“Have you ever been in a crisis? In moments of fragility it is so important for us to be there for each other.” These are Pope Leo’s words that he posted on his Instagram account. Yes, the popes of our lifetime have kept up with social media to evangelize us. We have been able to hear their words in real time and then be prepared for the inevitable analysis and commentary. His Holiness’ words referred to his prayer intention for this month: “For priests in crisis. Let us pray for priests in crisis in their vocation, that they may feel the accompaniment they need and that communities may support them understanding and prayer.” The website to participate with Catholics and fellow believers in the Lord all over the world is popesprayer.va.

Here in Boston we priests gathered at the Chrism Mass during Holy Week at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross to renew the promises we made on the day of ordination to the Lord and the people whom we serve. Overall, I and many of my colleagues in the presbyterate are both happy and fulfilled in our vocations. But from time to time, for various reasons a priest may feel overwhelmed and lose direction in their lives. Prayer from the community along with professional and spiritual guidance can play a role in aiding the priest rediscover the reason why he was created and called for a particular end by God. 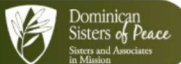

Manuel González García was born in Seville, Spain in 1877 and ordained a priest in 1901. He was assigned his first parish mission in the little town of Palomares del Rio. It was there, where Our Lord spoke to him from an abandoned tabernacle, that was a defining moment in his life and clarified the direction for the rest of his priestly ministry.
