St. Anthony de Padua WELCOMES you! In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the baptized person is “sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit” and is strengthened for service to the Body of Christ. We are excited to be a part of such a special time and invite you to register for **any one class** listed below. The class is free of charge and we encourage you to attend with your sponsor.

Please read the following important information prior to your requested class date.

1. In order to register, you must complete the required registration form in it's entirety and return to the Parish office along with all required documents.
2. Please choose your Saint Name prior to class. (See attached document-“Choosing a Saint Name.”) Your chosen Saint will play an important part in your spiritual journey as a model and intercessor.
3. Required Documents:
 - Certificate of Baptism– with notations
 - 1st Holy Communion Certificate -(only if 1st communion is not notated on certificate of baptism)

* If you do not have a sealed certificate, please contact the parish where you were baptized and ask for a certificate with notations. They should be able to provide you with an updated Sacramental certificate.

See Class dates below. **It is important for us to know which class you will be attending.** St. Anthony de Padua is responsible for submitting all the necessary documentation to the Archdiocese of San Antonio prior to you receiving your Confirmation.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION Regarding Sponsors, Please read carefully

The attached Confirmation Sponsor form must be completed by your sponsors' parish pastor and returned to St. Anthony de Padua Catholic Church.

Requirements for Sponsors are as follows:

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years old.
- ◆ A practicing Catholic that has received the sacrament of Confirmation
- ◆ Cannot be a parent or stepparent of the one being confirmed.
- ◆ If married, they must be married in the Catholic church.

Please ensure your sponsor meets all requirements prior to class date, if you do not have a sponsor one can be provided from our parish community.

Choosing a Saint Name

As we prepare for Confirmation, Confirmation saints are chosen to be a person we want to be like, as well as someone who can pray for us from heaven. Through the process of canonization, when someone is declared by the Church to be a saint, the Church is proclaiming that this member of the faithful practiced heroic virtue during their life on earth, 'the Church recognizes the power of the Spirit of holiness within her and sustains the hope of believers by proposing the saints to them as models and intercessors' (CCC 828).

Choosing a saint name is an important part of preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. In choosing a saint name, we are reflecting on our own spirituality, our strengths, and weaknesses, and finding a friend in the process. These saints, like our sponsors, will play an integral role in our spiritual journey, walking beside us as we grow closer to God and praying for us along the way.

As a young teen in the early 4th century, Saint Agnes was martyred because she refused to denounce her faith. Saint Aloysius, a young Jesuit in the late 16th century, helped care for people who were sick with the plague, giving them care and love as they left this world. His close contact with the disease took his life soon thereafter. Both these young saints bear witness to having love of God as their first priority.

It is important to remember that as members of the Church, we have never been alone, as St. Paul said, 'We are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses' (Hebrews 12:1). These witnesses are the saints who continually intercede for us (CCC 956); in choosing a confirmation saint, we are choosing a special friend to intercede for us in heaven and after whom we can model our lives while here on earth.

Your Confirmation saint is someone who you can talk to whenever you need them and they will always have your back!
