ADVENT: A SEASON OF HOPE

Advent is a sacred time of hope and promise. If everything in our lives were already perfect, hope would have no purpose. But because we live in a world marked by imperfection, we are invited—even called—to hope.

Hope is essential to the Christian life. So much of our journey is spent longing, waiting, and trusting in God's goodness. Life becomes unbearable only when hope disappears.

Yet hope is not passive. It is not simply waiting for something to happen. True Christian hope moves us to action. Because we believe that God is at work, we work hard as well. Our strength and perseverance flow from the depth of our hope. Without hope, we would soon give up.

Cynicism, however, is the enemy of hope. It tells us, "Nothing will ever change," and asks nothing of us—not trust, not effort, not love. It is easy, but it is not of God.

Hope is different from mere optimism. Optimism expects things to improve on their own. Hope is rooted in trust—trust that God will fulfill His promises, in His time and in His way. As St. Paul reminds us, Scripture shows again and again how God comes to the aid of those who refuse to give up.

We often place our hopes in imperfect human leaders. How much more, then, should we place our hope in God? He has given us His Word in Christ, and that Word is the sure foundation of our hope—an anchor for our lives.

John the Baptist's call to repentance is especially meaningful in this season. To repent is to change our hearts, to reorder our priorities, and to live in a new way. What does that look like for us? St. Paul gives us a simple, practical guide: "Treat one another in the same friendly way that Christ has treated you." If each of us lived that out, even in small ways, our corner of the world would quickly become a more hopeful place.

The world cannot satisfy our deepest hopes—but God can. And so we live "in hope," one foot grounded in the world as it is, and the other in the world as it is meant to be.

May this Advent renew in us the hope that only Christ can give.

ADVIENTO: UNA ESTACIÓN DE ESPERANZA

El Adviento es un tiempo sagrado de esperanza y promesa. Si todo en nuestras vidas ya fuera perfecto, la esperanza no tendría sentido. Pero como vivimos en un mundo marcado por la imperfección, estamos invitados—e incluso llamados— a la esperanza.

La esperanza es esencial para la vida cristiana. Gran parte de nuestro camino se pasa anhelando, esperando y confiando en la bondad de Dios. La vida solo se vuelve insoportable cuando la esperanza desaparece.

Sin embargo, la esperanza no es pasiva. No es simplemente esperar a que ocurra algo. La verdadera esperanza cristiana nos impulsa a la acción. Como creemos que Dios está actuando, también trabajamos duro. Nuestra fuerza y perseverancia fluyen de la profundidad de nuestra esperanza. Sin esperanza, pronto nos rendiríamos.

El cinismo, sin embargo, es el enemigo de la esperanza. Nos dice: "Nada cambiará jamás", y no nos pide nada—ni confianza, ni esfuerzo, ni amor. Es fácil, pero no es de Dios.

La esperanza es diferente del mero optimismo. El optimismo espera que las cosas mejoren por sí solas. La esperanza está arraigada en la confianza—la confianza en que Dios cumplirá Sus promesas, en Su tiempo y a su manera. Como nos recuerda San Pablo, la Escritura muestra de nuevo cómo Dios acude en ayuda de quienes se niegan a rendirse.

A menudo depositamos nuestras esperanzas en líderes humanos imperfectos. ¿Cuánto más deberíamos poner nuestra esperanza en Dios? Nos ha dado Su Palabra en Cristo, y esa Palabra es el fundamento seguro de nuestra esperanza: un ancla para nuestras vidas.

El llamado al arrepentimiento de Juan el Bautista es especialmente significativo en esta temporada. Arrepentirse es cambiar nuestro corazón, reordenar nuestras prioridades y vivir de una manera nueva. ¿Cómo sería eso para nosotros? San Pablo nos da una guía sencilla y práctica: "Trataos unos a otros con la misma amistad en que Cristo os ha tratado a vosotros." Si cada uno de nosotros viviera eso, aunque fuera en pequeñas medidas, nuestro rincón del mundo se convertiría rápidamente en un lugar más esperanzador.

El mundo no puede satisfacer nuestras esperanzas más profundas, pero Dios sí puede. Y así, vivimos "con esperanza", un pie anclado en el mundo tal como es, y el otro en el mundo tal como debe ser. ©LPi

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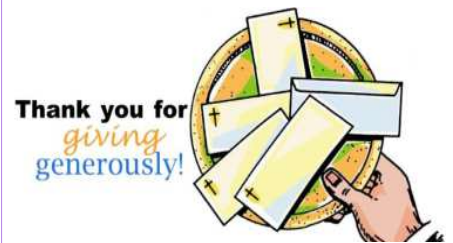

GOSPEL MEDITATION

December 7, 2025—Second Sunday of Advent

Matthew: 3:1-12

This week we hear that John the Baptist is out in the wilderness eating “locusts and wild honey” (Mark 1:6). It’s not just a strange historical detail. It’s a symbolic expression of a healthy spiritual diet. The path to Christ includes both the hard and the beautiful, the gritty and the sweet. We have to learn to gulp the locusts and savor the honey.

I remember working with a young couple preparing for marriage. They were sincere, but raw — barely beginning to discover faith. Part of me wanted to rush them ahead, to fill in all the gaps, to bombard them with scripture and church documents. I swallowed that instinct. It was like eating locusts.

But I also recall them light up as they spoke about each other, about their first child, then their second. And they wanted to be close to God. Something innocent and beautiful was unfolding. That was the honey. I knew God was asking me to savor it.



This Advent, maybe we’re each being invited to accept both locusts and honey. Maybe it’s time to stop avoiding the difficult parts of faith — prayer that feels dry, the call to repentance, the patience with the troublesome. It’s time to eat some locusts.

But we also need to notice the small gifts God gives us: a peaceful moment, a good conversation, the joy of serving someone else, new life, good intentions of our friends. That’s the honey. Savor it!

John didn’t avoid either. He took it all in. And so can we. What are your locusts? Your honey? If we let God feed us with both, we’ll be ready — really ready — for the coming of Christ.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

7 de diciembre de 2025: II Domingo de Adviento

Mateo 3:1-12

Durante el Adviento, Dios nos brinda la oportunidad de trabajar y movernos, de no quedarnos en un solo sitio. Como ejemplo, tenemos a Juan Bautista, personaje importante de este tiempo. Él trabajó incansablemente anunciando cómo preparar el camino del Señor, cómo sería su venida. El profeta Isaías se refería a Juan de esta forma: "Una voz grita en el desierto: preparen un camino al Señor, hagan sus senderos rectos" (Juan 3:3). Hacer los senderos rectos, es decir, implica una conversión desde el fondo del corazón; un cambio radical a través de un proceso suave pero firme para llegar a Dios.

"La Iglesia de este tiempo es igual a un campo sembrado que tiene grano y paja mezclados, es decir, juntos buenos y malos. Después del juicio, en cambio, tendrá solamente buenos, sin malo alguno... De ahí vendrá el juzgar a vivos y muertos, y como dice el Evangelio: Él tiene el bieldo en su mano para separar el trigo de la paja. Guardará el trigo en su granero y quemará la paja en un fuego que no se extingue"

(San Agustín, 354–430. Sermón 223). Preparados o no, este Adviento es el tiempo de aprender que los tiempos de Dios son momentos de gracia. Paja y trigo crecen en nosotros, y es tiempo de ponerse a trabajar en la conversión para ir al encuentro del Señor. No olvidemos que Dios espera de nosotros lo mejor y nos da la libertad de seguirlo o dejarlo. ¿Qué escoges? El tiempo de Adviento es para revisar nuestra conciencia: cómo pensamos, creemos y actuamos.

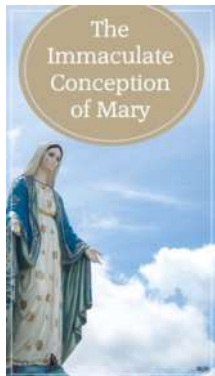

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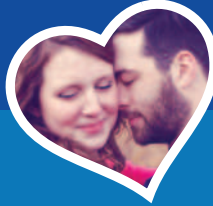
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
