Descriptions

Nor does any employee of the auctioneers have authority to make any representation of fact and the auctioneers disclaim on behalf of the vendors and themselves any responsibility for authenticity, age, origin and condition and for any accuracy of measurement or weight of any lot or lots.

Bidding

A BUYERS PREMIUM of 10% will be added to the final sale price of each and every lot at the fall of the hammer, to be paid in full by the purchaser before goods are released.

Purchasers are deemed to have satisfied themselves as to the authenticity and condition of any lots before bidding. No bid will be withdrawn either during the sale of a lot or following completion of any lot sale.

The auctioneers reserve the right to refuse any bid during the sale.

The auctioneer may divide, combine, add to or withdraw any lots and shall determine the advance of each bid and may bid on the behalf of the vendor on lots that have a reserve price.

The highest bidder shall be the buyer. If a dispute arises, the auctioneers have full discretion to settle the dispute or to re-offer lots. At the fall of the hammer the lots shall be at the sole risk of the purchaser. All purchasers are required to lodge their full name, address and deposit (if deemed required by the auctioneer) before commencement of the auction.

Clearance and Payment

No lots are to be removed from the sale without full payment of the purchase price and buyers premium being made. Payments can be made by a card transaction or cash. Payment by cheque will only be accepted if agreed prior to the sale with the auctioneers.

If the sold lots are not removed by the purchaser immediately after the end of the sale they will be subject to a charge for warehousing at a cost of £2.50 per lot, per day and transport will be charged to the purchaser for removal of the goods to the warehouse. 
