



The First Martyrs of Rome

FEAST DAY: JUNE 3

After a raging fire destroyed two-thirds of Rome in 64, Emperor Nero blamed Rome's Christians to divert suspicion from himself. Those acknowledging their Christianity were arrested and executed. Some were covered in wax and set afire as torches; some were sewn into and set after as foreness, some were sewn into animal skins and cast into the arena with wild animals; others were crucified. Sts. Peter and Paul died in the same persecution. The feast of these earliest martyrs of the Roman church is celebrated Roman historian Tacitus said the protomartyrs were to be pitied "for it was felt that they were





FIRST CENTURY Apostles Peter and Paul


hese apostles share a feast as founders of the church in Rome. Peter, a Galilean fisherman chosen by Christ as on of the Twelve Apostles, became the undisputed leader of the fledgling church after Pentecost. Paul, a Pharisee and Roman citizen who had persecuted Christians, became after his dramatic conversion the church's greatest missionary, its "apostle of the gentiles." By tradition both were martyred in Rome. Their adventures are recounted in the Acts of the Apostles, and letters from them are included in the




