## Fr. Kevin's Korner

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The readings today center on mindfulness, awareness of where we stand in God's plan. The mountain of Sinai carries a message of the majesty and distance of God, while Jesus' presence as host of the banquet speaks of intimacy and mystery. September's shadow calls us all to mindfulness as we prepare to return to life outside of summer. The Christian life holds these two places of knowledge of God in careful balance. Even in the accounts of the Passion we see the table in the upper room in balance with the Mount of Olives.

Altar means "high place," yet it is also a table. The former liturgy of the Latin Rite began with the priest bowing at the foot of the altar's three steps, chanting *Introibo ad altare Dei*, or "I will go to the altar of God," followed by the altar servers' response, "The God who gives joy to my youth." Many parishioners can recall and recite this scene by heart.



As with so many things in liturgy, there are layers of meaning in our worship. The altar table evokes memories of the high places once reserved for encounter with the holy, and the intimacy of the table where hospitality draws us to share food and drink.

### HOME BOYS, HOME

'And its home boys, home. Home, I like to be. Home for a while in the old country, where the oak and the ash and the bonny rowan tree, are all growing greener in the old country.' I enjoyed my trip to the 'old country' to visit with family, and friends. They are all keeping well, thank God. I am deeply grateful to Fr. Alan Whelan and the parish staff for "minding the house" while I was on holiday. I will be back in the office soon, so let us keep things light.

### TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Las lecturas de hoy se centran en la atención plena, la conciencia de dónde nos encontramos en el plan de Dios. La montaña del Sinaí lleva un mensaje de la majestad y la distancia de Dios, mientras que la presencia de Jesús como anfitrión del banquete habla de intimidad y misterio. La sombra de septiembre nos llama a todos a la atención plena mientras nos preparamos para volver a la vida fuera del verano. La vida cristiana mantiene estos dos lugares de conocimiento de Dios en un cuidadoso equilibrio. Incluso en los relatos de la Pasión vemos la mesa del aposento alto en equilibrio con el Monte de los Olivos.

Altar significa "lugar alto", pero también es una mesa. La antigua liturgia del rito latino comenzaba con el sacerdote inclinándose al pie de los tres escalones del altar, cantando Introibo ad altare Dei, o "Iré al altar de Dios", seguido de la respuesta de los monaguillos: "El Dios que da alegría a mi juventud". Muchos feligreses pueden recordar y recitar esta escena de memoria.

Como ocurre con tantas cosas en la liturgia, hay capas de significado en nuestra adoración. La mesa del altar evoca recuerdos de los lugares altos que alguna vez estuvieron reservados para el encuentro con lo sagrado, y la intimidad de la mesa donde la hospitalidad nos lleva a compartir comida y bebida.







*IN THE PARISH***GOSPEL MEDITATION****August 31, 2025 —22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time****Luke 14:1, 7-14**

Once I was invited to a group meeting with Pope Francis. Entering the room, I paused, eyeing the seats next to the Pope's fancy chair. Someone saw my paralysis and invited me to sit in the seat farthest from what I wanted. Hiding my disappointment, I sat. We waited. To our surprise, an aid pointed out that those seats were still empty and invited me and another to have them. We calmly but gleefully strode across the room and sat. Pope Francis entered, and we enjoyed two hours of amazingly uplifting conversation.

Jesus says this week to us: **“When you are invited, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, ‘My friend, move up to a higher position.’ Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table” (Luke 14:10).** This is not about how to score free seat upgrades. Rather, it is a wise pattern for the whole of life. It is how to live free from the anxiety of constantly grasping for status and recognition.



Jesus perfectly embodies his seat-taking advice. He eschews his glorious throne for the lowest: death on a cross, that lonely chair we all deserve. In his resurrection, he calls us up higher to his marvelous banquet seats. This week, perhaps we should look for opportunities to choose the lowest seat. We'll be pleasantly surprised when we do.

## MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

31 de Agosto de 2025: XXII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 14:1, 7-14

Una vez me invitaron a una reunión grupal con el Papa Francisco. Al entrar en la habitación, me detuve, mirando los asientos junto a la elegante silla del Papa. Alguien vio mi parálisis y me invitó a sentarme en el asiento más alejado de lo que quería. Ocultando mi decepción, me senté. Esperamos. Para nuestra sorpresa, un ayudante señaló que esos asientos aún estaban vacíos y nos invitó a mí y a otro a tenerlos. Con calma, pero con alegría, cruzamos la habitación y nos sentamos. El Papa Francisco entró y disfrutamos de dos horas de conversación increíblemente edificante.

Jesús nos dice esta semana: **"Cuando seas invitado, ve y toma el lugar más bajo, para que cuando el anfitrión venga a ti, te diga: 'Amigo mío, sube a una posición más alta'. Entonces disfrutarás de la estima de tus compañeros en la mesa"** (Lucas 14:10). No se trata de cómo obtener mejoras de asiento gratis. Más bien, es un patrón sabio para toda la vida. Es cómo vivir libre de la ansiedad de aferrarse constantemente al estatus y al reconocimiento.

Jesús encarna perfectamente su consejo de tomar asiento. Evita su glorioso trono por el más bajo: la muerte en una cruz, esa silla solitaria que todos merecemos. En su resurrección, nos llama a subir más alto a sus maravillosos asientos de banquete. Esta semana, tal vez deberíamos buscar oportunidades para elegir el asiento más bajo. Nos sorprenderemos gratamente cuando lo hagamos.
