Fr. Kevin's Korner

PRAYING WITH OUTSTRETCHED HANDS

Jesus says to us, "Pray continually and never lose heart." From childhood we were taught to join our hands when praying. Yet during the Mass the priest opens his hands and stretches them out. Both ways of praying are good and have their place. But what do the different gestures mean?

To join one's hands means that, for a while, we stop our normal activities and take time out to pray to God. This is more suited to private prayer.

To pray with open hands is more suited to public prayer. To pray like this makes a powerful statement; it is a sermon in itself and acknowledges that before God we are poor.

We hold up our empty hands to God as a beggar holds out an empty bowl to passers-by. I need you to fill my emptiness.

The gesture is as old as the bible. We have a fine example of it in today's First Reading. There, we see Moses, on a hilltop, praying with extended hands for his people in their life or death battle with the Amalekites. When Moses' hands dropped, the Amalekites prevailed. But when he kept them aloft to God, the Israelites prevailed. This is meant to illustrate the power of prayer. As long as Jewish people put their faith in God, they moved forward. As soon as they forgot to look to God, they were forced to retreat.

The priest says the prayer of the Mass with outstretched hands. Like Moses, he is praying, not just in his own name, but also in the name of the worshipping community.

Jesus urges us to keep on praying and not to lose heart. If we stop praying, we are likely to lose heart and give up. If we pray continually, we will never lose heart. To pray means to rely on God's strength and not on our own. God's strength becomes available to those who pray.

A prayer is answered, not when we get what we are asking for, but when we are granted a sense of God's nearness, and an assurance that God has not abandoned us. Prayer may not change the world for us, but it can give us the courage to face it. The prayer of Jesus in Gethsemane "Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me," was not answered. But, through that prayer, Jesus got the strength to face his passion.

When we learn how to pray, we learn not just to recite words, but how to open our hearts. The practice that nourishes one the most is quiet prayer of the heart. Just sitting quietly and opening the heart and letting God in.

ORAR CON LAS MANOS EXTENDIDAS

Jesús nos dice: "Orad continuamente y nunca desfallezcáis". Desde la infancia nos enseñaron a unir nuestras manos al orar. Sin embargo, durante la Misa, el sacerdote abre las manos y las extiende. Ambas formas de orar son buenas y tienen su lugar. Pero, ¿qué significan los diferentes gestos?

Unir las manos significa que por un tiempo dejamos nuestras actividades normales y nos tomamos un tiempo para orar a Dios. Esto es más adecuado para la oración privada.

La oración con las manos abiertas es más adecuada para la oración pública. Orar así hace una declaración poderosa; es un sermón en sí mismo y reconoce que ante Dios somos pobres.

Levantamos nuestras manos vacías a Dios como un mendigo extiende un cuenco vacío a los transeúntes. Necesito que llenes mi vacío. El gesto es tan antiguo como la Biblia. Tenemos un buen ejemplo de ello en la primera lectura de hoy. Allí vemos a Moisés en la cima de una colina, orando con las manos extendidas por su pueblo en su batalla de vida o muerte con los amalecitas. Cuando las manos de Moisés cayeron, los amalecitas prevalecieron. Pero cuando los mantuvo en alto para Dios, los israelitas prevalecieron. Esto tiene la intención de ilustrar el poder de la oración. Mientras el pueblo judío puso su fe en Dios, siguió adelante. Tan pronto como se olvidaron de mirar a Dios, se vieron obligados a retirarse.

El sacerdote dice la oración de la Misa con las manos extendidas. Al igual que Moisés, está orando, no solo en su propio nombre, sino también en nombre de la comunidad de adoración.

Jesús nos insta a seguir orando y a no desfallecer. Si dejamos de orar, es probable que nos desanimemos y nos demos por vencidos. Si oramos continuamente, nunca nos desanimaremos. Orar significa confiar en la fuerza de Dios y no en la nuestra.

La fuerza de Dios se pone a disposición de los que oran. Una oración es respondida, no cuando obtenemos lo que estamos pidiendo, sino cuando se nos concede un sentido de la cercanía de Dios y la seguridad de que Dios no nos ha abandonado. La oración puede no cambiar el mundo para nosotros, pero puede darnos el coraje para enfrentarlo. La oración de Jesús en Getsemaní: "Padre, si es posible, pase de mí esta copa", no fue respondida. Pero a través de esa oración, Jesús obtuvo la fuerza para enfrentar su pasión.

Cuando aprendemos a orar, aprendemos no solo a recitar palabras, sino a abrir nuestros corazones. La práctica que más nutre a uno es la oración silenciosa del corazón. Simplemente sentarse en silencio y abrir el corazón y dejar entrar a Dios.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

October 19, 2025 —29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke: 18:1-18

A woman in my parish has an adult son who has rejected his faith. She prays for him every day. She lights candles, says rosaries, and asks God again and again to bring him back. But nothing changes. Is God listening? Is He delaying? She told me once that she feels like the widow in Jesus' strange parable — crying out for justice, but hearing only silence. And yet, she said, she is at peace. I asked why. She responded, "God is already answering. I just can't see it yet."

She embodies something of the mystery in Jesus' parable this week in Luke 18. A powerless widow demands justice from a corrupt judge. This isn't about wearing God down until He gives in. It's about faith in the justice that is already coming. The widow isn't just persistent; she believes that justice is inevitable. And when Jesus points to the judge's words — his fear of being "struck" — He hints at something deeper: God's justice does not creep in gradually. It strikes. It comes like lightning.



Blessed Mary is, of course, the ultimate widow demanding justice. At the foot of the cross she stands before what looks like the ultimate injustice — the brutal execution of her son. But she did not despair. She did not beg for a last-minute rescue. She knew that justice was not delayed. In fact, it was happening. The power of the cross was already unleashing justice upon the world — suddenly, decisively, like a blow that would topple every corrupt power, making even the most corrupt fear her strike.

This parable asks us: will the Son of Man find faith on earth? Or will we mistake God's silence for absence? The cross proves that justice is not slow. It is only hidden. The lightning has already struck. In the cross, justice is speedily being done.

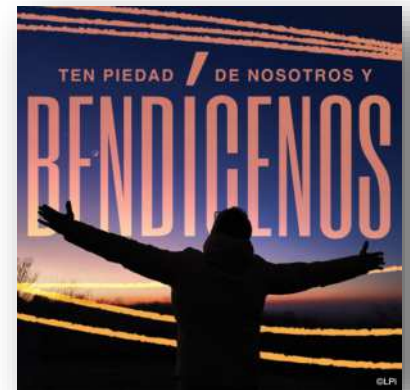

La forma de actuar de Dios es muy diferente a la nuestra. A veces, con nuestras súplicas, queremos moldear a nuestro modo el actuar de Dios. Es por eso que muchas veces se pierde la esperanza: porque deseamos que las cosas sucedan cuando queremos y como queremos. Sin embargo, la Palabra de Dios nos invita a ser perseverantes en la oración: "Predica la Palabra, insiste a tiempo y a destiempo, corrige, reprende y exhorta con toda paciencia y doctrina" (2 Timoteo 4:2).

En lo que respecta a la injusticia, se necesita una tenacidad descomunal; es decir, no desmayar ante las adversidades, como lo demuestran los personajes de la parábola de hoy. San Efrén (306–373), en su Comentario al Diatesarón, escribe: "De hecho, la perseverancia de la viuda humilló la iniquidad del juez rebelde a Dios y la insolencia arrogante contra los hombres. La voluntad de la viuda las sometió, y de esta manera pudo encontrar justicia ante su adversario. La oración inoportuna transformó las dos ramas amargas para que dieran frutos dulces, ajenos a su naturaleza... El fruto de la justicia es la correcta atribución de los oprimidos, y el fruto de la bondad es el consuelo de los afligidos". Oremos hoy por todas las personas que buscan justicia, luchando día a día hasta encontrarla. Tengamos la seguridad de que Dios, en su infinita bondad, escucha sus ruegos, porque Él es justo y su misericordia no tiene límites.

Our Saint-Peter To Rot (5 March 1912- 7 July 1945) was a Papua New Guinea Catholic. He served as a catechist in his village and was entrusted with the leadership of the local parish during World War II when Imperial Japanese forces occupied the region and imprisoned Catholic missionaries. In response to Japanese oppression of his community, he publicly opposed their actions and continued to hold secret prayer services after the Japanese restricted him from active pastoral service. To Rot married in 1936, and he criticized Japanese attempts to encourage his people to return to the pre-Christian practice of taking multiple wives. He was executed by the Japanese in 1945. He was beatified by Pope John Paul I in 1995, approved for canonization by Pope Francis earlier this year and will be canonized by Pope Leo XIV, October 19, 2025.

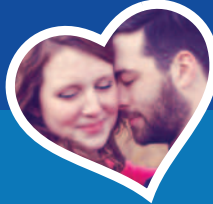

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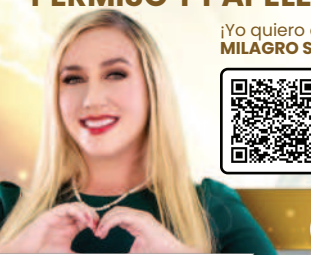
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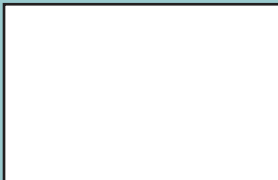
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
