After completing some amazing passes in a football game, the winning quarterback was asked how he managed to be so accurate and consistent. "I have to think like my receivers. Shawls may go to someone suffering from a serious illness or to one who has perhaps experienced a grievous loss. Prayers that accompany the shawls ask God to help renew the body as well as the spirit. They ask him to restore the recipient to hope, strength, and healing.” Each shawl comes with a special prayer card that helps to remind the recipient of God’s love always.


