GROWING IN FAITH

What is Faith? In the first place, faith is not about belief in certain truths. Faith is essentially a relationship with God. Like all relationships, it can wax and wane.

Most of us have someone in our lives with whom we communicate only now and then. At one time we may have been very close. But, for one reason or another, a distance grew between us, and we got disconnected. Now we have reached the sorry stage where we are communicating only now and then.

We can get disconnected from God too. We may have been very connected with God as children, but over the years we got disconnected from God. It is not necessarily that we stopped believing in God. It is just that we stop communicating with God. To stop communicating with God is effectively to have no relationship with God.

We had no trouble in connecting with God when we were young. Everything was clear, simple, and certain back then.

We all long to recapture the religious sense of the world we had as children. But the idyllic faith of childhood cannot be held onto eternally.

We all have to leave our youth behind, and with it a world of certainties.

Faith does not remain stationary, no more than any of our relationships remain stationary. Faith has to grow, and as it grows it changes.

All of us can make the prayer of the apostles our own; "Lord, increase our faith," because it is not enough to keep the faith, we have to grow in it.

Faith grows when exercised. Faith also grows through regular nourishment.

Those beliefs that we don't nourish become less solid. How do we nourish our faith? Chiefly by prayer and contact with the believing community.



The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." The Lord replied, "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." — Lk 17:5-6

¿CRECIENDO EN LA FE

¿Qué es la fe? En primer lugar, la fe no se trata de creer en ciertas verdades. La fe es esencialmente una relación con Dios. Como todas las relaciones, puede aumentar y disminuir.

La mayoría de nosotros tenemos a alguien en nuestras vidas con quien nos comunicamos solo de vez en cuando. En un momento dado, es posible que hayamos estado muy cerca. Pero, por una razón u otra, la distancia creció entre nosotros y nos desconectamos. Ahora hemos llegado a la etapa lamentable en la que nos comunicamos solo de vez en cuando.

También podemos desconectarnos de Dios. Es posible que hayamos estado muy conectados con Dios cuando éramos niños, pero con los años nos desconectamos de Dios. No es necesariamente que dejáramos de creer en Dios. Es solo que dejamos de comunicarnos con Dios. Dejar de comunicarse con Dios es efectivamente no tener ninguna relación con Dios.

No tuvimos problemas para conectarnos con Dios cuando éramos jóvenes. Todo era claro, simple y seguro en ese entonces.

Todos anhelamos recuperar el sentido religioso del mundo que teníamos cuando éramos niños. Pero la fe idílica de la infancia no se puede aferrar eternamente.

Todos debemos dejar atrás nuestra juventud, y con ella un mundo de certezas.

La fe no permanece estacionaria, no más de lo que cualquiera de nuestras relaciones permanece estacionaria. La fe debe crecer, y a medida que crece cambia.

Todos podemos hacer nuestra la oración de los apóstoles; "Señor, aumenta nuestra fe", porque no basta con mantener la fe, tenemos que crecer en ella.

La fe crece cuando se ejercita. La fe también crece a través de la alimentación regular. Esas creencias que no alimentamos se vuelven menos sólidas. ¿Cómo alimentamos nuestra fe? Principalmente mediante la oración y el contacto con la comunidad creyente.

Los apóstoles dijeron al Señor: "Auméntanos la fe". El Señor les contestó: "Si tuviera fe, aunque fuera tan pequeña como una semilla de mostaza, podrían decir a ese árbol frondoso: 'Arráncate de raíz y plántate en el mar', y los obedecería". — Lc 17, 5-6

GOSPEL MEDITATION

October 5, 2025 — 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke: 17:5-10

A priest friend of mine received a call from a family whose elderly mother was dying. Within thirty minutes, he was at her bedside, offering the consolation of the sacraments, anointing her with the oil of the sick, and commending her soul to God. She passed not long after, and for months, her family spoke of their deep gratitude for his presence. When I phoned him to commend his faithful ministry, he simply said, “I was just doing my job.”

His words brought to mind Jesus’ teaching this week in Luke 17:10: “So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, ‘We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.’” In a world that often seeks recognition and applause, the Lord invites us into a different mindset — one of humble service. The priest did not see his response as extraordinary; he saw it as a grace to fulfill his vocation.

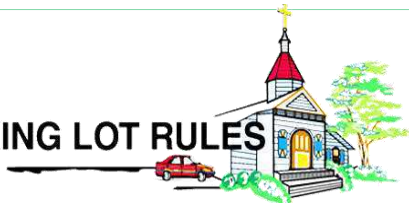


How tempting it is to seek affirmation for doing what I ought to do! Yet Jesus reminds us that true discipleship is not about grandstanding but about quiet faithfulness. It is enough to have served. It is enough to have loved. It is enough to be grateful that we were given the chance to do our duty in the first place. Whether in priesthood, parenthood, or any vocation, what peace-soaked freedom there is in simply doing what is asked of us. No more, no less. Jesus, that is how you quietly love us.

A lo largo del Evangelio encontramos diferentes pasajes donde Jesús elogia a las personas que tienen fe. Por ejemplo: "Levántate, tu fe te ha salvado" (Lucas 17:19). Un buen reto podría ser darnos a la tarea de leer los cuatro evangelios y tomar nota de estos pasajes, para así poder comparar a las personas de aquel tiempo con nosotros hoy, en lo que respecta a la fe. ¿En qué creemos actualmente? ¿Cómo podemos medir la fe que hay en nosotros? ¿Seguimos a Jesús solo para pedirle favores y que nos haga milagros, o porque de verdad tenemos fe en Él?

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, en sus números 176 y 184, nos dice lo siguiente sobre la fe: "La fe es una adhesión personal del hombre entero a Dios que se revela. Comprende una adhesión de la inteligencia y de la voluntad a la revelación que Dios ha hecho de sí mismo mediante sus obras y sus palabras". Y añade: "La fe es un gusto anticipado del conocimiento que nos hará bienaventurados en la vida futura". La vida de fe no se construye en solitario. Para su crecimiento, intervienen muchos factores. El primero nos fue dado desde el bautismo, y nuestros padres y abuelos participaron de primera mano en su desarrollo. La comunidad de fe es otro factor esencial. Después, el crecimiento de la fe depende de cada uno. Hoy, hagamos la misma petición que hicieron los apóstoles: "Señor, aumentanos la fe". Seguramente, la respuesta será la misma. ¿Verdad?

Question: Who invented the Stations of the Cross?

Answer: The first Stations of the Cross were walked by Jesus himself on the way to Calvary. Known as the "Via Dolorosa" ("The Way of Suffering") or the "Via Crucis" ("The Way of the Cross"), it was marked out from the earliest times and was a traditional walk for pilgrims who came to Jerusalem. The early Christians in Jerusalem would walk the same pathway that Jesus walked, pausing for reflection and prayer. Later, when Christians could not travel to the Holy Land, artistic depictions of "The Way of the Cross" were set up in churches, or outside and Christians would walk from station to station, reading the Gospel account of the Passion, or simply praying and reflecting on each event. While the content or place of each station had changed, the intention was to make a mini-pilgrimage and follow--literally--in the footsteps of Jesus.

This devotion became better known in the Middle Ages, and the Franciscans are credited with its spread. Lent is a time when many people make the Stations and some churches present Passion plays or Living Stations. But anyone can pray the Stations at any time. It is a simple and personal reflection on the passion of Jesus and what it means to us.

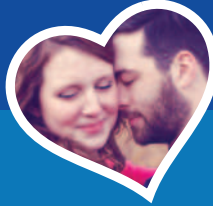
