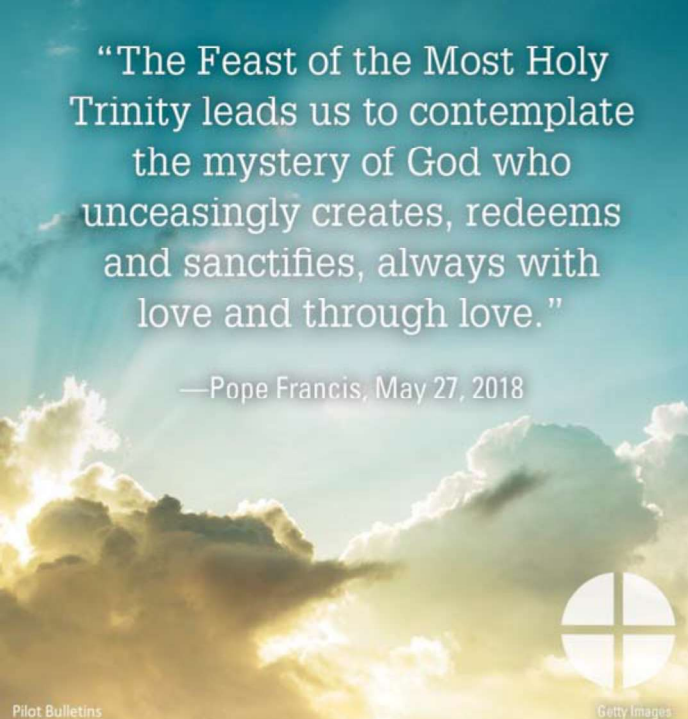

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

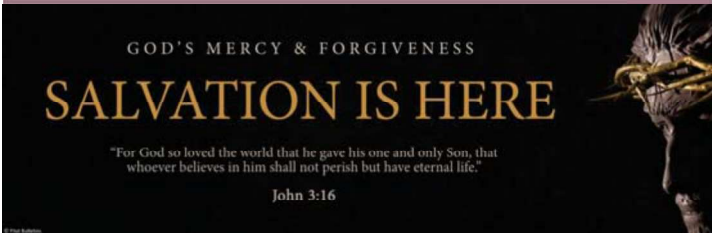
Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June 12, Friday, is the Feast of the Sacred Heart for all the Catholic Church.

As a parish that is proud of having the Sacred Heart as its Patron, this year we will honor its Name by celebrating the Feast Day with a Procession and a bilingual Solemn Mass.

The **Procession** will be at **6 pm on June 12**, from Roslindale Square to the Parish. We will praise the Sacred Heart with prayers and songs. It will be for adoration and in reparation for the many offenses we commit against his Love poured from his Holy Heart.

The **Mass** will be at **7 pm** in the upper church. All other activities planned at that time will be cancelled since this is a Parish event.

In preparation for the celebration we will have a **Novena from June 3 to June 11**. It will be led twice, each day: once after the morning mass in English and again at 6 pm via zoom in Spanish. The purpose of the Novena is to prepare spiritually to praise the Sacred prior to our consecration. All are invited.

This is our fourth year in a row that our Parish will come together to honor and adore the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will be waiting for you to share such a special celebration of the Catholic Church together.

What is a prayer shawl?

“The makers of these special, hand-knit or crochet shawls pray before the shawl is made, pray while working on the shawl, and pray after it is finished. When completed, the shawl is given to someone experiencing a particularly difficult time and in need of prayer. Shawls may go to someone suffering from a serious illness or to one who has perhaps experienced a grievous loss. Prayers that accompany the shawls ask God to help renew the body as well as the spirit. They ask him to restore the recipient to hope, strength, and healing.” Each shawl comes with a special prayer card that helps to remind the recipient of God’s love always.

MOST HOLY TRINITY

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.


