Important Update: Special Assessment & Project Revisions

Dear HOA Members,

We hope this message finds you well. As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining a safe and welcoming community, we want to provide an important update regarding the previously discussed special assessment and the unexpected repairs that have impacted our timeline and budget.

Why is this special assessment necessary?

Earlier this year, an assessment was required to help fund essential community projects. However, during the process, unexpected walkway and catwalk repairs arose that required immediate attention to address critical safety issues. These unforeseen conditions resulted in significant additional work, revisions to the project scope, and higher costs than originally anticipated. We apologize for the inconvenience as we attempt to coordinate with the contractors.

These projects will enhance safety, preserve property values, and maintain the quality of life for all residents. By acting now, we are ensuring that our community remains strong, attractive, and financially stable for years to come.
