

# Fr. Kevin's Korner

## SOMETIMES WE FORGET WHAT IS WORTH REMEMBERING

The love in our speech is not just the words of praise, but the tone of affection and sincere admiration. Words are not neutral. We all know about fighting words. As followers of Christ, we should be committed to loving words.

The song of the birds, the rush of wind and the roar of the ocean waves constitute a symphony that praises God all day and night with love. If nature is designed to praise the Lord, can we not use our tongue to praise God and people? With love in our actions, we travel among the walking wounded. Each person we meet has learned to build up a wall of defense. Most people around us are armed with suspicion and caution. They have been hurt too often. They carry a history of disillusion. Only love in action can disarm them. We tend to fight force with force.

### THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO YOU

You are writing a gospel,  
a chapter each day,  
By deed that you do,  
by words that you say.

Men read what you write,  
whether faithless or true,  
Say, what is the gospel  
according to you?

Men read and admire the  
gospel of Christ,  
With its love so unfailing and true;  
But what do they say,  
and what do they think  
Of the gospel according to you?

'Tis a wonderful story,  
the gospel of love,

What that accomplishes is more hostile aggression.

The principle here is: Whatever we send out comes back to us. All our actions are boomerangs. Send out a message of anger, it will only make us angrier. If we set out to insult, we will feel the impact of the insult. On the other hand, project an act of love and its warmth will return to us. Insist on being affectionate and our souls will feel the glow of that affection. This is true whether the person on whom we focus our love accepts it or not. We must believe, however, that in time our love for others will begin to work for them.

Forgetfulness of the deepest truths is our greatest fault. We not only forget unpleasant things. We also forget how worthwhile remembering is. Today, we are reminded of the Golden Rule, the very core of our religion. Lord, strengthen us in our resolve to recall that love is the very essence of our lives.

## A VECES OLVIDAMOS LO QUE VALE LA PENA RECORDAR

El amor en nuestro discurso no son solo las palabras de elogio, sino el tono de afecto y admiración sincera. Las palabras no son neutrales. Todos conocemos las palabras de lucha. Como seguidores de Cristo, debemos comprometernos a palabras amorosas.

El canto de los pájaros, la ráfaga del viento y el rugido de las olas del mar constituyen una sinfonía que alaba a Dios todo el día y la noche con amor. Si la naturaleza está diseñada para alabar al Señor, ¿no podemos usar nuestra lengua para alabar a Dios y a las personas? Con amor en nuestras acciones, viajamos entre los heridos que caminan. Cada persona que conocemos ha aprendido a construir un muro de defensa. La mayoría de las personas que nos rodean están armadas con sospecha y precaución. Han sido lastimados con demasiada frecuencia. Llevan una historia de desilusión. Solo el amor en acción puede desarmarlos. Tendemos a luchar contra la fuerza con la fuerza. Lo que eso logra es una agresión más hostil.

El principio aquí es: todo lo que enviamos nos regresa. Todas nuestras acciones son bumeranes. Envía un mensaje de ira, solo nos enojará más. Si nos proponemos insultar, sentiremos el impacto del insulto. Por otro lado, proyecta un acto de amor y su calidez volverá a nosotros. Insiste en ser cariñoso y nuestras almas sentirán el brillo de ese afecto. Esto es cierto ya sea que la persona en la que enfocamos nuestro amor lo acepte o no. Sin embargo, debemos creer que con el tiempo nuestro amor por los demás comenzará a funcionar para ellos.

El olvido de las verdades más profundas es nuestra mayor falta. No solo olvidamos las cosas desagradables. También olvidamos lo valioso que es recordar. Hoy, se nos recuerda la Regla de Oro, el núcleo mismo de nuestra religión. Señor, fortalecenos en nuestra resolución de recordar que el amor es la esencia misma de nuestras vidas.






**IN THE PARISH****GOSPEL MEDITATION**

August 24, 2025 —20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 13:22-30

I've been hiking Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Arizona most of my life. It is a vigorous forty-five minutes to the top. Near the peak, the end suddenly appears much further away, and steeper. At that moment, a descending hiker often offers encouragement: "Keep going! The peak is right there. It's not as far as it looks. You can do it!" It usually works. After another five minute push, you summit and enjoy a glorious panorama of the Sonoran Desert in the Valley of the Sun.

When Jesus is asked about how many people are saved, he says: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate" (Luke 13:24). How many? Strive! Focus on your journey. What does heavenly census taking have to do with you or me? How would it help a hiker on a mountain to ask the others coming down, "How many people are going to make it to the top?" A normal response would be something like: "How is that a relevant question? Carry on!"



Jesus links one virtue directly to salvation: perseverance (cf. Matt 24:13; hypomone in Greek). Strive! Endure! Keep going! The one absolutely necessary virtue is perseverance, to not give up on our journey. The mountain we struggle to climb is often our own weakness, failures, and sins. Persevere in prayer. Keep celebrating the sacraments. Embrace daily duties. With God's grace, you are strong enough to keep going. Perhaps the peak is not as far away as you might fear. Keep going!

**EN LA PARROQUIA****MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO****24 de Agosto de 2025: XXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario****Lucas 13:22-30**

¿Has intentado alguna vez o has tenido la experiencia de entrar por alguna puerta angosta? Es incómodo y te sientes apretado si intentan entrar más de dos personas al mismo tiempo. Nos gustan las puertas anchas, altas y bonitas. La puerta angosta es para entrar de uno en uno, no más. *"Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta angosta, porque yo les digo que muchos tratarán de entrar y no lo lograrán"* (Lucas 13:24). La manera de hablar de Jesús es diferente a otras ocasiones. Habla claro y directo: dice "esfuércense". Nada es fácil; moldear la arcilla de lo que estamos hechos requiere de esfuerzo.

El Evangelio de hoy también nos advierte: *"Unos que estaban entre los últimos son ahora los primeros, mientras que los primeros han pasado a ser los últimos"* (Lucas 13:30). ¡Qué sorpresa tan grande! Dios no nos reconocerá por nuestros títulos ni por los puestos de importancia en la sociedad, mucho menos por la riqueza y las propiedades. Así que, ahora sí, se comprende el mensaje de esforzarse para entrar por la puerta angosta. *"Ahora considero un deber mío explicarles por qué la puerta es angosta."*

*Cualesquiera que desee entrar, primero, y antes que nada, tiene que poseer una fe honrada e incontaminada; en segundo lugar, una vida sin mancha, sin pecado, en la que no existan posibilidades de culpa, conforme a la medida de la justicia humana"* (San Cirilo de Alejandría, 375-444, Comentario al Evangelio de San Lucas).


