At the time, we may not have appreciated those words, but they helped shape the people we have become. Only God knows how many of those seeds took root, but our lives would be immeasurably poorer without them.

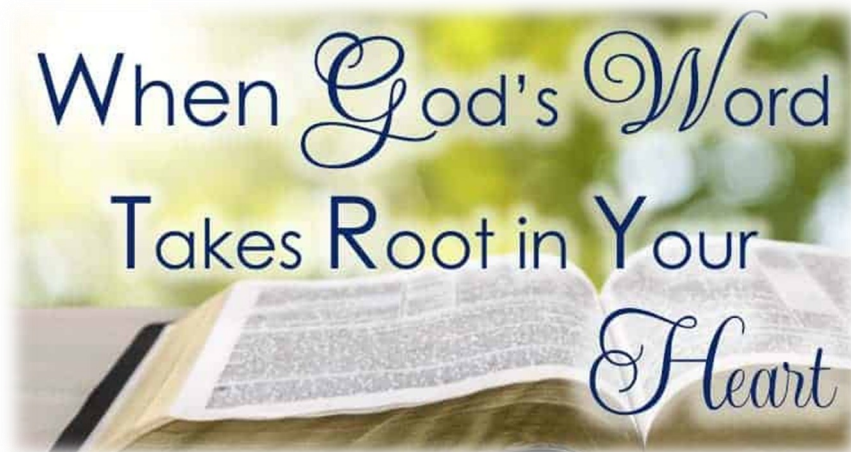

In today's world, we are surrounded by constant noise. Every day we are bombarded with messages from television, radio, social media, and countless other voices competing for our attention. Amid all this distraction, how can we hear God's gentle voice? We can only do so by making time for silence, prayer, and reflection.

The Gospel reminds us that simply hearing God's Word is not enough. Some hear it, yet it quickly fades away. But those who receive it with open hearts and put it into practice are changed by it. As disciples of Christ, may we not only listen to God's Word but allow it to take root, bear fruit, and transform our lives each day.

PRAYER TO ST. ANTHONY DE PADUA

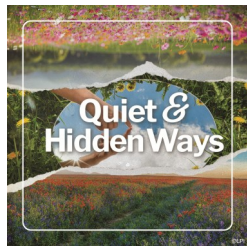

IN THE PARISH

GOSPEL MEDITATION | July 12, 2026

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time | Matthew 13:1-23 (Father John Muir)



Sometimes I feel capable of absorbing almost anything except God's Word. My mind soaks up song lyrics, sports trivia, and endless online content. But what was the reading at Mass this morning? I struggle to recall. That realization discourages me, and it leads to an uncomfortable question. What is my heart really for? Is it shaped for constant information and distraction, or is it truly designed for God? Am I capable of deeply receiving His Word?

Jesus speaks directly to this today with a simple image. **"The seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it."** By comparing the Word of the Kingdom to a seed, Jesus reveals something hopeful about us. The human heart is made for that seed. Soil and seed belong together. No matter how compacted, rocky, or overgrown the ground has become, the Sower never stops sowing.

God loves our hearts. He sees them as a farmer sees his fields, full of potential. Human hearts can indeed **"understand the Word."** Understanding does not mean mastering information. It means letting the Word sink in, interacting with it, and giving it a home. It means trusting that, beneath the surface, God is at work in quiet and hidden ways.

When we allow the Holy Spirit to loosen the soil of our hearts through prayer, repentance, and simplicity, the same Word that created the universe begins to bear fruit in us, 30, 60, even a hundredfold.

Lord Jesus, Sower of life, soften the soil of my heart. Let Your Word take root in me again and bring forth the fruit You desire. Amen.

The Gardener and the Soil

I began writing this piece by googling "how do you make soil fertile?" which should tell you everything you need to know about my own abilities as a gardener.

I remember seeing a packet of seeds in the store one summer as a child and convincing my mother to buy them. They were delphiniums, which bloom into a beautiful cone shape if you know what you're doing. Alas, I didn't. I chose for my garden a particularly dry spot of earth right next to my backyard playset, scattered the seeds, congratulated myself, and went on my merry way. I returned occasionally to water the area, but only when I remembered to.

Nothing grew, not even a little sprout. I was more than heartbroken — my faith was shaken. I had planted these seeds! I had watered them! (A little.) There was sunlight! All my childhood books and rhymes said this was all you needed. Was it all a lie?

Of course it wasn't a lie. Seeds need soil, sunlight, water, and oxygen — good soil, adequate sunlight for whatever the plant is, and consistent water.

So what seeds need more than anything is a gardener. (At least, delphiniums do.)

When I hear the parable of the rich soil and the rocky ground in the Gospel of Matthew, I often miss the point. I think Jesus is trying to give me a message about how I should be. "Be better." That's what I think he's telling me.

I forget that I am only the soil. I cannot enrich myself; all my efforts to do so will come to nothing. What he is telling me is to ask the gardener: "Make me what I need to be."

EN LA PARROQUIA

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO | 12 de Julio de 2026
XV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario | Mateo 13:1-23

Si hacemos memoria, quizá tengamos recuerdos de nuestra infancia, cuando nuestros padres nos decían: “Mira, hijo-hija, escucha y pon atención a lo que te voy a aconsejar”. O también nos decían: “Abre los ojos y fíjate hacia dónde vas”. En fin, cada uno de nosotros puede hacer eco en la memoria y en el corazón de todos esos sabios consejos. Cada consejo fue dirigido a todos los miembros de la familia, y cada uno lo comprendió y acogió de manera diferente. Hoy, la Palabra de Dios, en la parábola del sembrador, describe la misión de Jesús y las distintas formas de acogida y apertura que encuentra en las personas.



Cada semana, en la Eucaristía dominical, nosotros somos parte de ese auditorio. ¿De qué forma escucho su Palabra? ¿Qué acogida le doy en mi corazón? ¿Doy fruto de lo que escucho? La respuesta la conoce cada uno, porque es personal; depende de la tierra que hay en mí y de cómo está cuidada. Para que la tierra sea fértil, debemos poner nuestro grano de arena. Por ejemplo: participar regularmente en los sacramentos de la Reconciliación y de la Eucaristía, acudir a algún retiro espiritual o a las catequesis ofrecidas en nuestra parroquia. Nuestro compromiso debe ser activo, tanto para acoger la Palabra como para llevarla a otros que no la conocen. Seamos, pues, buenos sembradores perseverantes, para que la semilla nazca sana y fuerte en nosotros y dé fruto. *“El que tenga oídos, que escuche”* (Mateo 13:9).

Empecé a escribir este texto buscando en Google “¿cómo se hace que el suelo sea fértil?”, lo que debería decirte todo lo que necesitas saber sobre mis propias habilidades como jardinera.

Recuerdo haber visto un paquete de semillas en la tienda un verano cuando niña y haber convencido a mi madre para que las comprara. Eran flores espuela de caballero, que florecen en forma de cono precioso si sabes lo que haces. Por desgracia, yo no sabía. Elegí para mi jardín un rincón de tierra especialmente seco justo al lado de mi área de juegos en mi jardín trasero, esparcí las semillas, me felicité a mí misma y seguí mi camino alegremente. Volví de vez en cuando para regar la zona, pero solo cuando me acordaba.

Nada creció, ni siquiera un pequeño brote. Estaba más que destrozada — mi fe se tambaleó. ¡Yo había plantado estas semillas! ¡Las había regado! (Un poco.) ¡Había luz del sol! Todos mis libros y rimas infantiles decían que esto era todo lo que necesitabas. ¿Era todo una mentira?

Por supuesto que no era mentira. Las semillas necesitan tierra, luz solar, agua y oxígeno — buen suelo, luz solar adecuada para la planta y agua constante.

Así que lo que las semillas necesitan más que nada es un jardinero. (Al menos, las flores espuelas de caballero sí.)

Cuando escucho la parábola de la tierra fértil y el suelo rocoso en el Evangelio de Mateo, a menudo no entiendo el punto. Creo que Jesús está intentando darme un mensaje sobre cómo debería ser. “Sé mejor.” Eso es lo que creo que me está diciendo. Olvido que solo soy la tierra. No puedo enriquecerme sola; Todos mis esfuerzos para lograrlo serán en vano. Lo que me está diciendo es que le pida al jardinero: “Hazme lo que necesito ser.”
