✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Here are the highlights of the last Parish Pastoral Council meeting which was held on Monday, April 13th. We began planning the 10am Sunday Pentecost Mass which will have music and readings in several languages. Other upcoming parish events worth noting are the exhibit of Eucharistic Miracles on April 25 and 26, First Communions on May 2 and 3 and Confirmation on May 15th. A discussion about the liturgical environment continued from previous meetings. The availability of holy water was questioned since it was not visible in either of the sanctuaries. It is available in the rectory office during business hours. The location of the holy oils used in the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and anointing of the sick was brought up. Currently they are kept in a sacristy safe but the plan will be to purchase an appropriate display case known as an ambry to have them be more visible as the liturgical documents recommend. A subcommittee is also working on planning a goldfish fundraiser to be held in the fall. Our next meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 4th at 6:30pm in the Murray Room. These meetings are always open to all parishioners. I am grateful to the Council for their guidance, dedication and candor.

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

A continuación, presentamos los puntos más destacados de la última reunión del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial, celebrada el lunes 13 de abril. Comenzamos a planificar la Misa de Pentecostés del domingo a las 10:00 a. m., la cual contará con música y lecturas en varios idiomas. Otros eventos parroquiales próximos que cabe destacar son la exposición sobre los Milagros Eucarísticos, los días 25 y 26 de abril; las Primeras Comuniones, los días 2 y 3 de mayo; y la Confirmación, el 15 de mayo. Se continuó el diálogo, iniciado en reuniones anteriores, sobre el ambiente litúrgico. Se planteó la cuestión de la disponibilidad del agua bendita, dado que no resultaba visible en ninguno de los dos santuarios. Esta se encuentra disponible en la oficina de la rectoría durante el horario de atención al público. Asimismo, se abordó el tema de la ubicación de los santos óleos utilizados en los sacramentos del Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Unción de los enfermos. Actualmente, estos se custodian en la caja fuerte de la sacristía; sin embargo, el plan consiste en adquirir una vitrina adecuada —conocida como *ambry* o armario de los santos óleos— para que resulten más visibles, tal como recomiendan los documentos litúrgicos. Por otra parte, un subcomité se encuentra trabajando en la planificación de una actividad de recaudación de fondos —basada en la venta de peces dorados— que se llevará a cabo durante el otoño. Nuestra próxima reunión está programada para el lunes 4 de mayo, a las 6:30 p. m., en la Sala Murray. Estas reuniones están siempre abiertas a todos los feligreses. Expreso mi gratitud al Consejo por su orientación, su dedicación y su franqueza.

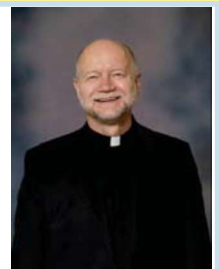
