✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

As the month of May begins so too does the Month of Mary. Yes, every day we ask for her protection, guidance and intercession but why are we invited to intensify our devotion during these thirty one days in particular? Ancient civilizations such as the Greeks and Romans looked to their gods and goddesses who were in charge of fecundity and blossoms during May.

In the Middle Ages, when winter gave way to spring, May obviously became linked with new life. Therefore, Christians looked to Christ's resurrection as the ultimate embodiment of this event and Mary's role in bringing new life into the world was not reserved for only select feast days but for the entire month. A Jesuit priest in Rome named Father Latomia encouraged his students to pray to Mary that she grant her favor through her Son to live holy lives. By the 1800's Pope Pius VII and Pope Pius IX granted indulgences to those who practiced prayers to Mary during the month. In 1945, Pope Pius XII declared May as an official month of observance to Our Lady.

Our parish school carries on the tradition that you may recall from your younger days. Later this month, our little scholars will crown Mary after a brief procession. I encourage you to pray the rosary, daily if possible, for your families and anything that weighs on your heart; for those who receiving holy communion for the first time; for those to be confirmed in our parish and for the men to be ordained to the transitional diaconate and priesthood in the Archdiocese of Boston. Remember all mothers, living and deceased, who have taught us the faith. Most especially, pray that all wars and conflicts cease. Mary, Queen of Peace, pray for us!

MARY, OUR MOTHER

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

Con el inicio del mes de mayo, comienza también el Mes de María. Sí, cada día solicitamos su protección, su guía y su intercesión; pero, ¿por qué se nos invita a intensificar nuestra devoción precisamente durante estos treinta y un días? Las civilizaciones antiguas, como la griega y la romana, dirigían su mirada hacia sus dioses y diosas —encargados de la fecundidad y de la floración— durante el mes de mayo.

Durante la Edad Media, cuando el invierno daba paso a la primavera, mayo quedó vinculado, de manera natural, con la nueva vida. Por consiguiente, los cristianos vieron en la resurrección de Cristo la máxima encarnación de este acontecimiento; asimismo, el papel de María al traer la nueva vida al mundo dejó de reservarse únicamente para ciertas festividades selectas, para extenderse a la totalidad del mes. Un sacerdote jesuita de Roma, el padre Latomia, animaba a sus alumnos a rezar a María para que ella, por medio de su Hijo, les concediera la gracia de llevar una vida santa. Hacia el siglo XIX, los papas Pío VII y Pío IX otorgaron indulgencias a aquellos que dedicaran oraciones a María durante este mes. Finalmente, en 1945, el papa Pío XII declaró oficialmente el mes de mayo como un tiempo de especial veneración a Nuestra Señora.

Nuestra escuela parroquial mantiene viva la tradición que tal vez recuerden de sus años de juventud. Más adelante este mes, nuestros pequeños estudiantes coronarán a María tras una breve procesión. Los animo a rezar el Rosario—a diario, si es posible—por sus familias y por todo aquello que pese en sus corazones; por quienes recibirán la Sagrada Comunión por primera vez; por aquellos que se confirmarán en nuestra parroquia y por los hombres que serán ordenados al diaconado transitorio y al sacerdocio en la Arquidiócesis de Boston. Recuerden a todas las madres, vivas y difuntas, que nos han transmitido la fe. Muy especialmente, recen para que cesen todas las guerras y conflictos. ¡María, Reina de la Paz, ruega por nosotros!

Shawls may go to someone suffering from a serious illness or to one who has perhaps experienced a grievous loss. Prayers that accompany the shawls ask God to help renew the body as well as the spirit. They ask him to restore the recipient to hope, strength, and healing.” Each shawl comes with a special prayer card that helps to remind the recipient of God’s love always.

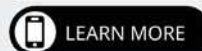


