

SPIRITUAL CORNER

READINGS FOR TODAY

First Reading - If you wrong the widow and the orphan, my wrath will flare up against you. (*Ex 22:20-26*)

Psalm - I love you, Lord, my strength . (*Ps 18*)

Second Reading - you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God and to await his Son from heaven (*1 Thes 1:5c-10*)

Gospel - You shall love the Lord, your God and your neighbor as yourself. (*Mt 22:34-40*)

Eucharistic Miracle of Bagno di Romagna , ITALY, 1412

At Bagno di Romagna, in the Basilica of St. Maria Assumed, the relic of the Eucharistic miracle of the "Holy Cloth Soaked by Blood" is preserved. The historian Fortunio thus describes the miracle in his noted work Annales Camaldenses: "It was the year 1412. The Camoldese abbey of Santa Maria in Bagno (then Priorato) was governed by Don Lorenzo, of Venetian origin. While he was celebrating the Divine Sacrifice, his mind was occupied, by a diabolical work, with a strong doubt about the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament; when he then saw the sacred species of the wine flow over the chalice and land on the corporal in the form of wine and living Blood, and thus the corporal remained soaked. It cannot be told how great was his emotion and perturbation of mind in that instant in the face of such a profound event. In tears he turned to the bystanders, confessing his unbelief and the miracle which now had taken place before his eyes."

The monk Lazzaro was then transferred to Bologna as chaplain of the female Camaldolesian convent of St. Christine, where he died in 1416. The Camoldese held the Parish of Bagno until the Napoleonic suppression of 1808; from then the Parish - Basilica of St. Mary Assumed, after having been held for a brief period by the diocese of Sansepolcro, in 1975 passed definitively to become part of the diocese of Cesena. In 1912, Cardinal Gilio Boschi, Archbishop of Ferrara, celebrated the fifth centenary of the miracle, which was followed by a conference on Eucharistic studies. In 1958, His Excellency Domenico Bornigia, had a chemical analysis done on the marks of the corporal of the miracle at the University of Florence, which confirmed them to be of an emetic nature. In the basilica is found a colored and very rare incision on wood from 1400 called "The Madonna of the Blood," which is found in the third chapel on the left. This image is thus named because, as Benedetto Tenaci, abbot of Bagno and eye witness of the miracle on May 20, 1948, tells us, the icon bled from the left arm. Every year, during the Feast of Corpus Christi, the corporal is carried in procession through the streets of the city and is exposed on every Sunday of the temperate season which lasts from March to November, at the

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"The heart of Christian morality is the desire to love God fully, completely, and to love others as unique reflections of God's love. We can see an analogy in the love we must have in the love that good parents have for their children. Parents do not try to find the minimal amount of love they must have to be good parents. Parents continually give their love because they know their children need their love. Parents do not love their children because they are afraid that if they do not love their children God will punish them. Parents love their children because they are their children. Parents love their children for whom they are, expressions of love, loving them back. Parents do not love their children due to their looks, talents, or intelligence. They love them because they are their children. God loves us because we are His children.

Jesus is calling us to love God and neighbor completely, without counting the cost. Shema Israel. God wants us to love him with our whole mind, our whole heart, and our whole soul.

"Love your enemies" the Lord commanded. Loving our neighbors as ourselves means that just as we want to be united to God, we want others to be united to God. When this becomes the focus of our relationships, then we are loving others as Christ taught us to love. I want to flesh this out. Let us say you entered a business partnership with a friend. As time goes on, the business is not showing the profit it initially showed. Then, after a few years, the government came knocking. Taxes had not been paid because your partner had been embezzling from the business. Not only do you lose the business, but you also lose your home, your car, and so forth. Now your wife and children must make do in a small apartment. Meanwhile, your former partner has initiated a lawsuit against you.

And Jesus says, "Love your enemies." How are you supposed to do that? Well, when we get into a situation like this, we must strengthen our relationship with God by increasing our prayer life. We need to pray that our former partner will turn from evil and himself embrace a relationship with God. This is tough. We see what this guy has done to our family and everything about us wants to violate the Second Commandment and wish that he suffers the torments of hell. But Jesus is saying, "No, wish the opposite. Wish that he changes his life and go to heaven." God wants our love to win others over for him. That is the meaning of "when someone slaps you on your right cheek, offer him your left cheek."

Being a Christian is tough business. It means following the one who on the cross forgave his executioners, "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they are doing.

"Love God with your whole heart, our whole soul, and your whole mind, and love your neighbor as yourself." This sums up everything there is in the law and the prophets. The lawyer asked, "What does God want from us?" Jesus answered, "He wants it all."

Milagro Eucarístico de ASTI, ITALIA, 1535

En Bagno di Romagna, en la Basílica de Santa María Assunta, se conserva la Reliquia del Milagro Eucarístico del "Sagrado Corporal empapado de Sangre". El historiador Fortunio describe así el Milagro en su importante obra Annales Camaldulenses: "corría el año 1412. La abadía camaldulense de Santa María en Bagno (entonces priorazgo) era gobernada por el Padre Lázaro, de origen véneto. Un día, mientras celebraba el divino Sacrificio, fue ocupada su mente por obra diabólica de una fuerte duda acerca de la presencia real de Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento. En ese preciso momento, vio que la sagrada especie del vino empezaba a hervir y a derramarse fuera del cáliz hasta llegar al corporal en forma de sangre viva y palpitante, empapándolo completamente. No existen palabras para decir cuán fuerte fuese la conmoción y la turbación que en ese instante el sacerdote tuvo frente a un hecho de tal magnitud. En lágrimas se dirigió a los presentes, confesando su incredulidad y exponiendo el Prodigio que se había realizado bajo su mirada". Poco después, el monje Lázaro se trasladó a Boloña como capellán del monasterio femenino camaldulense de Santa Cristina, donde murió en 1416. Los camaldulenses, luego de varios acontecimientos, mantuvieron el gobierno de la Pieve di Bagno hasta la supresión napoleónica del 1808. Desde entonces la Parroquia-Basílica de Santa María Asunta, después de pertenecer por un breve período a la diócesis de Sansepolcro, en 1975 pasó a ser parte definitivamente de la diócesis de Cesena. En 1912, el Cardenal Julio Boschi, Arzobispo de Ferrara, celebró el quinto centenario del Milagro convocando también un simposio sobre estudios eucarísticos. En 1958, S.E. Domingo Bornigia, mandó realizar un análisis químico de las manchas del Corporal del Milagro en la Universidad de Florencia. Fue confirmada el origen hemático. En la Basílica, precisamente en la tercera capilla hacia la izquierda, se encuentra un rarísimo grabado a colores y de madera del 1400, llamado "La Virgen de la sangre". Esta imagen fue llamada así porque como cuenta don Benedicto Tenaci, abad de Bagno y testimonio ocular del Prodigio, el 20 de mayo de 1498, el ícono derramó sangre del brazo izquierdo. Cada año, durante la fiesta del Corpus Domini, el Corporal es llevado en procesión por las calles de la ciudad y es expuesto todos los domingos de la estación termal (de marzo a noviembre), en la Misa celebrada a las once de la mañana.

Hermanas y hermanos, sabemos que la Biblia predica la compasión y la misericordia. Lo interesante de la primera lectura de hoy es la manera como se argumenta el mandato de ser compasivos. La idea es: reconócete en el pequeño, mírate en el pobre, descubre que tú fuiste (o, en el fondo, eres) como ese necesitado. Uno tiende a pensar que la ayuda debe brotar de la diferencia: "yo tengo mucho y aquel pobre tiene poco." Esa es una parte pero quizás no es la parte más importante. Sólo cuando llegamos a percibir el vínculo profundo que nos une obtenemos ojos capaces de horrorizarse por lo que nos separa.

Si veo a un mendigo puedo sentir desde amor hasta asco. Si de pronto llego a saber que ese mendigo es mi padre, que padece una enfermedad senil, la misericordia brota como un río de amor y generosidad hacia él: cuanto más cerca lo descubro, más me espanta que la pobreza o el hambre nos estén separando hoy. Aplica tú lo mismo a la Humanidad.

Una pregunta directa provocó una respuesta directa: Uno de los escribas se acercó a Jesús y le preguntó: "¿Cuál es el primero de todos los mandamientos?" Jesús le respondió: "El primero es: Escucha, Israel: El Señor, nuestro Dios, es el único Señor; amarás al Señor tu Dios, con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma, con toda tu mente y con todas tus fuerzas. El segundo es éste: Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo. No hay ningún mandamiento mayor que éstos". Es bueno recordar ese lenguaje escueto porque en un mundo plagado de fachadas y máscaras es fácil acostumbrarse a disculparlo todo o justificarlo todo o venderlo todo. El orden empieza siempre con un pensamiento claro en la mente; una idea llena de luz atrae a otras. Y hoy Jesús nos da esa clave fundamental, ese primer principio que iluminó su alma santa y que quiere iluminar también nuestras vidas.

La palabra fundamental en la respuesta de Jesucristo no la podemos perder: AMA. El resto de su respuesta es esencial también, porque todo depende de a quién ames y con qué amor. Tal fue el regalo que nos dio con su vida y su muerte. Bien podemos resumir la existencia de Cristo diciendo que fue una gran cátedra de amor en la que aprendimos que hemos de amar para vivir y hemos de aprender a amar para vencer a la muerte y alcanzar la vida que no muere.
