During Holy Week we commemorate the Passion of Our Lord, beginning with his Messianic entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and all the events leading to His resurrection. For those who are able to fast for a prolonged period of time, please consider doing so from Good Friday until Holy Saturday. "In this way, the people of God will receive the joys of the Lord's resurrection with uplifted and responsive hearts." (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, 110). May your homes and places of work and recreation also take on the air of these solemn days.

Manuel González García was born in Seville, Spain in 1877 and ordained a priest in 1901. He was assigned his first parish mission in the little town of Palomares del Rio. It was there, where Our Lord spoke to him from an abandoned tabernacle, that was a defining moment in his life and clarified the direction for the rest of his priestly ministry.




