IMPORTANCE OF GRATITUDE

Gratitude: A Path to Grace

In healing the ten lepers, Jesus performed a profound act of mercy. Yet only one of them returned to give thanks. The other nine went on their way, without a word of gratitude.

The one who came back was a Samaritan—an outsider. The others, presumably Jewish, were part of the chosen people—insiders. But how often this happens: those on the margins, who have little, often recognize the blessings they receive. Those who feel entitled can overlook them entirely.

What does this reveal? Perhaps the nine people returned home, healed in body but still wounded in spirit, having learned nothing from their suffering. But the Samaritan, the one who gave thanks, was healed in a deeper way. His gratitude brought him closer to God.

Ingratitude is painful to witness. Shakespeare once wrote, *"Blow, blow, thou winter wind, thou art not so unkind as man's ingratitude."* A lack of thankfulness can harden even the kindest of hearts.

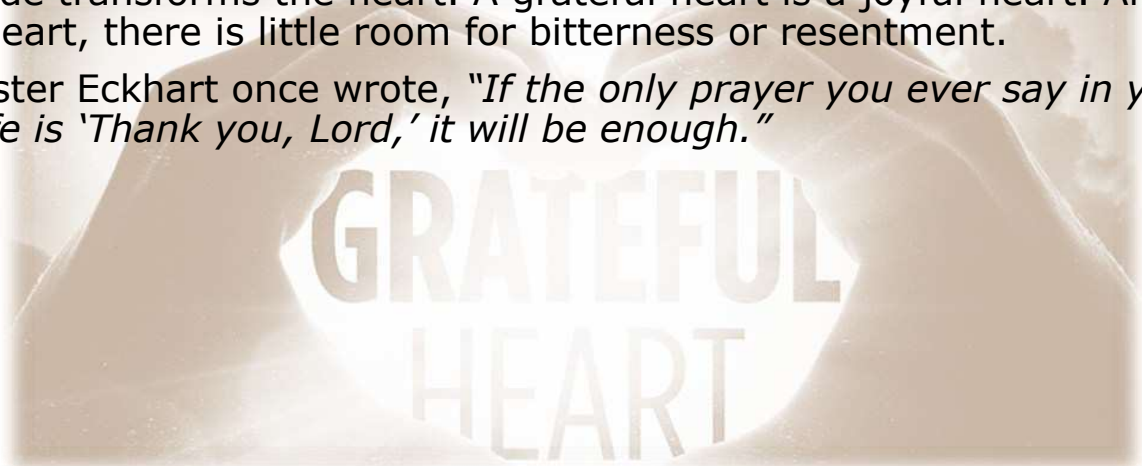
Yet Jesus did not seek gratitude for himself. When he asked, *"Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?"* he was expressing sorrow, not for his own sake, but for the nine who missed a deeper encounter with grace.

Gratitude should come naturally, yet often we are quicker to expect it than to offer it. As Thomas More wisely said, *"We write in the sand the benefits we receive, but the injuries we write on marble."*

Giving thanks matters—not only for those we thank but also for ourselves. It reminds us of the goodness we've received, and it honors those who have blessed us. Above all, it is essential that we give thanks to God. Not because God needs our praise, but because we need to recognize that all we are and all we have come from Him.

Gratitude transforms the heart. A grateful heart is a joyful heart. And in such a heart, there is little room for bitterness or resentment.

As Meister Eckhart once wrote, *"If the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is 'Thank you, Lord,' it will be enough."*

IMPORTANCIA DE LA GRATITUD

Gratitud: Un camino hacia la gracia

Al sanar a los diez leprosos, Jesús realizó un profundo acto de misericordia. Sin embargo, solo uno de ellos regresó para dar gracias. Los otros nueve siguieron su camino, sin una palabra de gratitud.

El que regresó era un samaritano, un forastero. Los demás, presumiblemente judíos, formaban parte del pueblo elegido, los de adentro. Pero con qué frecuencia sucede esto: los marginados, que tienen poco, a menudo reconocen las bendiciones que reciben. Aquellos que se sienten con derecho pueden pasarlos por alto por completo.

¿Qué revela esto? Quizás las nueve personas regresaron a casa, sanadas en cuerpo pero aún heridas en espíritu, sin haber aprendido nada de su sufrimiento. Pero el samaritano, el que dio gracias, fue sanado de una manera más profunda. Su gratitud lo acercó a Dios.

La ingratitud es dolorosa de presenciar. Shakespeare escribió una vez: *"Sopla, sopla, viento invernal, no eres tan cruel como la ingratitud del hombre"*. La falta de agradecimiento puede endurecer incluso los corazones más bondadosos.

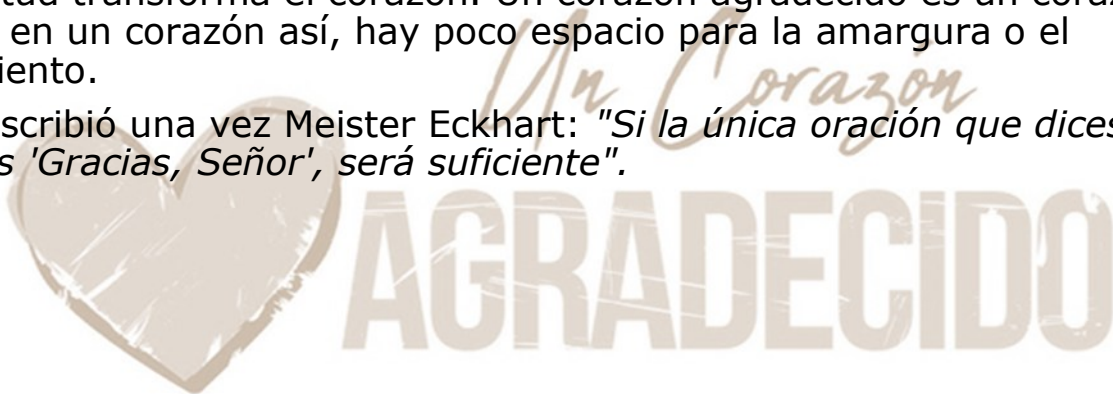
Sin embargo, Jesús no buscó gratitud para sí mismo. Cuando preguntó: *"¿Nadie más que este extranjero ha regresado para dar gracias a Dios?"* Estaba expresando dolor, no por su propio bien, sino por los nueve que se perdieron un encuentro más profundo con Grace.

La gratitud debe venir naturalmente, pero a menudo somos más rápidos para esperarla que para ofrecerla. Como dijo sabiamente Tomás Moro: *"Escribimos en la arena los beneficios que recibimos, pero las lesiones las escribimos en mármol"*.

Dar gracias es importante, no solo por aquellos a quienes agradecemos sino también por nosotros mismos. Nos recuerda la bondad que hemos recibido y honra a quienes nos han bendecido. Sobre todo, es esencial que demos gracias a Dios. No porque Dios necesite nuestra alabanza, sino porque necesitamos reconocer que todo lo que somos y todo lo que hemos venido de Él.

La gratitud transforma el corazón. Un corazón agradecido es un corazón alegre. Y en un corazón así, hay poco espacio para la amargura o el resentimiento.

Como escribió una vez Meister Eckhart: *"Si la única oración que dices en toda tu vida es 'Gracias, Señor', será suficiente"*.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

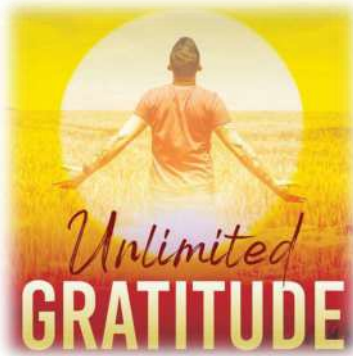
October 12, 2025 —28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke: 17:11-19

Dorothy Day, the great Catholic activist, doubted God's existence. At least in her early adult years. But something changed when after giving birth to her daughter, she experienced an overwhelming gratitude. She later described how, as she held her daughter, the only appropriate response was a kind of unlimited gratitude. She had done nothing to deserve such a gift — this tiny, miraculous life — but there she was, flooded with gratitude, completely undone by the love of such a Giver.

Something similar occurs in Luke 17:19 when Jesus tells a healed leper, **“Stand up and go; your faith has saved you.”** This man had already received physical healing through his faith. But the moment of an even deeper transformation came when he turned back, fell at Jesus' feet, and gave thanks. Like Dorothy, this man's gratitude led him to encounter the Giver.

Isn't that what we want, too? Gratitude to God has the power to break our chains of sadness, bitterness, and disenchantment. It empowers us to step out of the prison of self-pity and into the reality of God's abundant love. It shifts our focus from what we lack to what we have received, from what wounds us to what heals us.

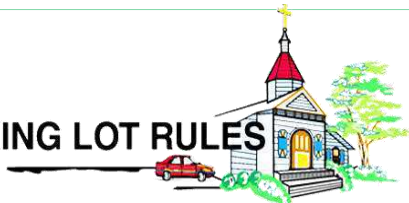


Where do we learn this? The Mass. The priest prays: “It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks.” Always. Everywhere. Not just when life is easy. Not just when prayers are answered as we expect. Gratitude is not a passive feeling; it is an act of faith. In the eucharist, we remember that Christ himself has given everything for us. And in this act of gratitude, we are healed.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

12 de octubre de 2025: XXVIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 17:11-19

En nuestros tiempos se conversa sobre muchas cosas: moda, política, belleza, o sobre quién tiene mejor estatus en la sociedad. Pero de lo que rara vez se dialoga es sobre la fe. Para muchas personas, ese tema parece pasado de moda. Sin embargo, el domingo pasado y este domingo, Jesús nos muestra lo que es la fe. Hoy se alaba el espíritu de agradecimiento de un leproso, y ese agradecimiento a Dios nace precisamente de su fe. Fueron curados diez, pero solo uno, nos narra el Evangelio, regresó a dar gracias: *"Uno de ellos, al verse sano, volvió de inmediato alabando a Dios en alta voz, y se echó a los pies de Jesús con el rostro en tierra, dándole las gracias"* (Lucas 17:15-16). Después de ese acto de gratitud, se dio un diálogo entre Jesús y el hombre, y Jesús le dio una respuesta inmediata: *"Levántate y vete: tu fe te ha salvado."* (Lucas 17:19).

San Atanasio de Alejandría, en su Carta Festal (c. 295–373), dice lo siguiente: *"El Maestro alabó el espíritu agradecido de uno de aquellos, pero le disgustó el comportamiento de los nueve ingratos, porque no reconocieron al autor de su beneficio. Pensaron más en la curación de su lepra que en quien los había curado. Ciertamente, el que fue curado escuchó del Señor: 'Levántate, vete: tu fe te ha salvado'. Los agradecidos y los que alaban a Dios son como hermanos, que bendicen a su Salvador por los beneficios que de Él han recibido."* ¡Señor, dame un corazón agradecido!

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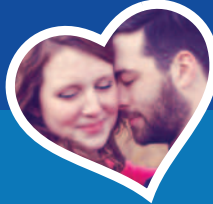


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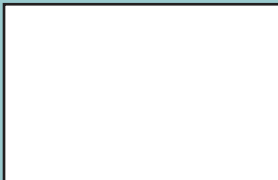
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
