✠ From the Pastor's Desk


Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Archbishop Henning called a meeting of all pastors and administrators on Thursday, January 29th to keep us informed on the state of the Archdiocese. He plans to have these meetings two or three times a year along with the convocation of all priests that usually held in the springtime. As of that meeting, he has visited at least eighty parishes and dozens of schools, institutes, hospitals, shelters and other places where the Lord's work is being done. His spirit is uplifted for he has seen that the faith is truly alive here in Boston. While he has been observing our uniqueness and similarities to other places he has served, he has concluded that parishes are essential to carrying out Jesus Christ's mission. Therefore, he announced that over the next several months we will be doing a self study of parish life, ministry and mission. Every priest will be interviewed by a member of the steering committee who identify strengths, challenges and emerging pressures across parishes. We will be honest about parish vitality, participation in worship and parish life; programs, staffing, facilities and financial realities; parish and priestly formation needs along with our hopes and aspirations for the future. Other members of the parish will be consulted or surveyed towards the end of the year. Once completed, a report will be released along with recommendations which could take the form of a coordinated, Archdiocesan wide fundraising effort.

I would ask that you keep Archbishop Henning and his advisors in your prayers. For someone in Church leadership, it can be "lonely at the top." His love for the Lord and for the people of God is becoming more evident each time that he meets with people and shares his wisdom.

Otros miembros de la parroquia serán consultados o encuestados hacia finales de año. Una vez finalizado, se publicará un informe con recomendaciones que podrían incluir una campaña de recaudación de fondos coordinada a nivel de toda la arquidiócesis.

February 14th is World Marriage Day!

On this World Marriage Day, we thank our heavenly Father for the gift and blessing of marriage and the family. As we strive to live our particular vocations and respond to the Lord's grace in our lives, let's also consider how we might dedicate renewed prayer and attention to marriage and the family.

As a start, here are possible areas we might consider:

First, we begin with prayer: Let's remember to pray with and for marriages and families throughout our nation: for marriages in crisis, for families struggling with unemployment, for broken or wounded family relationships.

Second, let us reclaim Sunday as the Lord's Day, a day of rest when we can focus on being together as a family. The celebration of Holy Mass together is the first essential way to honor this day. But is there something more the Lord is inviting us to when we go back home? Set aside some time to pray a decade of the rosary, enjoy the outdoors together, play ball, eat dinner together, have a game night!

And third, let us remember that the Church is the family of God and a family of families. As a family, how can we share Christ with other married couples and families? Do we have any friends and family members who are struggling in their marriage, alone during this time of isolation, or particularly afflicted by this pandemic? When was the last time we checked on our elderly neighbors? Is there someone in the parish that we haven't seen in a while? How can we—as a family—reach out to those who are in need?




