SPIRITUAL CORNER

READINGS FOR TODAY

First Reading: The glory of the Lord shines upon you. (*Is 60:1-6*)

Psalm: Lord, every nation on earth will adore you. (*Ps 72*)

Second Reading: Now it has been revealed that the Gentiles are coheirs of the promise. (*Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6*)

Gospel: We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage. (*Jn 1:1-18*)

Eucharistic Miracle of GRUARO (VALVASONE) ITALY, 1294

The relic of this Miracle is kept in the Church of the Most Holy Body of Christ in Valvasone, but the miracle happened in Gruaruo. In 1294, a young housemaid went to the public wash-house of Versiola to wash the altar linens of the Church of St. Giusto in Gruaro. Suddenly, the woman noticed that a consecrated Host had remained by mistake among the folds of the cloth and that Blood was flowing from it. Frightened by this inexplicable event, she immediately ran to alert the pastor who then informed the Bishop of Concordia, Giacomo di Ottonello from Cividade. The Bishop, having learned the facts, asked to be able to keep the cloth of the miracle in his Cathedral in Concordia. However, the pastor of Gruaro and the family of the Counts of Valvasone, patrons of the churches of Gruaro and of Valvasone, wanted to keep the cloth. No agreement was reached, and so it was decided to seek recourse with the Holy See. In the end, Rome let the Counts keep the relic, on the condition that they would build a church dedicated to the Most Holy Body of Christ. The construction of the church was completed in 1483.

The oldest and most authoritative document describing the miracle is a decree of Pope Nicholas V written in 1454. The title of the parish church, formerly St. Mary and St. John the Evangelist was thereby changed to the Church of the Most Holy Body of Christ (March 28, 1454). Today, the cloth is kept in a crystal cylinder, held by a precious reliquary of silver made by master craftsman Antonio Calligari. The celebration of the Holy Cloth is commemorated on the 5th Thursday of Lent, at the end of days of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, with the participation of the priests and of the community of Valvasone. During the celebration of Corpus Christi, the reliquary is carried in procession with the Most Blessed Sacrament.





Epiphany reflection by Pope Francis, in his Apostolic Letter *Admirabile Signum*, on the meaning and importance of the nativity scene

At the feast of Epiphany we place the statues of the Three Kings in the Christmas crèche. Observing the star, those wise men from the East set out for Bethlehem, in order to find Jesus and to offer him their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. These costly gifts have an allegorical meaning: gold honours Jesus' kingship, incense his divinity, myrrh his sacred humanity that was to experience death and burial.

As we contemplate this aspect of the nativity scene, we are called to reflect on the responsibility of every Christian to spread the Gospel. Each of us is called to bear glad tidings to all, testifying by our practical works of mercy to the joy of knowing Jesus and his love.

The Magi teach us that people can come to Christ by a very long route. Men of wealth, sages from afar, thirsting for the infinite, they set out on the long and perilous journey that would lead them to Bethlehem (cf. Mt 2:1-12). Great joy comes over them in the presence of the Infant King. They are not scandalized by the poor surroundings, but immediately fall to their knees to worship him. Kneeling before him, they understand that the God who with sovereign wisdom guides the course of the stars also guides the course of history, casting down the mighty and raising up the lowly. Upon their return home, they would certainly have told others of this amazing encounter with the Messiah, thus initiating the spread of the Gospel among the nations.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Prima Lectura: La gloria del Señor alborea sobre ti. (Is 60, 1-6)

Milagro Eucarístico d GRUARO (VALVASONE) ITALIA, 1294

La Reliquia de este Milagro se custodia en la Iglesia del Santísimo Cuerpo de Cristo en Valvasone, pero el Prodigio se verificó en Gruaro. En el año 1294 una joven se dirigió al lavatorio de la acequia del Versiola para lavar un mantel de altar de la iglesia de San Justo de Gruaro. De pronto, la mujer se dio cuenta que una Hostia consagrada se había quedado por equivocación entre los pliegues del mantel y de ella brotaba sangre. Llena de temor, corrió en busca del Párroco para advertirle de lo sucedido. El párroco informó al Obispo de Concordia, Giacomo d'Ottonello de Cividale quien, una vez que certificó el hecho, pidió poder tener el mantel del Milagro en la Catedral de Concordia. Sin embargo, el párroco de Gruaro y la familia de los Condes de Valvasone, que gozaban del derecho de conferir beneficios eclesiásticos en el territorio de la iglesia de Gruaro y de Valvasone, deseaban también tener ellos el mantel. Viendo que no se llegaba a ningún acuerdo, recurrieron a la Santa Sede quien autorizó a los Condes la custodia de la Reliquia del Milagro en Valvasone, con la condición que se construyese una iglesia dedicada al Santísimo Cuerpo de Cristo. La construcción de la iglesia fue concluida en 1483.

El documento de mayor autoridad y antigüedad que habla del Milagro es un rescrito del año 1454 del Papa Nicolás V. Fue entonces que el título de la iglesia parroquial, llamada precedentemente Santa María y San Juan Evangelista, fue cambiado por disposición del Pontífice a Iglesia del Santísimo Cuerpo de Cristo (28 de marzo de 1454). Hoy, el mantel se conserva en un cilindro de cristal, sostenido por un rico relicario de plata del maestro Antonio Calligari. La fiesta del Sagrado Mantel se celebra el V jueves de Cuaresma, como conclusión de las jornadas de adoración del Santísimo Sacramento. Allí participan sacerdotes, junto con la comunidad foránea de Valvasone. Durante la fiesta del Corpus Domini, la reliquia es llevada en procesión, junto con el Santísimo Sacramento.

Hermanas y hermanos, la solemnidad de la epifanía debería ir precedida de aquello que decimos en el prefacio de la Santa Misa: "¡levantemos el corazón!" Dios se manifiesta en Jesús: tal es el contenido maravilloso, inagotable, precioso sobre toda hermosura, de esta fiesta singular. Ahora pues que la Belleza Increada deja escuchar su voz, y somos convocados a gozarnos en la visión del Eterno, vengan a acompañarnos y sean guías nuestros: un corazón contemplativo, unos oídos capaces de escuchar y un corazón capaz de acoger.

Jesús entero podría llamarse como se llama esta fiesta: Epifanía. "Quien me ha visto a mí, ha visto al Padre", dijo él una vez a Felipe (Jn 14,9), y muchas veces a nosotros. Nos lo repite cada vez que sentimos lo que sintió Felipe: "Muéstranos al Padre, y eso nos basta" (Jn 14,8). ¿Has conocido la punzante inquietud que sienten los niños que nunca han conocido a su papá, especialmente cuando llegan a la juventud? ¿Has visto con qué ansiedad buscan ese rostro, esa referencia existencial, esa primera clave de lectura que sólo un papá puede darles? Algo así tiene el alma humana, algo incisivo, que nada puede apagar, algo que nos dice gritar con Felipe. "¡muéstranos al Padre!". La respuesta a este clamor, el descanso de esta zozobra es Jesús: ver a Jesús, reposar en Jesús. Él es nuestra epifanía.

Los perfumes delicados, los vestidos finos, las joyas fastuosas significan siempre precios inalcanzables, dinero a montones, costos imposibles. No es así con Jesús. El más bello es también el más humilde; el más santo es también el más cercano; el más sabio es también el más comprensible; el más puro es también el más amigable y el más acogedor. Su grandeza no nos aplasta sino que nos levanta; su pureza no nos humilla sino que nos limpia. Eso es lo grande de esta Epifanía.

Jesús es el llamado de la belleza y de la humildad sin límites. Porque, en el fondo, la humildad es bella y la belleza es humilde. Un rostro hermoso y petulante puede halagar los sentidos, pero a precio de entristecer el alma, y eso en realidad no es hermosura. Sólo Jesús, en la dulce paz de su presencia sin escándalos, en la serena palabra de su corazón cargado de amor, puede manifestar al hombre esa belleza que no cansa, que no se repite, que siempre refresca. ¡Bendita Epifanía, cúbreanos de tu esplendor y enséñanos el camino a la Felicidad Perpetua!


