4	Matters arising: It was noted that there are participants on the Wednesday rides who have not renewed their memberships. It was agreed that there would be a cut off date of the 15 th June after which non members would be removed from the WhatsApp group, There are 84 people on the WhatsApp group but we only have 60 signed up members. If there are no candidates to fill the committee, the committee discussed how the club could continue with a reduced number of “committee “ members. It was agreed that there need to be persons responsible for the finances of the club and selecting the weekly rides. It was felt that due to the number of members there should be enough interest to establish a new committee – maybe with reduced members Also discussed was whether SCC need to be affiliated to British Cycling. It was agreed that this affiliation should continue as it provides insurance cover for the officers of the club and also a record of paid up members SF mentioned he still accessed the club bank account through previous officers. It was agreed that a new bank account should be opened and SF will transfer the funds to this new account
