

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

The death of Msgr. Kelley has been met with much sadness because this man, who has been a part of your faith journey for well over thirty years, has been called home by the Lord. The same Lord called him to serve the People of God as priest and your pastor, and he fulfilled that mission. I can just imagine Frank hearing Jesus' words to him as he breathed his last on Wednesday, February 11th: "Well done, good and faithful servant. Inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world." You have shared with me the many ways that he has touched your lives in the sacraments, pastoral care and inviting you to be active in your faith. Under his leadership, the parish has grown and been one of the most diverse and welcoming.

It is also a tremendous loss for the Archdiocese of Boston. As the coordinator of the Clergy Benefit Trust said, he was "one of the greats." Priests seek each others' counsel and advice on a plethora of issues. I first met with Frank in 2002 when I was discerning coming to Sacred Heart as his parochial vicar but it was not in the cards at the time. Being assigned to Saint Mary's in Brookline gave me many opportunities to be in meetings with him with local clergy and to be on the guest list of his annual Advent gatherings. He was affirming and encouraging as I was assigned here and a phone call away whenever the inevitable questions arose.

We are all blessed to have known him. May he rest in the peace of Christ.

La muerte de Monseñor Kelley ha sido recibida con mucha tristeza porque este hombre que ha sido parte de su camino de fe por más de treinta años ha sido llamado a casa por el Señor. El mismo Señor lo llamó a servir al Pueblo de Dios como sacerdote y su pastor y él cumplió esa misión. Me animó y me apoyó durante mi asignación aquí, y estaba a una llamada de distancia cada vez que surgían las inevitables preguntas.

### *Lenten Regulations*

- **Abstinence** from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on **Ash Wednesday, Good Friday,** and all **\*Fridays** of Lent
- **Fasting** is to be observed on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** by all Catholics over the age of 18 but not yet 59. Those bound by this may only take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal practices.**

(Those who are ill, pregnant, on medication or special diets for health concerns, or those who work at extremely physical jobs may be exempt from these regulations)

\*In the United States, the bishops have asked Catholics over the age of 14 to abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent.





**ST. MARY'S CEMETERY**  
 St Mary's Cemetery in Needham, founded in the 1870's, is the parish cemetery of Mary Immaculate of Lourdes. The Cemetery is a reverent resting place for those awaiting reunion with the Risen Lord.
