One of the greatest blessings we receive as Catholics is the gift of the sacraments. I often hear people speak of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation as if they were items on a checklist. Once they have been completed, it can seem as though the work of faith is finished. But nothing could be further from the truth.

The sacraments are not the end of our journey—they are the beginning of a lifelong relationship with Jesus Christ. They are God's gifts to strengthen, guide, and nourish us as we grow in faith throughout our lives.

Think of a bridge being built across a river. If construction stopped halfway, the bridge would never serve its purpose. Our spiritual lives are much the same. God continually invites us to grow closer to Him, and the sacraments provide the grace we need to keep moving forward. They help us persevere through life's joys and challenges and deepen our communion with Christ and His Church.

As a parish family, we rightly rejoice when our children celebrate the sacraments. These are beautiful milestones worthy of celebration. I encourage each of you to see the sacraments not as obligations to fulfill, but as encounters with the living Christ. Every Mass, every confession, every reception of the Holy Eucharist is an opportunity to receive God's grace and to be renewed in His love.

May we never view the sacraments as something we have simply "completed." Instead, let us treasure them as how God continually draws us closer to Himself. Together, may we continue walking the path of faith with confidence, trusting that the Lord will always provide the grace we need for the journey.

Como familia parroquial, nos alegramos con raz3n cuando nuestros hijos celebran los sacramentos. Son hitos hermosos que merecen ser celebrados. Sin embargo, tambi3n nos recuerdan que el trabajo de formar discípulos continúa. Los padres son los primeros maestros de la fe, y los niños aprenden mejor siendo testigos de la fe vivida en casa. Cuando las familias rezan juntas, asisten fielmente a misa cada domingo y celebran regularmente el Sacramento de la Reconciliaci3n, construyen una base s3lida que las sostendr3 durante muchos ańos.

Animo a cada uno de vosotros a ver los sacramentos no como obligaciones que cumplir, sino como encuentros con el Cristo vivo. Cada misa, cada confesi3n, cada recepci3n de la Santa Eucaristía es una oportunidad para recibir la gracia de Dios y renovarse en Su amor.

Que nunca veamos los sacramentos como algo que simplemente hemos "completado". En cambio, valorémoslos como la forma en que Dios nos acerca continuamente a Sí mismo. Juntos, que sigamos caminando el camino de la fe con confianza, confiando en que el Seńor siempre nos proporcionará la gracia que necesitamos para el camino.

POPE LEO XIV URGES CATHOLICS TO READ PRINTED BOOKS

EWTN NEWS: Pope Leo XIV on May 7 underscored the enduring value of printed books in the digital age, saying reading “nourishes the mind” and offers Christians a valuable opportunity to proclaim Christ.

The Pope made the remarks during an audience at the Vatican with employees of the Vatican Publishing House, or Libreria Editrice Vaticana, which was founded in 1926 and is celebrating its centenary this year.

The Holy Father said the book “is an opportunity to think,” defending the physicality of printed books in an increasingly digital culture because, he said, they remind readers of the importance of “thought, reflection, and study.”

Reading nourishes the mind; it helps to foster a conscious and well- formed critical sense, guarding us against fundamentalism and ideological shortcuts,” Pope Leo said.

“For this reason, I urge everyone to read books, as an antidote to closed-mindedness, which is reflected in rigid attitudes and reductive views of reality,” he added.

The pope also emphasized that books offer an opportunity for encounter.

“When we hold a book in our hands, we ideally encounter its author,” he said. “But at the same time, we meet those who have read it before us, or who are reading it now or will read it in the future.”

Pope Leo noted that Pope Francis had taught Catholics “to practice the culture of encounter,” adding that “a book is a bridge to others, a source of dialogue that enriches us, a stimulus to expand our own perspective.

“ For Christians in particular, the pope said, books can be “an opportunity to proclaim Christ.”

“We know well how reading a saint's biography or a well-written spiritual reflection can touch the heart,” he said.

He also pointed to the Virgin Mary, who is often depicted in the Annunciation “intent on reading the holy Scriptures,” and to St. Anthony of Padua, who is commonly shown holding “the open Book of the Gospels, upon which the Infant Jesus stands.”

“We often see St. Augustine seated at a desk before a large book and, at times, holding a heart in his hand: truth and charity,” the pope said.

“At the school of Mary and the saints, let us nourish ourselves with the word of God, so that it may shape our way of thinking and acting,” Pope Leo added, according to an EWTN News report.

EL PAPA LEÓN XIV INSTA A LOS CATÓLICOS A LEER LIBROS IMPRESOS

EWTN NEWS: El Papa León XIV subrayó el 7 de mayo el valor duradero de los libros impresos en la era digital, afirmando que leer "nutre la mente" y ofrece a los cristianos una valiosa oportunidad para proclamar a Cristo.

El Papa hizo estas declaraciones durante una audiencia en el Vaticano con empleados de la Editorial Vaticana, o Libreria Editrice Vaticana, fundada en 1926 y que este año celebra su centenario.

El Santo Padre dijo que el libro "es una oportunidad para pensar", defendiendo la fisicalidad de los libros impresos en una cultura cada vez más digital porque, dijo, recuerdan a los lectores la importancia del "pensamiento, la reflexión y el estudio". "

Leer nutre la mente; ayuda a fomentar un sentido crítico consciente y bien formado, protegiéndonos del fundamentalismo y de atajos ideológicos", dijo el Papa León.

"Por esta razón, insto a todos a leer libros, como antídoto contra la mentalidad cerrada, que se refleja en actitudes rígidas y visiones reductoras de la realidad", añadió.

El papa también enfatizó que los libros ofrecen una oportunidad de encuentro.

"Cuando sostenemos un libro en nuestras manos, idealmente nos encontramos con su autor", dijo. "Pero al mismo tiempo, conocemos a quienes lo han leído antes que nosotros, o que lo están leyendo ahora o lo leerán en el futuro."

El Papa León señaló que el Papa Francisco había enseñado a los católicos "a practicar la cultura del encuentro", añadiendo que "un libro es un puente hacia los demás, una fuente de diálogo que nos enriquece, un estímulo para ampliar nuestra propia perspectiva.

"Para los cristianos en particular, dijo el papa, los libros pueden ser "una oportunidad para proclamar a Cristo."

"Sabemos bien cómo leer la biografía de un santo o una reflexión espiritual bien escrita puede tocar el corazón", dijo.

También señaló a la Virgen María, que a menudo aparece en la Anunciación "decidida a leer las sagradas Escrituras", y a San Antonio de Padua, que suele aparecer sosteniendo "el Libro abierto de los Evangelios, sobre el que se asienta el Niño Jesús."

"A menudo vemos a San Agustín sentado en un escritorio frente a un gran libro y, en ocasiones, sosteniendo un corazón en la mano: verdad y caridad", dijo el papa.

"En la escuela de María y los santos, alimentémonos con la palabra de Dios, para que pueda moldear nuestra forma de pensar y actuar", añadió el papa León, según un informe de EWTN News.

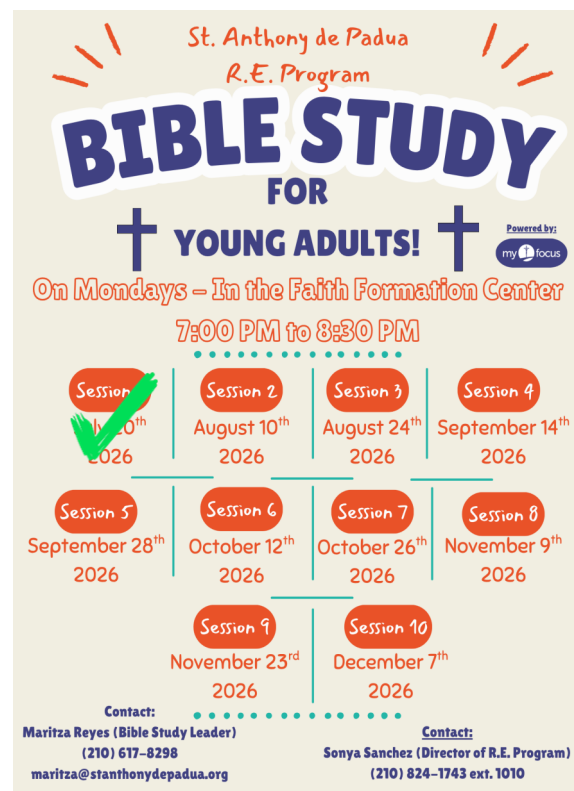

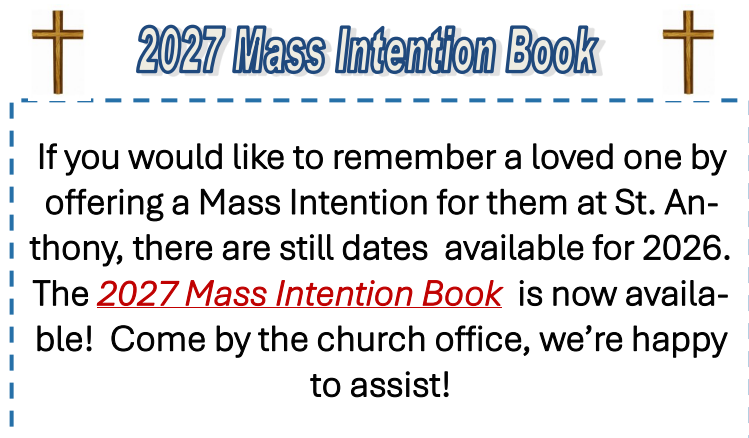

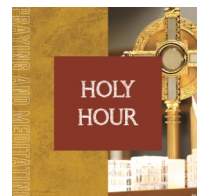

Holy Hour Mini Explanation —

A holy hour is the practice of spending one hour's time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, praying and meditating on the agony of Jesus Christ.



Holy Hour, *Explained!*

A holy hour is the practice of spending one hour's time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, praying and meditating on the agony of Jesus Christ. More broadly, a holy hour can also refer to any 60 minutes set aside in prayer and reflection, whether in church or elsewhere.

The holy hour devotion dates to the late 17th century, when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received visions of Jesus Christ. In these visions, the Lord requested that St. Margaret Mary spend one hour every Thursday evening lying prostrate and meditating upon his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. This practice calls back to the Gospel of Matthew, which tells of Jesus' desire for the disciples to "remain here and keep watch with me" (Matthew 26:38) as he awaited his passion. Holy hours can be made privately or in community, and the USCCB has created a variety of different holy hour formats that can be found at usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/prayers-and-devotions/eucharistic-devotion.

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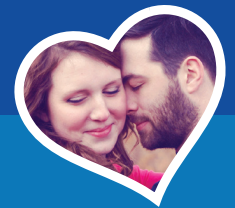
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
