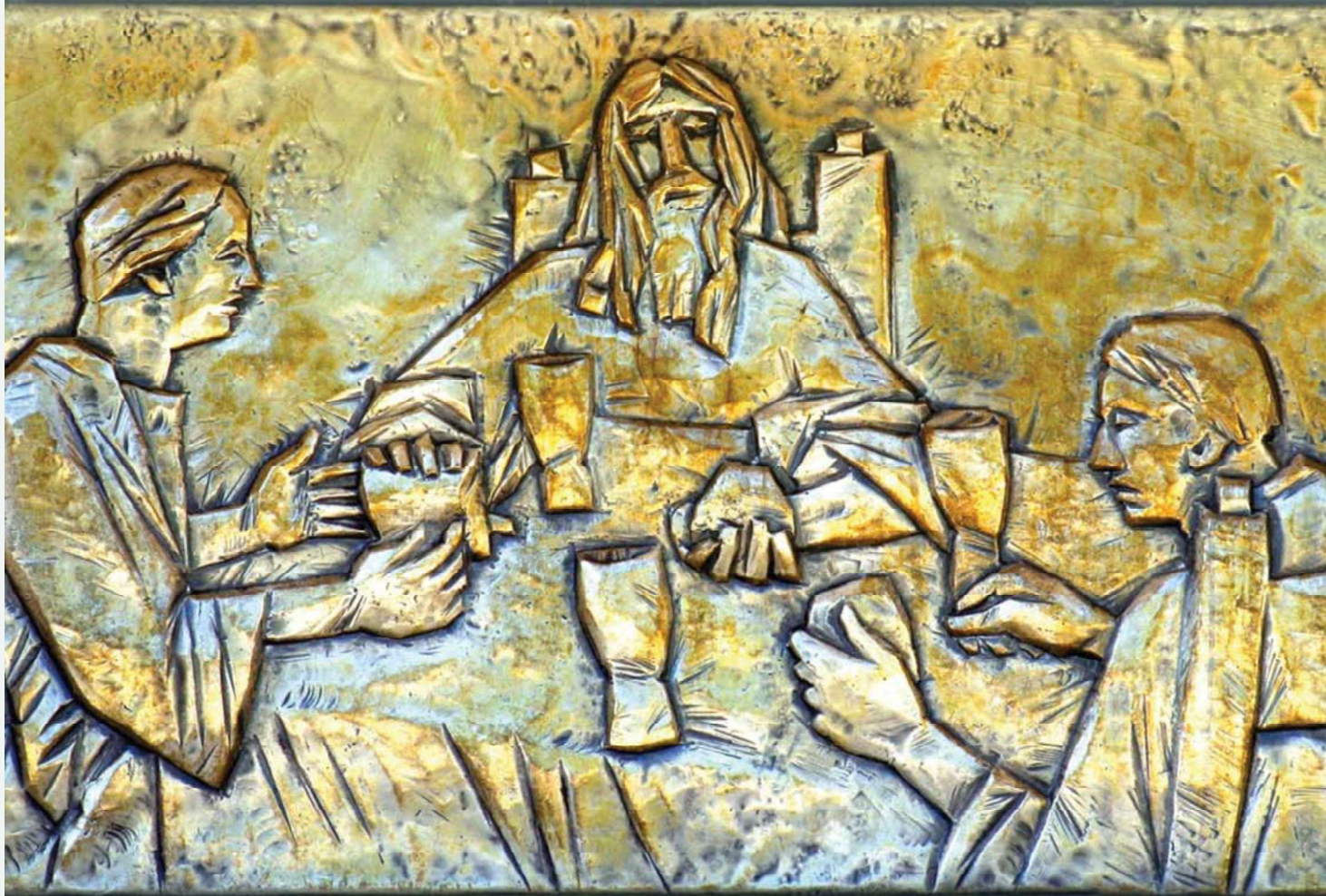

## Saint Mark, Evangelist

### Marcos el Evangelista

#### Saint Mark, Evangelist

According to the Acts of the Apostles, Mark's mother owned the house where the first Jerusalem Christians prayed and where Peter stayed after his miraculous release from prison (Acts 12:1-19). The New Testament also notes that Mark traveled with Paul and Barnabas on their mission to Antioch and that he was associated with both Paul and Peter in Rome. He may have written his Gospel, the shortest of the four, based on Peter's preaching while in Rome. By tradition, he was the martyred bishop of Alexandria, Egypt, with his relics later carried to Venice by Venetian merchants. In art, he is often symbolized by a lion. He is the patron saint of lions, lawyers, Venice, interpreters, and prisoners



#### Marcos el Evangelista

Segun los Hechos de los Apóstoles, la madre de Marcos era dueña de la casa en donde oraban los primeros cristianos de Jerusalem y donde Pedro permaneció luego de su milagrosa liberación de la prisión (Hechos 12: 1-19). El Nuevo Testamento también señala que Marcos viajó con Pablo y Bernabé en su misión a Antioquia y que estaba asociado con Pedro y Pablo en Roma. Puede ser que haya escrito su Evangelio, el más corto de los cuatro, basado en las predicas de Pedro mientras que estuvo en Roma. La tradición dice que Marcos murió como mártir cuando era obispo de Alejandría, Egipto, y que sus reliquias fueron llevadas más adelante a Venecia por unos comerciantes venecianos. En las obras de arte, a menudo, se le simboliza con un león. Marcos es el santo patron de los leones, de los abogados, de Venecia, de los intérpretes y de los prisioneros.


