The Ascension of the Lord Seventh Sunday of Easter

The Ascension of the Lord, a moment of both ending and new beginning — after Jesus's resurrection, he ascends into heaven; forty days later, he is fulfilling his earthly mission; sending the Holy Spirit to empower his disciples to be his witnesses to the ends of the earth.

We are not to just sit and wait, we must move and be a witness to the world. The Ascension calls us to move from watching the Gospel to living out the Gospel; trusting that the Spirit will guide us through and empower our mission.

Jesus is gone, yet He is not absent. His rise in heaven is our call to rise with him toward the heavenly kingdom. His ascension with his crucifixion, shows the humanity he shares in divine glory. This mystery of his departure deepens our faith, reminding us that his grace remains with us in the sacraments and in our daily lives.

Our mission is no longer to solely be dependent on his physical presence BUT we are called to mature in faith, courage and service; to baptize and to teach, spreading His word, His love and His truth. Our mission to make disciples of all nations.

This, a celebration of hope, joy, and purpose, reminding us that while Jesus is no longer physically present, His reign continues through His Church and His Spirit remains with us. We are invited to live faithfully – one day heaven will be our home. A promise of his return, sustained by the endless union between the Father, the Son and we who believe.



La Acencion del Señor Séptimo Domingo de Pascua

La Ascensión del Señor, un momento de final como de nuevo comienzo: después de la resurrección de Jesús, asciende al cielo; cuarenta días después, está cumpliendo su misión terrenal; enviando al Espíritu Santo para capacitar a sus discípulos a ser sus testigos hasta los confines de la tierra.

No debemos limitarnos a sentarnos y esperar, debemos movernos y ser testigos ante el mundo. La Ascensión nos llama a pasar de observar el Evangelio a vivir el Evangelio; confiando en que el Espíritu nos guiará y fortalecerá nuestra misión.

Jesús se ha ido, pero no está ausente. Su ascenso al cielo es nuestro llamado a levantarnos con él hacia el reino celestial. Su ascensión junto con su crucifixión muestra la humanidad que comparte en la gloria divina. Este misterio de su partida profundiza nuestra fe, recordándonos que su gracia permanece con nosotros en los sacramentos y en nuestra vida diaria.

Nuestra misión ya no es depender únicamente de su presencia física, SINO que estamos llamados a madurar en fe, coraje y servicio; a bautizar y enseñar, difundiendo Su palabra, Su amor y Su verdad. Nuestra misión es hacer discípulos de todas las naciones.
