FOLLOWING THE MASTER



When young people came to Mother Teresa and expressed a desire to join her congregation, she left them in no doubt as to what they were getting themselves into. She said, "Our work is hard. We are serving the poor and the homeless twenty-four hours a day."

In the same way, Jesus did not hide the difficulties, the hardships, and the sacrifices that would be needed from those who would follow him. He told them in no uncertain terms that it would not be easy. So, they could not complain later on, "oh, we never thought it was going to be like this."

There is such a thing as the courage of the blind. But Jesus did not advocate this. In fact, he discouraged it. He said, in following him, there is a place for common sense, for prudence, for counting up the cost, for discernment to see if one has what it takes.

We can draw encouragement from the example of the Apostles. The Gospels show that they struggled at every point to follow Jesus. Yet, he did not write them off and, it is clear, that they learned from their failures. It was only after his death and resurrection that they became his true followers.

The Gospel offers hope, to Christians who fail, repentance and a second chance are always possible. Jesus is generous with his grace to those who strive to answer his call.

SIGUIENDO AL MAESTRO

Cuando los jóvenes acudían a la Madre Teresa y expresaban su deseo de unirse a su congregación, ella no les dejaba ninguna duda sobre en qué se estaban metiendo. Ella dijo: "Nuestro trabajo es duro. Estamos sirviendo a los pobres y a las personas sin hogar las veinticuatro horas del día.

De la misma manera, Jesús no ocultó las dificultades, las penurias y los sacrificios que se necesitarían de aquellos que lo siguieran. Les dijo en términos inequívocos que no sería fácil. Entonces, no pudieron quejarse más tarde, "oh, nunca pensamos que iba a ser así".



Existe el coraje de los ciegos. Pero Jesús no abogó por esto. De hecho, lo desalentó. Dijo que, al seguirlo, hay un lugar para el sentido común, para la prudencia, para contar el costo, para el discernimiento para ver si uno tiene lo que se necesita.

Podemos animarnos con el ejemplo de los Apóstoles. Los Evangelios muestran que lucharon en todo momento para seguir a Jesús. Sin embargo, no los descartó y, está claro, que aprendieron de sus fracasos. Fue solo después de su muerte y resurrección que se convirtieron en sus verdaderos seguidores.

El Evangelio ofrece esperanza, a los cristianos que fracasan, el arrepentimiento y una segunda oportunidad siempre son posibles. Jesús es generoso con su gracia con aquellos que se esfuerzan por responder a su llamado.

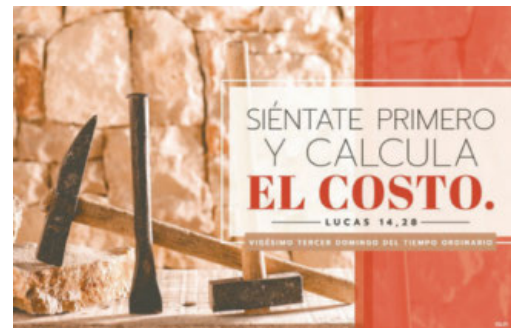
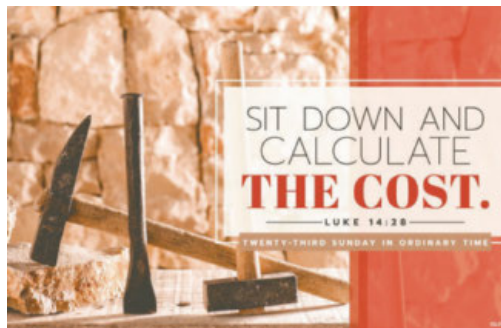

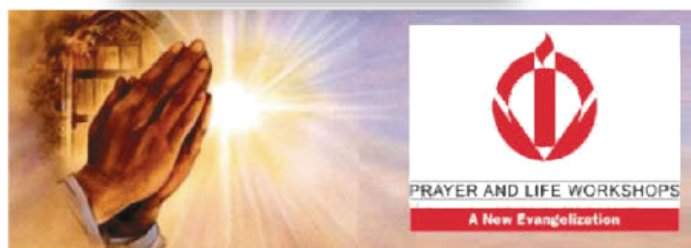

GOSPEL MEDITATION

**September 7, 2025 —23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time
Luke 14:25-33**

One hot Arizona summer afternoon my car ran out of gas. I phoned the parish office and begged for help. My secretary came and helped me fill the gas tank. She chided me, "If you can't manage getting your car from A to B, how can we expect you to guide the parish where it needs to go?" Point taken, Julie. I vowed to always make sure I have plenty of gas in my car.

The Lord Jesus chides us in this week's Gospel, too. He uses the two images of a man building a tower and a king marching soldiers into war to make this single point: acquire what is needed to follow him or look ridiculous. We rightly mock the builder who lacks money for his tower and the king with a short-handed army. But our mocking boomerangs back on us. How do we expect to follow Jesus to the end with insufficient detachment from our possessions and divided hearts?



The good news is, there is still time. Jesus is building a great tower to heaven—his own body. So we renounce all and give ourselves to him as his precious stones. Jesus is waging a battle against our enemy. So we forsake all and swear allegiance and march under his banner. In this way, we will finish what has begun in our discipleship. Or better put, our Lord will have the stones and soldiers required to see his great work through.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

7 de septiembre de 2025: XXIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
Lucas 14:25-33

Para seguir a Jesús debemos realizar ciertos cambios en la vida, que implican salir de nuestro confort. Renunciar a cosas y situaciones a las que no estamos acostumbrados, pensamos, es casi imposible. Pero, recuerde, nada es imposible para Dios. Solo basta con que pongamos un poco de nuestra parte. Dejar nuestros caprichos, manías y malos hábitos que se oponen al Evangelio es cosa de trabajo y proceso. ¡Eso cuesta seguir a Jesús! "El que no carga con su propia cruz para seguirme no puede ser discípulo mío" (Lucas 14:27).

El Papa Francisco, en su catequesis, nos ayuda a comprender el mensaje de Jesús para que nuestra carga sea ligera y apreciemos la cruz que llevamos en nuestra vida. "Hay tres características que trazan claramente la personalidad de Jesús y que motivan nuestra confianza en Él: nos encomendamos a Él porque ora, porque nos ha elegido y porque está cerca de nosotros. Jesús ha pedido y sigue pidiendo por nosotros: es el intercesor. Jesús ama y elige con amor, nos elige a todos. Y la cercanía de Dios a su pueblo es la cercanía de Jesús con la gente". A Jesús le importa nuestra libertad, no quiere que lo sigamos a ciegas. Cargar con la cruz quiere decir medir y calcular las fuerzas que tenemos y darnos cuenta de cuánta fidelidad a sus enseñanzas existe en nuestro corazón. Ayúdame, con tu gracia, cuando flaqueo, cuando estoy solo y confundido, cuando estoy sin esperanza. ¿Quieres seguir a Jesús? Pues, adelante, Él te espera siempre.



Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple." — Lk 14:25-27
