Fr. Kevin's Korner

A RIGHT AND A WRONG WAY TO PRAY

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about two men who go to the Temple to pray: a Pharisee and a tax collector. At first glance, the Pharisee seems like a model religious man—faithful, honest, committed to observing the law, and even going beyond what the law requires. So why does Jesus say he gets it wrong?

The Pharisee's First Mistake: His Attitude Toward God

The Pharisee believed he had earned God's favor through his good behavior. He didn't see himself as a sinner in need of mercy. In fact, he seemed to think that God owed him something—that his "spiritual resume" had put God in his debt. This kind of self-reliance leaves no room for grace.

His Second Mistake: His Attitude Toward Others

He looked down on others, especially the tax collector. He didn't pray with humility but used his prayer to boast and compare. Rather than confessing his own sins, he pointed out the faults of others. His sin was not one of outward behavior, but of inward pride—a pride he couldn't even see. And nothing blinds us to our own faults more than being overly focused on the faults of others.

The Tax Collector Got It Right

Unlike the Pharisee, the tax collector didn't list off his achievements. He stood at a distance, wouldn't even raise his eyes to heaven, and simply prayed, "Lord, be merciful to me, a sinner." His prayer was humble, sincere, and honest. He didn't hide behind excuses or comparisons. He came before God as he was, knowing his need for mercy.

Jesus tells us that it was the tax collector—not the Pharisee—who went home justified before God.

A Lesson for Our Own Prayer

This parable is a reminder for us all. The best prayer is honest and humble. Like the

tax collector, we must recognize our need for God's mercy and avoid comparing ourselves to others. It is not our achievements, but our openness to grace, that brings us close to God.

Let us make our own the simple and powerful prayer of the tax collector:

"Lord, be merciful to me, a sinner."

If we pray these words from the heart, they will keep us grounded in humility, open to grace, and united in love with both God and our neighbor.

UNA FORMA CORRECTA Y INCORRECTA DE ORAR

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús cuenta una parábola sobre dos hombres que van al Templo a orar: un fariseo y un recaudador de impuestos. A primera vista, el fariseo parece un hombre religioso modelo: fiel, honesto, comprometido con la observancia de la ley e incluso yendo más allá de lo que la ley requiere. Entonces, ¿por qué Jesús dice que se equivoca?

El primer error del fariseo: su actitud hacia Dios

El fariseo creía que se había ganado el favor de Dios a través de su buen comportamiento. No se veía a sí mismo como un pecador necesitado de misericordia. De hecho, parecía pensar que Dios le debía algo, que su "currículum espiritual" había puesto a Dios en deuda con él. Este tipo de autosuficiencia no deja lugar para la gracia.

Su segundo error: su actitud hacia los demás

Despreciaba a los demás, especialmente al recaudador de impuestos. No oraba con humildad, sino que usaba su oración para jactarse y comparar. En lugar de confesar sus propios pecados, señaló las faltas de los demás. Su pecado no era de comportamiento externo, sino de orgullo interno que ni siquiera podía ver. Y nada nos ciega más a nuestras propias faltas que estar demasiado enfocados en las fallas de los demás.

El recaudador de impuestos lo hizo bien

A diferencia del fariseo, el recaudador de impuestos no enumeraba sus logros. Se paró a distancia, ni siquiera levantaba los ojos al cielo y simplemente oró: "Señor, ten piedad de mí, un pecador". Su oración era humilde, sincera y honesta. No se escondió detrás de excusas o comparaciones. Se presentó ante Dios tal como era, sabiendo su necesidad de misericordia.

Jesús nos dice que fue el recaudador de impuestos, no el fariseo, quien se fue a casa justificado ante Dios.

Una lección para nuestra propia oración

Esta parábola es un recordatorio para todos nosotros. La mejor oración es honesta y humilde. Al igual que el recaudador de impuestos, debemos reconocer nuestra necesidad de la misericordia de Dios y evitar compararnos con los demás. No son nuestros logros, sino nuestra apertura a la gracia, lo que nos acerca a Dios. Hagamos nuestra la oración sencilla y poderosa del publicano: **"Señor, ten piedad de mí, pecador"**.

Si rezamos estas palabras desde el corazón, nos mantendrán cimentados en la humildad, abiertos a la gracia y unidos en amor tanto con Dios como con nuestro prójimo.

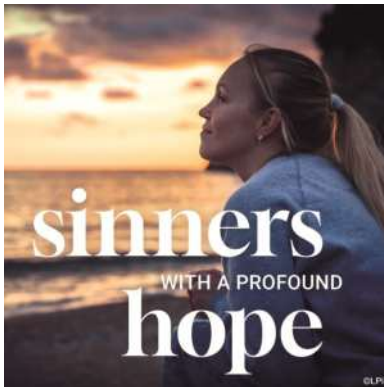
GOSPEL MEDITATION

October 26, 2025 —30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke: 18:9-14

Every now and then readers of these reflections write letters in which they object to something. Years ago, this Gospel of Luke 18 prompted such an email. A man wrote to me: “I find it deeply offensive that you suggest we are still sinners once we are God’s sons and daughters.” His objection stirred in me a profound awareness of the paradox at the heart of our faith. Are we sinners or beloved children of God?

In this Gospel (Luke 18:9-14), a tax collector appears as one who has missed the mark. His sins have isolated him. His breast-beating is not an act of self-flagellation for pride’s sake but a heartfelt admission of his failure and unworthiness. Remarkably, Jesus honors the candid humility of the parable’s penitent. Why? Because we are always in need of mercy, always. But even more, perhaps because on the cross, Jesus will fully embrace a similar place of humiliation and rejection. He will enter into the most shameful, offensive place of the sinner so that we might “go home justified.”



There is a sacred tension in admitting that we are sinners and yet have profound hope. We are beloved sons and daughters of God, growing precisely through our honest acceptance of failure. When we cry, “Have mercy on us,” during Mass or when we repeat the “Jesus Prayer” in quiet moments, or in the confessional, we embrace our imperfections as fertile ground for divine grace. In doing so, we follow Christ’s example — finding true exaltation in the humble acknowledgment of our human frailty.

26 de octubre de 2025: XXX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 18:9-14

Ante Dios no podemos fingir ni aparentar: Él nos conoce profundamente. Por más cara de buenos que pongamos, Él ve más allá: ve nuestro corazón. Tampoco podemos decirle cuán buenos somos, porque nos conoce y sabe perfectamente nuestras acciones. Hoy, Jesús nos cuenta otra parábola: la de dos hombres que fueron al templo a orar. Cada uno lo hace a su manera, y al escuchar el relato, nos damos cuenta de que uno lo hace mejor que el otro. Pero lo más importante es que los dos hablan con Dios. Con este ejemplo podemos aprender a orar y a presentarnos ante Dios tal como somos. “Efectivamente, el fariseo, a pesar de las obras, perdió la justicia; el publicano, en cambio, se granjeó la justicia por la humildad de sus palabras. Aunque, a decir verdad, la del publicano no era propiamente humildad: de hecho, la humildad se da cuando uno que es grande se humilla a sí mismo. La actitud del publicano no fue humildad, sino verdad: sus palabras eran verdaderas, pues él era un pecador” - San Juan Crisóstomo (350–407), Homilía 2 sobre la Penitencia.

“Pero, aunque somos pecadores, no debemos desalentarnos, porque el Señor está con nosotros, quien nos ha dado todo y nos hará vencer también este pequeño paso de hoy, con la gracia de la fuerza, de la valentía, de la oración, de la vigilancia y de la alegría” (Papa Francisco). En conclusión: puede ser que en cada uno de nosotros vivan un fariseo y un publicano. Ambos necesitan de Dios para ser liberados y perdonados. Ante Dios, oremos con verdad y con sinceridad de corazón.

Our Saint-Peter To Rot (5 March 1912-7 July 1945) was a Papua New Guinea Catholic. He served as a catechist in his village and was entrusted with the leadership of the local parish during World War II when Imperial Japanese forces occupied the region and imprisoned Catholic missionaries. In response to Japanese oppression of his community, he publicly opposed their actions and continued to hold secret prayer services after the Japanese restricted him from active pastoral service. To Rot married in 1936, and he criticized Japanese attempts to encourage his people to return to the pre-Christian practice of taking multiple wives. He was executed by the Japanese in 1945. He was beatified by Pope John Paul I in 1995, approved for canonization by Pope Francis earlier this year and was canonized by Pope Leo XIV, October 19, 2025.

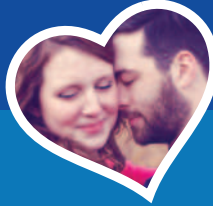


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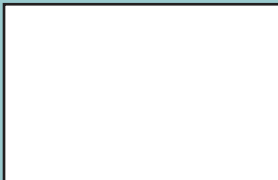
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
