Registration for Faith Formation classes will be held in the Immaculate Conception room from 10:00 AM-11:00 AM on:

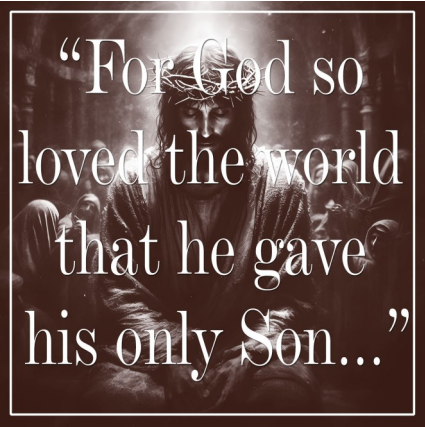
- **Sunday, September 21** (*last day to register*)
