FAITH THAT CARRIES US THROUGH THE STORMS

The Gospel of Jesus walking on the water is much more than a story about an extraordinary miracle. It is a powerful reminder of what it means to trust the Lord in the midst of life's storms.

The boat represents the Church, and the wind and waves symbolize the trials, hardships, and persecutions that believers have faced throughout every age. St. Peter, stepping out onto the water with great courage, also represents each one of us. He begins with confidence, but when he focuses on the strength of the wind rather than on the presence of Jesus, fear overtakes him and he begins to sink.



How often does the same happen in our own lives? We begin with faith and hope, yet when illness, loss, disappointment, or uncertainty enters our lives, our confidence falters. Like Peter, we cry out, "Lord, save me!"

The beautiful message of this Gospel is that Jesus immediately reaches out His hand. He does not abandon Peter, nor does He abandon us. Even when our faith is weak, His love remains constant. His gentle question, "Why did you doubt?" is not meant to condemn, but to invite us to trust Him more deeply.

Faith does not remove every trial or guarantee a life free from suffering. Rather, it gives us the strength to persevere, knowing that Christ walks beside us through every storm. His grace sustains us when our own strength is not enough.

When we look back over our lives, many of us can recognize moments when we wondered how we would endure a difficult situation. Yet, by God's grace, we found the strength to continue. Those moments remind us that the Lord was holding us up, just as He held Peter.

As disciples of Christ, we are called to keep our eyes fixed on Him rather than on the storms around us. When we do, we discover that Jesus is not simply a figure from the past. He is the living Son of God, present with His Church today, offering His peace, His strength, and His unfailing love to all who place their trust in Him.

FE QUE NOS SOSTIENE A TRAVÉS DE LAS TORMENTAS

El Evangelio de Jesús caminando sobre el agua es mucho más que una historia sobre un milagro extraordinario. Es un recordatorio poderoso de lo que significa confiar en el Señor en medio de las tormentas de la vida.

El barco representa a la Iglesia, y el viento y las olas simbolizan las pruebas, dificultades y persecuciones que los creyentes han sufrido a lo largo de todas las épocas. San Pedro, saliendo al agua con gran valentía, también representa a cada uno de nosotros. Comienza con confianza, pero cuando se centra en la fuerza del viento en lugar de en la presencia de Jesús, el miedo le domina y empieza a hundirse.

¿Con qué frecuencia ocurre lo mismo en nuestra propia vida? Empezamos con fe y esperanza, pero cuando la enfermedad, la pérdida, la decepción o la incertidumbre entran en nuestras vidas, nuestra confianza flaquea. Como Pedro, clamamos: "¡Señor, sálvame!"

El mensaje hermoso de este Evangelio es que Jesús extiende la mano inmediatamente. Él no abandona a Pedro, ni nos abandona a nosotros. Incluso cuando nuestra fe es débil, su amor permanece constante. Su suave pregunta, "¿Por qué dudaste?" no pretende condenar, sino invitarnos a confiar más profundamente en Él.

La fe no elimina todas las pruebas ni garantiza una vida libre de sufrimiento. Más bien, nos da la fuerza para perseverar, sabiendo que Cristo camina a nuestro lado en cada tormenta. Su gracia nos sostiene cuando nuestra propia fuerza no es suficiente.

Cuando miramos atrás en nuestras vidas, muchos de nosotros podemos reconocer momentos en los que nos preguntamos cómo soportaríamos una situación difícil. Sin embargo, por la gracia de Dios, encontramos la fuerza para continuar. Esos momentos nos recuerdan que el Señor nos sostenía, igual que sostenía a Pedro.

Como discípulos de Cristo, estamos llamados a mantener la mirada fija en Él en lugar de en las tormentas que nos rodean. Cuando lo hacemos, descubrimos que Jesús no es simplemente una figura del pasado. Él es el Hijo viviente de Dios, presente hoy con Su Iglesia, ofreciendo Su paz, Su fuerza y Su amor inquebrantable a todos los que depositan su confianza en Él.

GOSPEL MEDITATION | August 9, 2026

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 14:22-33 — Father John Muir

As a young, newly ordained priest, I admired a senior priest who was gifted, beloved, and had changed countless lives. But soon I learned that he had fallen in catastrophic and destructive ways. The painful juxtaposition of good and evil was complex to process. How could someone so seemingly good also be so broken and deceptive? It forced me to confront a sobering truth: leadership in the Church is no guarantee against weakness or sin.

Peter teaches that truth in this week's Gospel. When he sees Jesus walking on the sea, Peter does what leaders do. He goes first. "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." But when he sees how strong the wind is, he becomes frightened and, beginning to sink, cries out, "Lord, save me." Immediately, Jesus stretches out his hand and catches him.

St. Thomas Aquinas observes that Peter overcomes the greater danger of the waves but falters before the lesser threat of the wind. This is the paradox leaders often face. It is not always the great trials that undo us, but the smaller, quieter temptations, such as subtle fears and compromises, that lead us to sink.

The good news is that Jesus does not abandon Peter. He saves him before it is too late. Our frail humanity lives within a rhythm of grace, risk, failure, and mercy. Jesus helps Peter overcome both the obvious and hidden sources of fear, and he promises to do the same for us. So, let us pray for all, especially our spiritual leaders.

Looking for God

What do we think when we see Jesus coming to save us?

The first thing the Apostles scream is "Ghost!" when they catch sight of Jesus walking towards them on water. That always makes me laugh. After all they have witnessed thus far as the companions of the Messiah, they see someone walking on water and they still react like extras in a bad episode of Scooby-Doo.

We are always more quick to believe a bad thing than a good thing. We can easily believe gossip and hearsay about a friend, but we fear being taken for a fool when it comes to faith. We would rather look cynical than stupid.

"Save me, God, for the waters have reached my neck," reads Psalm 69. "My eyes fail, from looking for my God."

I think back on my life, on all the various ways that God has rescued me from slipping beneath the surface. Rarely did it ever occur to me, in the midst of it, that I was being rescued. In fact, I usually thought I was being held underwater. Did I hear His voice directing me, or did I only hear my own despairing? "Save me, God." Was I looking for Him, or were my eyes shut in fear? "My eyes fail, from looking for my God."

It's never until after the fact — sometimes years after, or decades — that we see things clearly. That we see Christ in the situation, making his way toward us, hand outstretched.

XIX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Mateo 14:22-33

No sé si alguna vez en tu vida has tenido miedo a algo o a alguien, y te has dado cuenta de que el miedo paraliza: no te deja avanzar, incluso te ciega y no te permite ver. Muchas veces, las causas del miedo son falsas y solo sirven para amedrentar a la persona y dejarla sin esperanza. El miedo también nos quita la paz y nos impide hacer planes para el futuro. El Papa León XIV afirma que: "Cuanto más hermoso es el plan, mayor es la esperanza", sabiendo que "el futuro está en manos de Aquel que ofrece la mayor esperanza". El santo cardenal John Henry Newman, canonizado por el Papa Francisco en octubre de 2019, escribió lo siguiente: "A través de las tinieblas que me rodean, condúceme tú, siempre más adelante. La noche es oscura y estoy lejos del hogar: condúceme tú, siempre más adelante. Guía mis pasos; un solo paso cada vez es bastante para mí. Deseaba escoger y ver mi camino, pero ahora, condúceme tú, siempre adelante".

El pasaje del Evangelio que nos narra lo sucedido a los discípulos en el lago, aquella noche, es muy parecido a lo que vivimos en el día a día de nuestra vida. La barca era golpeada por las olas y el viento era fuerte. En medio de todos esos acontecimientos aparece Jesús caminando sobre las aguas, y ellos, asustados, creen ver un fantasma. El miedo los paraliza y gritan aterrados. Enseguida, Jesús les dice: "Ánimo, no teman, que soy yo" (Mateo 14:27). ¡Señor, nos falta fe como a Pedro! Danos tu mano y sálvanos.



Buscando a Dios

¿Qué pensamos cuando vemos a Jesús venir a salvarnos?

Lo primero que gritan los Apóstoles es "¡Fantasma!" cuando ven a Jesús caminando hacia ellos sobre el agua. Eso siempre me hace reír. Después de todo lo que han presenciado hasta ahora como compañeros del Mesías, ven a alguien caminando sobre el agua y aun así reaccionan como extras en un mal episodio de Scooby-Doo.

Siempre somos más rápidos en creer algo malo que en algo bueno. Podemos creer fácilmente los chismes y los rumores sobre un amigo, pero tememos que nos tomen por tontos cuando se trata de fe. Preferimos parecer cínicos que tontos.

"Sálvame, Dios, porque las aguas han llegado a mi cuello", dice el Salmo 69. "Mis ojos fallan de buscar a mi Dios."

Pienso en mi vida, en todas las formas en que Dios me ha salvado de deslizarme bajo la superficie. Rara vez se me ocurría, en medio de todo eso, que me estaban rescatando. De hecho, normalmente pensaba que me estaban reteniendo bajo el agua. ¿Oí Su voz guiándome, o solo escuché mi propia desesperación? "Sálvame, Dios." ¿Le estaba buscando o tenía los ojos cerrados por el miedo? "Mis ojos fallan de buscar a mi Dios."

Es hasta después de los hechos — a veces años después, o décadas — cuando vemos las cosas con claridad. Que veamos a Cristo en la situación, acercándose a nosotros, con la mano extendida.

Prayer in Faith in Trial

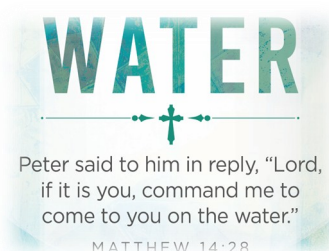
Dear God,

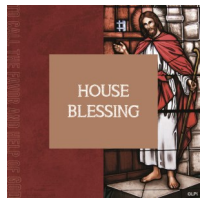

House Blessing

Mini Explanation —

Catholics who move to a new place of residence often wish to have their dwelling blessed, to call the favor and help of God upon all those who live in the house and all those who will enter it. The Roman Ritual provides two formats for such blessings.



House Blessing, Explained!

Catholics who move to a new place of residence often wish to have their dwelling blessed, to call the favor and help of God upon all those who live in the house and all those who will enter it.

The Roman Ritual (Book of Blessings) provides two formats for house blessings: one during the Easter or Christmas season (specifically for the Epiphany) and one for Ordinary Time. Those who live in the home must be present for a house to be blessed. A priest, deacon or lay person can administer the blessing, although if a lay person does so they must use the rites accorded to lay ministers in the Roman Ritual. A house blessing includes Scripture readings, intercessions and a prayer of blessing.

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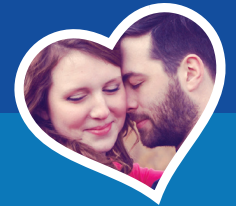
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
