and not merely say it.

## El Padre Nuestro

El Padre Nuestro es la primera y más grande de todas las oraciones cristianas. Sus frases cortas y sencillas abarcan todas las relaciones entre Dios y nosotros. No solo nos dice por qué orar, sino también cómo orar por ello.

Bien entendido, el Padrenuestro contiene todo un programa para la vida cristiana. Si viviéramos de acuerdo con lo que contiene, estaríamos perfectamente en sintonía con la mente de Cristo, porque indudablemente así es como oró y vivió.

### ***La primera parte trata de Dios.***

Comenzamos reconociendo la existencia de Dios y llamando a Dios "Padre". Dios es un padre para nosotros, y nosotros somos sus hijos. A veces actúa como un padre, y a veces como una madre.

Entonces alabamos el nombre de Dios. Al alabar el nombre de Dios, lo estamos alabando a él. Oramos por la venida de su reino, un reino de verdad y vida, santidad y gracia, justicia, amor y paz. Tenemos un papel que desempeñar para hacer de su reino una realidad. Oramos para que se haga su voluntad en la tierra. "En la tierra" significa también en nuestras vidas. Puede que la voluntad de Dios no siempre sea lo más fácil de hacer, pero siempre es lo mejor.

### ***La segunda parte se ocupa de nosotros y de nuestras necesidades.***

Comenzamos rezando por nuestro pan de cada día. El "pan" representa todas nuestras necesidades materiales. Sin embargo, todo lo que realmente necesitamos es suficiente por hoy. Rezamos por el perdón de nuestros propios pecados, y que la gracia pueda perdonar a los que pecan contra nosotros. La incapacidad de perdonar a los demás hace que sea imposible para nosotros recibir el perdón de Dios. Oramos para no ser llevados a la tentación. Dios no pone la tentación en nuestro camino, pero la vida sí. Le pedimos a Dios que nos ayude a hacer frente a las tentaciones que nos llegan y a evitar las nuestras. Elegir.

Finalmente, oramos para ser liberados de todo mal, tanto físico como moral. Una vez más, no podemos esperar no encontrarnos nunca con el mal. Lo que le pedimos a Dios es la gracia de vencer todo mal, pero especialmente el mal moral.

Desafortunadamente, como todas las oraciones, el Nuestro El padre sufre de repetición, tiende a decirse apresuradamente y sin pensar, por lo que se pierde gran parte de su significado. Necesitamos ir más despacio y pensar en el significado de lo que estamos diciendo y sus implicaciones para nuestras vidas. Sobre todo, debemos rezar por ella y no simplemente decirla.

**IN THE PARISH****GOSPEL MEDITATION****July 27, 2025 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time****Luke 11:1-13**

Once I went to a hospice facility to celebrate Last Rites for elderly dying man. His family had told me that he had been uncommunicative for days. At the conclusion of the ritual, we began to recite the Our Father prayer. To everyone's surprise, his lips moved, clearly mouthing the words to the Lord's prayer. Stripped of most of his faculties, the man could still pray those precious God-given petitions. A lifetime of prayer had planted the words even deeper than his failing consciousness.

Do we want the Lord's prayer to be deeply embedded in us? If we want to be people of hope, we should. Recall that our Lord immediately follows the prayer by saying: "**Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you**" (Luke 11:9). We only ask, search and

knock because we hope that the request is not in vain. Everything we could possibly hope for is contained in the prayer. Praying the Our Father deepens our hope.



We should consciously pour all our hopes into the Lord's prayer; we should allow it to be an expression of hope, not simply rote words. Then, over time, it builds up our hope in God. It sinks deep into our souls and bodies. How blessed we are when these words of hope are on our lips, even when everything else seems to fail.

**EN LA PARROQUIA****MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO**

**27 de julio de 2025: XVII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**  
**Lucas 11:1-13**

¿Te has preguntado alguna vez cuál es la mejor manera de hacer oración? Quizá la respuesta sea "de muchas maneras". A lo mejor explicarás las diferentes formas de hacer oración. Cada persona tiene su experiencia de oración. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en su número 2564, nos ayuda a comprender mejor lo que es orar: "*La oración cristiana es una relación de Alianza entre Dios y el hombre en Cristo. Es la acción de Dios y del hombre; brota del Espíritu Santo y de nosotros, dirigidas por completo al Padre, en unión con la voluntad humana del Hijo de Dios hecho hombre*". Santa Teresa del Niño Jesús, en sus manuscritos autobiográficos, decía sobre su experiencia de oración (C25 r.): "Para mí, la oración es un impulso del corazón, una sencilla mirada hacia el cielo, un grito de agradecimiento y de amor tanto desde dentro de la prueba como desde dentro de la alegría".

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en su número 2759, nos enseña: "Estando él [Jesús] en cierto lugar, cuando terminó, le dijo uno de sus discípulos: 'Maestro, enséñanos a orar, como enseñó Juan a sus discípulos'" (Lucas 11:1). En respuesta a esta petición, el Señor confía a sus discípulos y a su Iglesia la oración cristiana fundamental. San Lucas da de ella un texto breve (con cinco peticiones [Lucas 11:2-4]). San Mateo nos transmite una versión más desarrollada (con siete peticiones [Mateo 6:9-13]). La tradición de la Iglesia ha conservado el texto de San Mateo. El Padrenuestro es fundamental para todo cristiano. Recémoslo siempre con fe.



**DAILY EXAMEN, EXPLAINED!**

The daily examen is a spiritual practice derived from the writings of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus.

A Basque nobleman, Ignatius underwent a series of religious conversions as a young man following a wound sustained in the Battle of Pamplona in 1521. His Spiritual Exercises were first published in 1548 and form the basis of what is known today as "Ignatian spirituality."

Many different versions of the examen have been developed over the centuries, but all are centered on the same five elements which themselves reflect Ignatius' process of self-review and spiritual discernment.

In completing the daily examen, an individual places himself in the presence of God, prayerfully reflecting on the blessings of the day, the actions he took, and the invitation God has for his future decisions.
