

# SPIRITUAL CORNER

## PAROCHIAL VICAR'S MESSAGE

The readings speak about a time of change, a re-orientation of life. Jonah preaches to the sinful people of Nineveh; they believe God's words announced by Jonah and they repent. The Responsorial Psalm is a prayer asking God to show the right way for the believer to follow. In his letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul urges the believers in Corinth to live a different life, a life not attached to their former, worldly ways. In the Gospel, Jesus begins His ministry by announcing the coming of the Reign of God and the need for belief and repentance. He also calls His first disciples, who drop everything and follow Him.

The story of Jonah begins with Jonah seeking to flee from doing God's will. He set sail away from Nineveh. After a terrible storm, which Jonah knows is a result of his sinfulness, Jonah is thrown overboard and is swallowed by a huge sea creature. After his journey in the giant "fish," Jonah turns to doing God's will by announcing the destruction of Nineveh. When the people hear God's word as announced by Jonah, they believe and turn their hearts to God and seek God's forgiveness. They reform their lives in the hope that God may not carry out the destruction planned. God also repents (turns the divine heart around) and does not destroy the town because they believed and repented (turned their hearts around, re-oriented their lives).

The psalmist, in the spirit of Jonah, prays to God. Like Jonah, the psalmist asks to be shown the right path, instead of running away to escape from doing God's will. Just as Jonah finally learned, the psalmist realizes that God does show sinners the way to repentance.

Writing to the people of Corinth, St. Paul urges them to act as if the Lord Jesus would be returning momentarily. At this point in Paul's missionary life, he believes the end of the world and the return of the Lord Jesus was coming soon, very soon. Thus, he suggests that the believers act as if the end of the world as they knew it was happening right now. He wants them to live lives which are detached from the worldly ways. He asks that they let go of all their old habits and ways of life and focus only on the coming Reign of the Lord Jesus.

The Gospel has two foci: 1) Jesus announcing the Reign of God with the need to believe and repent, and 2) Jesus calling His first disciples. The Good News of Reign of God and the repentance associated with it are different than John the Baptist's cry for a symbolic baptism of repentance. Jesus adds the importance of belief. One must believe that God has established the Reign of God now through the ministry of Jesus. This leads to true repentance and forgiveness of sin. The call of Peter and Andrew, James and John are important also. Jesus asks that these first disciples drop their fishing nets and come after Him. They will be doing an entirely different sort of gathering, gathering not fish, but gathering people who are to be a part of the Reign of God.

## Eucharistic Miracle of MACERATA ITALY, 1356

At Macerata in the church of the Cathedral of Holy Mary Assumed and St. Giuliano, under the altar of the Most Holy Sacrament, it is possible to venerate the relic of the "corporal marked by Blood." Also preserved in this church is the parchment on which the miracle is described. Furthermore, the historian Ferdinando Ughelli cited this miracle in his work Sacred Italy of 1647 and describes how since the fourteenth century "the corporal has been carried in solemn procession through the city, enclosed in an urn of crystal and silver, with the concourse of all Piceno." All of the documents likewise agree in the description of how the miraculous facts occurred. An anonymous priest, during the Mass, was struck with strong doubts about the reality of the transubstantiation, and when he broke the Great Host, he saw blood drop from the Host and fall onto the corporal and chalice. The priest immediately informed Bishop Nicholas of San Martino, who ordered that the relic of the Blood-stained cloth be carried into the cathedral and he instituted a regular canonical process.

In 1493 one of the first confraternities in honor of the Most Blessed Sacrament was instituted at Macerata (1494) and it was here that the pious practice of Forty Hours was established in 1556. Every year on the occasion of Corpus Christi, the corporal of the miracle is carried in procession behind the Most Blessed Sacrament.

## Milagro Eucarístico MACERATA ITALIA, 1356

En Macerata, en la iglesia Catedral de Santa María Asunta y San Julián, bajo el altar del Santísimo Sacramento, es posible venerar la Reliquia del "corporal manchado de sangre". En la misma iglesia, se conserva también un pergamo de la época en el que se describe el Prodigio. El historiador Ferdinando Ughelli cita este Milagro en su obra Italia Sacra del año 1647. Allí describe que ya desde el siglo XIV "el corporal era llevado en solemne procesión por la ciudad, custodiado en una urna de cristal de plata, con la participación de toda la comarca del Piceno". Todos los documentos concuerdan en la descripción del hecho prodigioso. Un sacerdote, comenzó a tener fuertes dudas durante la Misa acerca de la realidad de la transubstanciación. Cuando fraccionó la Hostia Magna, vio que de ella comenzó a destilar sangre hasta el punto de manchar el corporal y el cáliz. El sacerdote informó inmediatamente al Obispo Nicolás de San Martín sobre lo ocurrido, el cual ordenó llevar la reliquia del corporal ensangrentado a la Catedral e instituyó un proceso canónico regular. En 1494 se instituyó en Macerata una de las primeras Confraternidades en honor al SS. Sacramento (1494), y fue precisamente allí que nació la práctica piadosa de las Cuarenta horas (1556). Cada año, en ocasión de la fiesta del Corpus Domini, el Corporal del Milagro es llevado en procesión detrás del Santísimo Sacramento.

Hermanas y hermanos, la realidad más visible en las lecturas de hoy está, sin duda, en el arrepentimiento. Jonás predica en la ciudad pagana por excelencia, Nínive; Cristo predica en Galilea. El mensaje, sin embargo, es distinto, por lo menos en su aspecto exterior: "Dentro de cuarenta días Nínive será destruida", dice Jonás; "El Reino de Dios ha llegado", anuncia Jesús. Podemos mirar en estas expresiones diversas las dos caras del mensaje que llama a conversión.

"Nínive será destruida" nos invita a pensar hacia dónde nos estamos encaminando, es decir: adónde conduce la alternativa que hemos tomado. "El Reino de Dios ha llegado" nos invita a mirar el otro camino, la alternativa que hemos descartado. Y bien, preguntémonos adónde va nuestro mundo. No nos contentemos con asumir las noticias como van llegando: despenalización del aborto, aprobación del "matrimonio" homosexual, manipulación genética e intentos de clonación humana, eugenios abierta o implícita, eutanasia que se extiende como vergonzosa plaga por el mundo. ¿Adónde va un mundo que va aprobando en secuencia cada una de estas cosas? A la destrucción. Es misión, aunque amarga, del predicador mostrar, hacer visible esa destrucción, y eso es lo que hace Jonás.


¿Hay otra posibilidad? Jesús anuncia la llegada del Reino. El Reino viene porque el mundo ya no va más. Dios se acerca al hombre porque el hombre ha mostrado su incapacidad de acercarse a Dios. Eso enseña Jesucristo. Y por cierto las matemáticas le dan la razón. El mundo no puede renovarse a sí mismo porque la suma de las conveniencias, multiplicada por la montaña de los egoísmos, resta demasiado de las fuerzas del bien, ya de hecho divididas por orgullos y afanes de protagonismo. La burocracia es la artritis de la bondad y la codicia el acelerador de la maldad. Así el mundo se desgarra entre la conciencia de un bien que no alcanza y la presencia de un mal que detesta.

"¡Convertíos!", suplica y ordena Jesucristo. Es una súplica, porque nace de un corazón que sufre de amor por el mundo; es una orden, porque es un acto de justicia frente a Dios que no recibe del hombre lo que éste le debe en gratitud y alabanza, pero sobre todo en amor. Así vemos abrirse el ministerio público de Jesús, con unas matemáticas nuevas: suma tu fe a la fuerza de la palabra y restarás de la montaña de tus culpas, y dividirás a la turba de tus enemigos.
